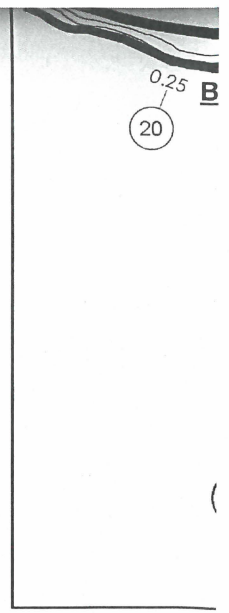
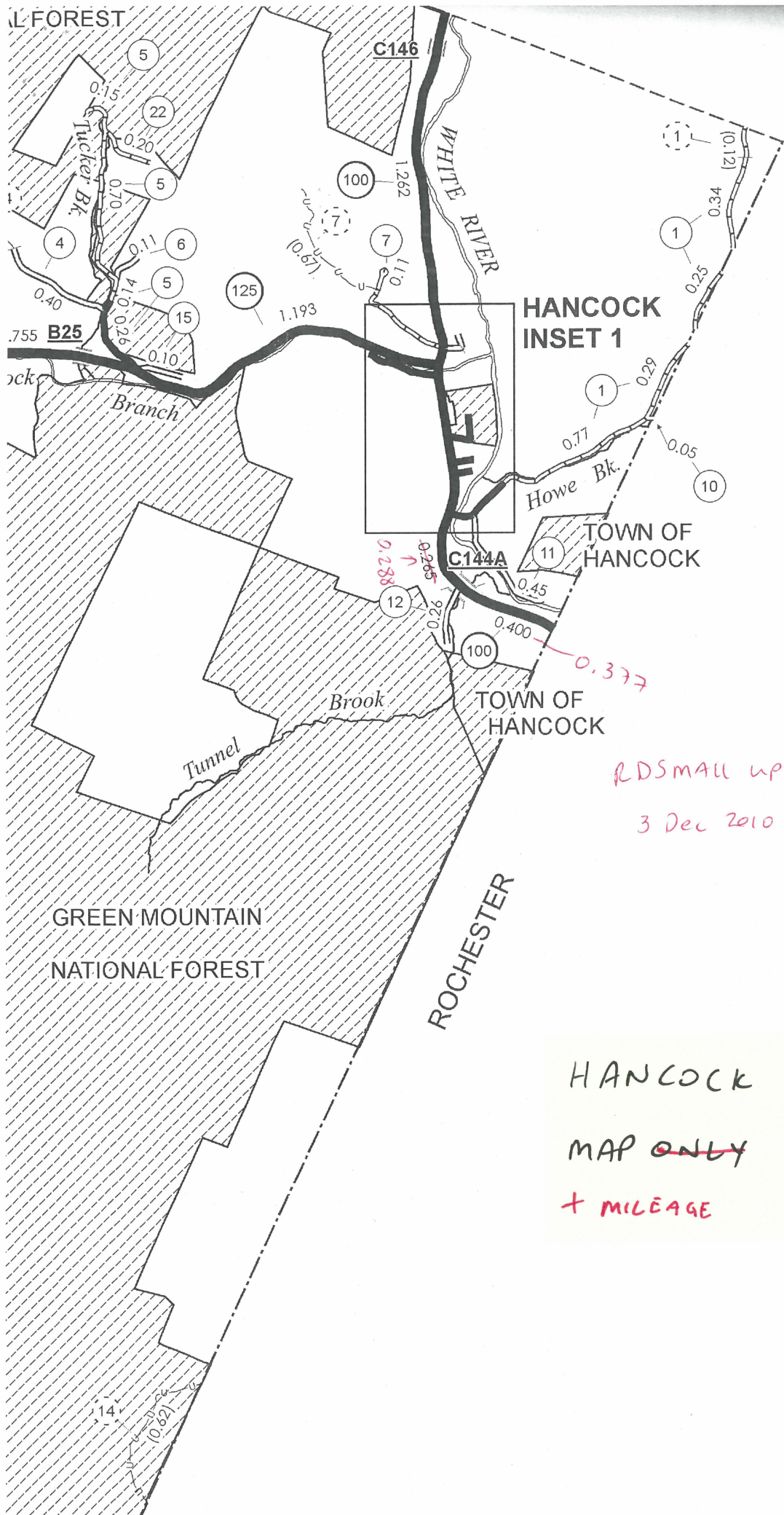

Joe,

I have reviewed the intersection of TH-12 and VT-100 in Hancock and agree with the mileage change. I reviewed project plans for AC STP 2124(1)S completed in 2005/2006 and have updated the station to 1991 feet (0.377 miles). I have left the stationing for B144A the same as the route log and not made any alterations to it.

