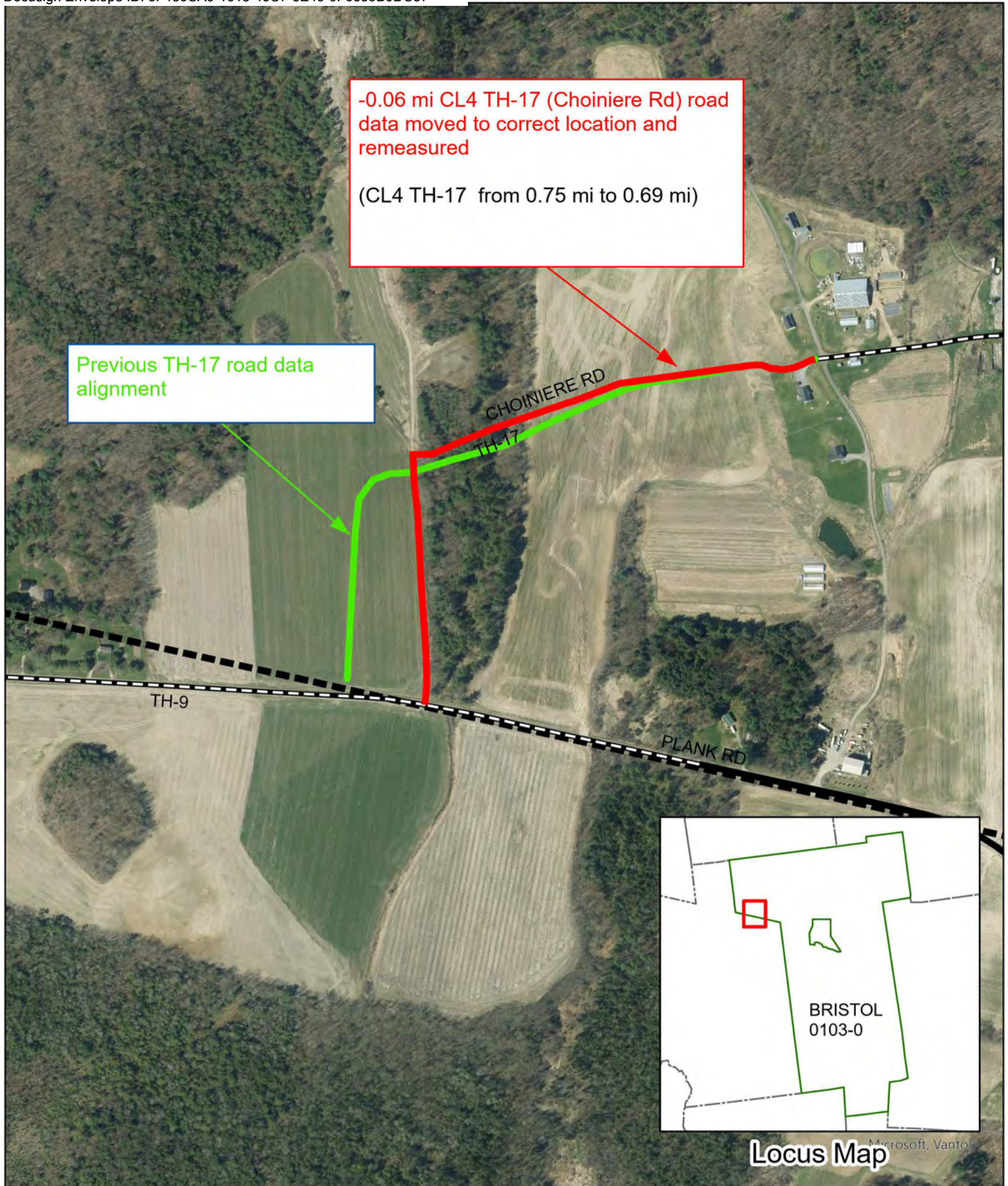

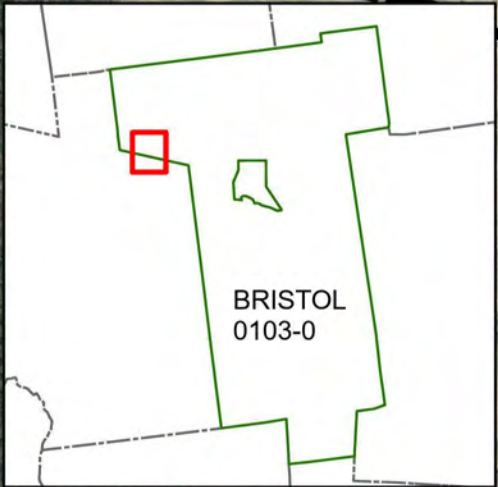

 (CL4 TH-17 from 0.75 mi to 0.69 mi)

