


GENERAL HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION MAP WINDSOR COUNTY VERMONT

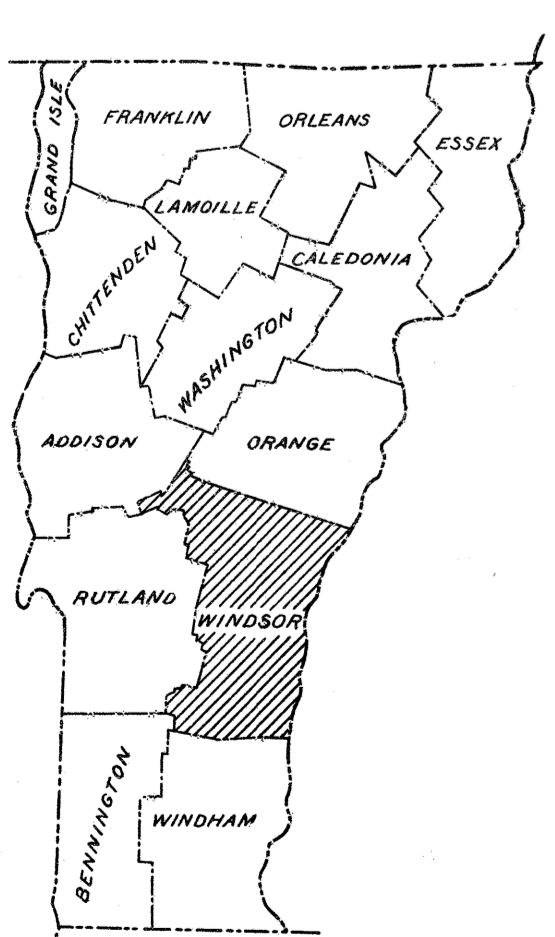