I have reviewed the stationing for B146 and agree that there is a mileage difference between the actual location and the route logs. I have used the stationing from AC STP 2124 (1)S with an adjusted station for the Hancock/Granville town line (-90 feet) and will assign a new station to B146 to be 12476 feet (2.363 miles). This matches your mileage and it also is very close to the stationing from a 1984 inventory of VT-100.

Thank you for the notice on these mileage discrepancies.

Good Monday morning –

While reviewing VisiData and the current Route Logs I noticed two points that did not correspond. Most town highways and bridges along this 2.51 mile stretch of roadway compared favorably (within 20 feet) with the exception of the following:

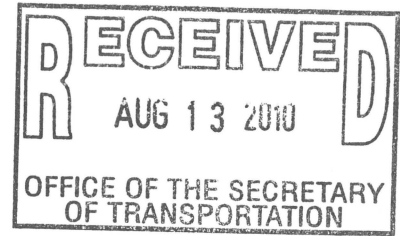
- TH-12 (Tunnel Brook Rd) exhibits a difference of approx. 150 feet (0.372 vs. 0.40)
- Bridge #146 exhibits a difference of approx. 275 feet (2.363 vs. 0.414)

Reports:

- a. Roads: Ricky reported that he had checked on the work that contractor ECS was doing on Fassett Hill Rd, the job was complete with a good job done. ECS has presented an invoice for payment of the culvert phase of the project Ricky makes the motion to pay the invoice, seconded by Jim all in favor. So Moved. Ricky has made an agreement with ECS for the disposal of the old culverts. ECS will crush and remove the old culverts by taking them to a scrap metal yard and the Town will receive 50% of what ever is recovered. The second phase of the Fassett Hill project will begin as soon as ECS and Ricky complete the details. Blair Hill Rd. Ricky will meet with ECS and Steve Smyrychynski to go over the details of the project.

New Business:

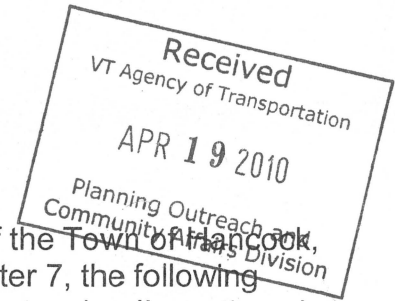
- A. Jim brought up the issue of having Mark provide traffic control for the event on the 29th. Jim makes the motion to do so, seconded by Jack, all in favor. So moved

Old Business:

- A. Hearing on Bingo Road: At the opening of the meeting Jim announced that they would be holding a hearing on the discontinuance of Bingo Rd and if anyone was present for that hearing they should speak up and be heard. No response from anyone in attendance. Bingo road is no longer a Town road.
- B. Fire Department Issues: Discussed earlier in the meeting with Fire Chief Rob Deering.
- C. Ordinances: Jim presented the board with a revised copy of the Driveway Access Permit. It would seem that the majority of the board was not happy with the insurance part of the ordinances, the issue of requiring signage was discussed Ricky felt that the Road Commissioner should decide if signage was needed not to make it mandatory. No vote was taken because Jim felt the ordinance was not complete unless a penalty was added, Jim will check and see if other Towns require insurance Jim will also check with the Towns insurance. Steve Smyrychynski brought the issue of the Town not having an ordinance protecting Town Properties, we all agree that something needed to be done.

Town Highway #13 (hereafter referred to as TH#13) said remain Class 3 – all existing leftover portions of TH#13 and beyond and current residing TH#13 to the NF#42 (National Forest “Bingo Brook Road Project of 1979”) and beyond in the Town of Hancock North of the Rochester-Hancock town line. Beginning north of the intersection of Pine Brook Trail Road and Bingo Road and proceeding in a North by Northwesterly direction for a distance of .55 miles more or less, A hearing at the Hancock Town Office beginning at 6:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 18th 2010/minimum 30 notice will be held to consider the discontinuance of formally established TH#13 and extant TH#13 from the Hancock Highway system. A date and time for the examination and inspection of the premises will be determined at a later date.

THEREFORE, pursuant to the Title 19, VSA, Chapter 7, you are hereby notified that a hearing will be held at the specified time as listed above, on Tuesday, May 18th, 2010, in Hancock, Vermont, for the purpose of hearing all persons interested in said highway, its discontinuance, and for the purpose of examining the premises affected hereby.

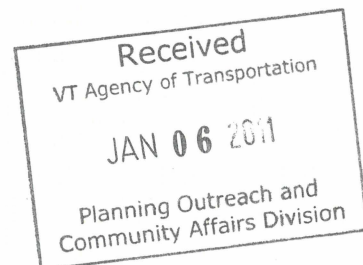