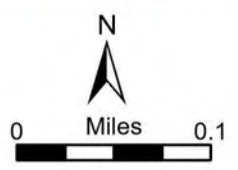
Previous TH-17 road data alignment

Good afternoon Valerie and Sharon,

A question on a road in Bristol came to my attention from an inquiry over a road in New Haven that we have mapped as continuing into Bristol, TH-17 or Choiniere Rd. We at VTrans and Tyler from E911 think we don't have this road mapped correctly and are trying to figure out what the original alignment of the road was and how it should be mapped on your Town Highway Map. Can you share this with the road foreman for me and see what he thinks? If you have an original survey of TH-17 that would really help us as well.

This is how we currently have it mapped, which shows it connecting to a tiny portion in New Haven (yellow highlight in image below), but it seems we have that New Haven road in the wrong location (maybe should be where the parcel data shows a ROW circled in red), or perhaps that little section does not exist at all in their town.

If you folks could help us verify where TH-17 should be located, that would help both VTrans and E911. Bing Street imagery shows Choiniere Rd following the yellow highlight in the second image below and intersecting with Plank Rd at the Town Boundary, but I don't think this is the original alignment of the road because it is too far east than historic documents show. Here is a link of the street view of that intersection [Bing Maps - Directions, trip planning, traffic cameras & more](#). In imagery from 1962, the road continues much further west than where Choiniere Rd heads south in the Bing street view (see 3<sup>rd</sup> image below).

Although not an official Town Highway map, the Beers Atlas (shown in 4<sup>th</sup> image) indicates that Choiniere Rd historically did go into New Haven (see yellow highlight). It shows the road as 299 rods in length, or 0.93 miles. This Bing street view shows an intersection with Plank Rd and a road going up the edge of the field, which I am wondering is where the actual Class 4 ROW should be. [Bing Maps - Directions, trip planning, traffic cameras & more](#). When I measure this in our GIS, I get 0.93 miles, very similar to the Beers measurement and it follows elevation data nicely (see green 5<sup>th</sup> image below). This would also connect it to the line shown in the 1962 imagery. Is this where the Town owned ROW for TH-17 should be located? It doesn't extend into New Haven at this location, but according to New Haven, Choiniere Rd is only in Bristol.

Could the road that goes into New Haven be a different road than Choiniere Rd? Did it change location at one point? If so, we do not have a record of that and should have the survey of the new location for our records.

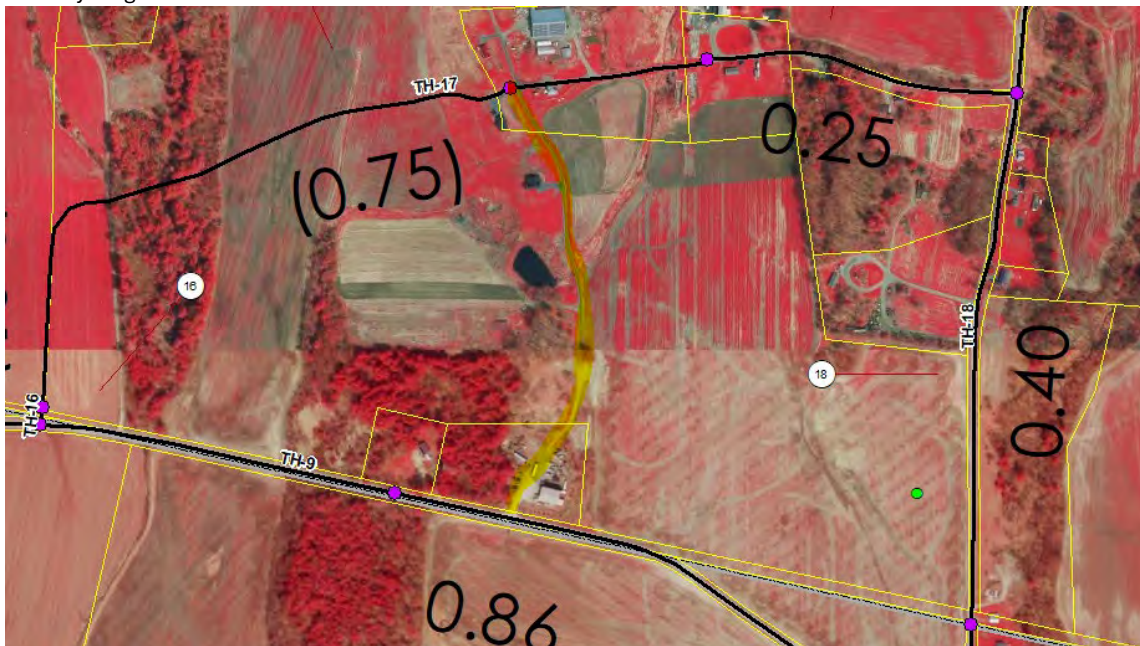
Please let us know what the Town can do to help us sort this out and we can share what we learn with E911 and New Haven. Whatever mileage or map changes may be needed can be put into the cue for the 2025 Mileage Certificate and/or Town Highway Map cycle.

