



That I, TERRENCE E. THOMAS

of Bristol in the County of Addison
and State of Vermont Grantor, in the consideration of

the INCORPORATED VILLAGE of BRISTOL,

in the County of Addison
and State of Vermont Grantee, by these presents, do

freely Give, Grant, Sell, Convey and Confirm unto the said Grantee

the INCORPORATED VILLAGE of BRISTOL,
its successors

and ~~here~~ and assigns forever, a
certain piece of land in the Village of Bristol in the
County of Addison and State of Vermont, described as
follows, viz:

A certain parcel of land, fifty feet (50') in width, presently used for highway purposes, serving North Meadows Development, so-called, together with the water mains now or to be placed thereon, for use as a highway and related uses, including the transmission of utilities and water. The said parcel appears on a survey entitled "North Meadows" drawn by Ronald L. LaRose, L.S., September 17, 1976, and on file in the office of the Bristol Town Clerk, as follows:

"Beginning at a point marked by an iron pipe, placed at the easterly side of Meadow Lane Extension, so-called, which said point is the northwesterly corner of lands now or formerly of James Hines, thence,
N 01° 34' E, 185.82 feet to an iron pipe; thence,
on an arc of a circle whose radius is 25 feet to a concrete marker; thence,
due east, 188.21 feet to an iron pipe; thence,
continuing due east 119.98 feet to an iron pipe; thence,
on an arc of a circle whose radius is 60 feet in a generally easterly direction, to a concrete marker; thence,
due north 50 feet, to a concrete marker; thence,
continuing on the arc of a circle, whose radius is 60 feet in generally westerly direction to an iron pipe; thence,
due west 60.89 feet to an iron pipe; 112.27 feet to an iron pipe; 120 feet to an iron pipe; 139.05 feet to a concrete marker; thence,
on an arc of a circle whose radius is 25 feet in a northwesterly direction to a concrete marker; thence,
N 10° 5' W, 223.55 feet to an iron pipe and 324.31 feet to an iron pipe; thence,
N 85° 54' W, 51.35 feet to a concrete marker; thence,

along the arc of a circle whose radius is 60 feet to an iron pipe; thence,
on a bearing S 10° 05' E, 44.04 feet to an iron pipe; 120 feet to an iron pipe; 120 feet to an iron pipe; 120 feet to an iron pipe; and 100 feet to a concrete marker; thence,
due east 86.98 feet to an iron pipe; thence,
on the arc of a circle having a radius of 25 feet in a generally southeasterly direction to an iron pipe; thence,
on a bearing S 01° 34' W, 80.11 feet to an iron pipe; and, 100.0 feet to an iron pipe, said pipe marking the southeasterly corner of lands now or formerly of William Fucci; thence,
easterly 50 feet, more or less, along the present northerly line of Meadow Lane, to the point or place of beginning."

Being a portion of the same lands and premises conveyed to Terrence E. Thomas by Warranty Deed of Rollin E. and Hazel S. Devino, dated 28 March 1974, and recorded in Volume 43, Page 391 of the Bristol Land Records.

EXCEPTING and RESERVING from highway use only from the above description is a strip of land 5 feet in width and running the width of the roadway at both the northerly-most and easterly-most extremities of the roadway. The Grantor herein, for himself, his heirs, executors and assigns, conveys an easement over said reserved strips for purposes of transmission of water, utilities and similar uses.

Grantor herein, for himself, his heirs, administrators and assigns, covenants and agrees with the Grantee, its successors and assigns, that the portion of the highway herein conveyed that serves lots 1 through 4 as set forth on the subdivision map, will be graded and covered with a tack coat in accordance with State and Village specifications within 24 months from the date hereof at the sole responsibility and expense of the Grantor. It is further understood and agreed that the Village of Bristol assumes no responsibility or liability for the maintenance of the said uncomplete portion of the highway until such time as it is completed and approved as set forth above.

To have and to hold *said granted premises, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof, to the said Grantee*

By acceptance of the within conveyance, the Village of Bristol, its successors and assigns, assumes the responsibility to maintain and repair the above-described highway and water mains, subject to the conditions stated above. *GED*

hereby engage to **Warrant and Defend** the same against all lawful claims whatever, except as aforesaid.