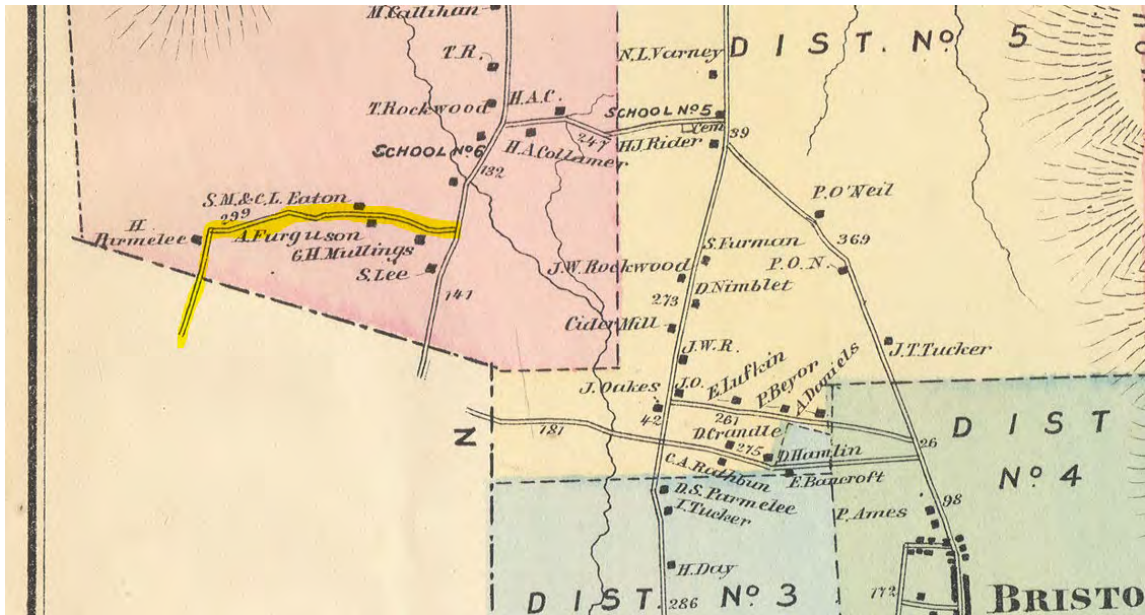
The way Bing shows Choiniere road:



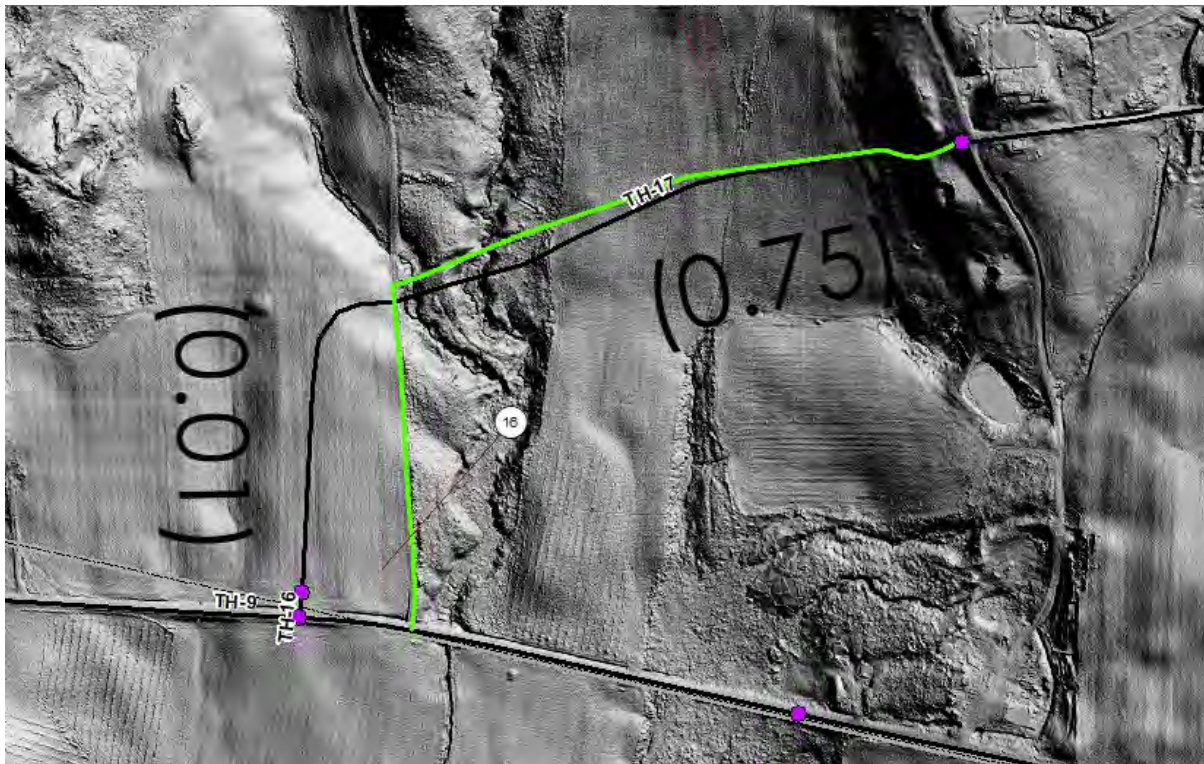

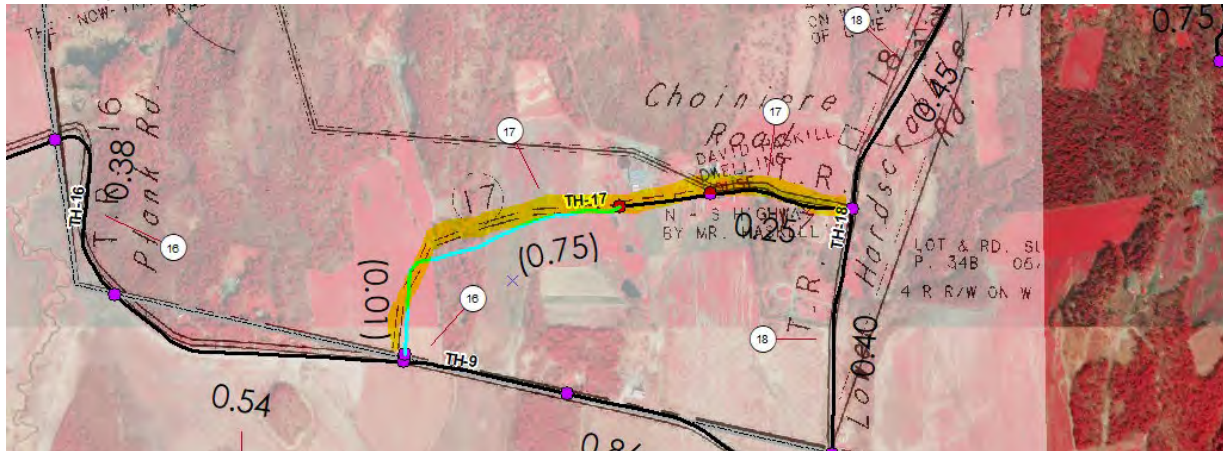
Thank you for all your input. It has been very helpful, but without the survey data of the official laying out of the road, it is not conclusive to make a major change in the alignment for TH-17 in Bristol.

AZ, I brought the old survey that you provided to us into our software and georeferenced it and have it shown over the imagery in the image below. The line for TH-17 on this survey lines up very close with what we already have mapped (see yellow highlight on survey and blue line for our mapped road in image below). I also concluded that this matches very well with the USGS map you sent.

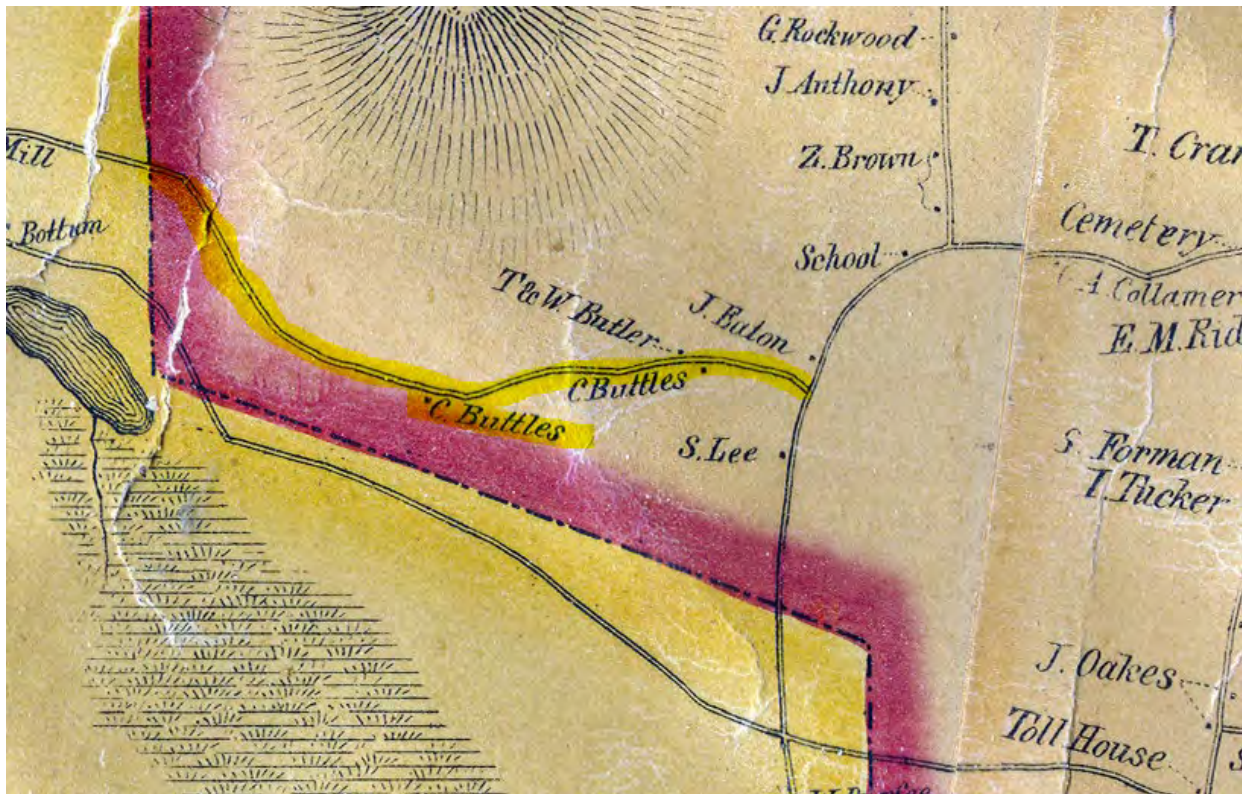
Although not an official laying out, the Walling map dated 1857 shows this road continuing west into New Haven (see 2<sup>nd</sup> image). This map is missing the piece that heads south to New Haven, but it does show a dwelling (C. Buttles) along the road which may match the dwelling (H. Parmelee) on the Beers atlas that I showed in an earlier email (see 3<sup>rd</sup> image). In the 4<sup>th</sup> image, you can see perhaps evidence of that dwelling in the elevation data where I have the red circle.

Since there is no other conclusive evidence, like the official survey data for the laying out of the original road, we conclude that the alignment for TH-17 should be where we currently have it mapped but slightly tweaked to the LiDAR elevation data (see green line in image below). This will not change the mileage of TH-17.

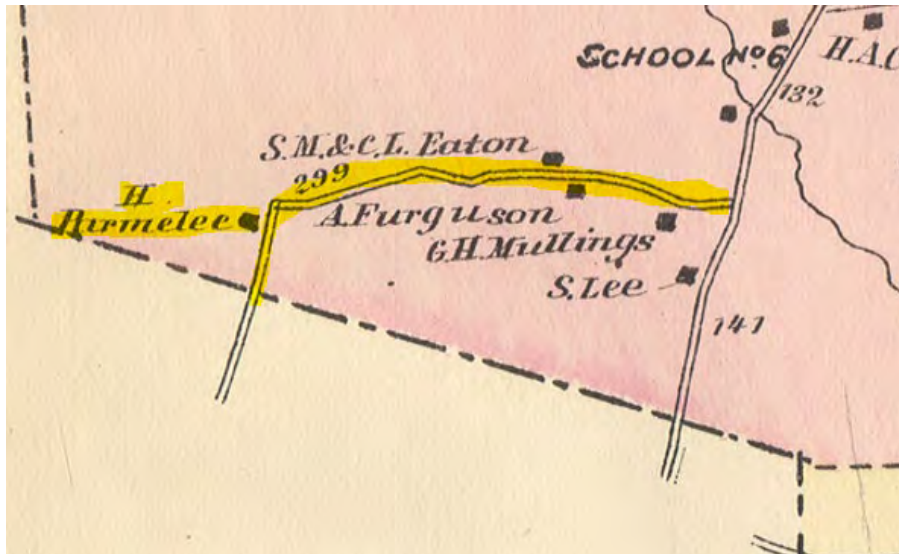
Old survey



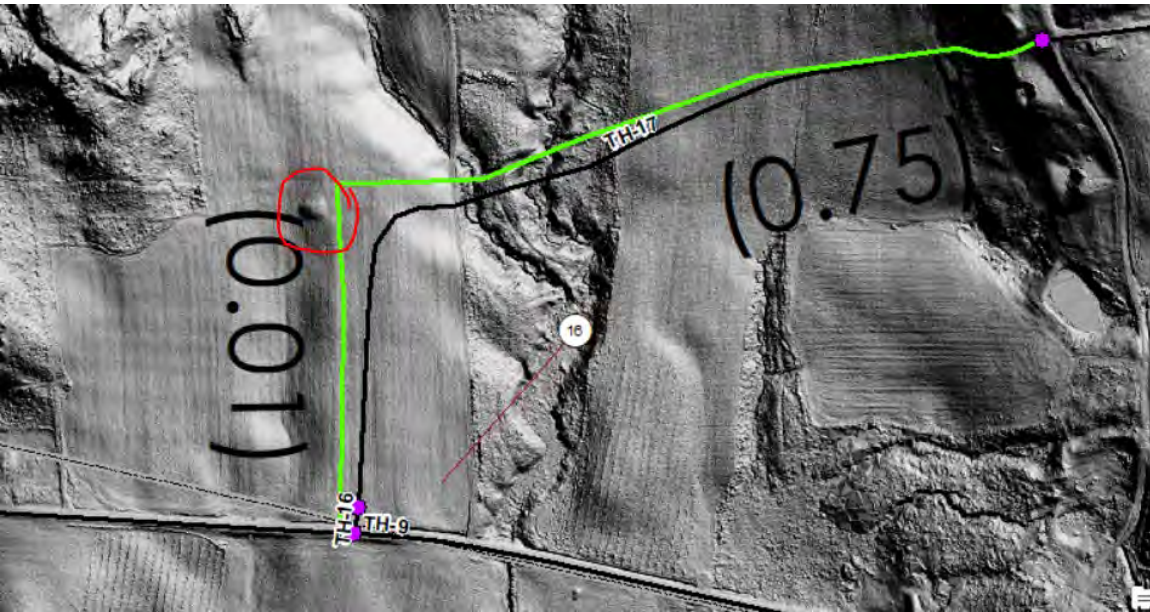
Walling map:

Hi All,

I've spent some time searching for historical surveys that would give a better idea of which path is correct. Although I could not find a survey that clearly shows the path, I do believe that 1A is the correct historical path. I was able to find a Department of the Interior geological survey map from 1903, it shows TR17 intersecting with TR18 practically on the town lines. I've included the Town Road Index as well, which shows a similar path as the geological survey.

The gravel pit received a 1983 act 250 permit, which is when I believe that access road was put in. The 1962 imagery it's not clear if there is a road along the edge of the field that would be path 3, which is why I'm hesitant to label that as the official legal path. The path labeled as 4 is an ROW access path used for AG purposes. However, based off the elevation data it is possible that TR17 did go along the field and was used for the gravel pit access.

I would say it is between 1A and 3 as the where the official legal laying is, with elevation data and length measurements pointing more towards 3.

I hope this helps, please let me know if I can be of further assistance.
