RE: 1995 Mileage Certificate for Middlebury

Dear Mr. Chabot:

Enclosed is the Town of Middlebury's Certificate of Mileage for the year ending February 10, 1995.

In the draft certificate which you furnished to the Town, you have indicated that 0.13 miles of Town Highway 31 (Three Mile Bridge Road) is not up to Class 3 standards. This was noted last year and was part of the 1994 Mileage Certificate submitted by the Town. However, in a February 23, 1994 letter from Jay Kilton to Betty Wheeler, Town Manager, the law was quoted and it was declared that this adjustment should happen in 1995.

The Town has still not formally changed the classification of this portion of Three Mile Bridge Road, but we accept your change of classification for State Aid purposes in 1995 and thereafter.

For 1995, we have only the addition of 0.0835 miles of Class 3 highway, a new road off Foote St. to the north of Standard Register.

I noticed on the Certificate for the first time there is a new category "Class 1 Lane" which adds 0.404 miles. I am interested to know the basis for this mileage and the beginning and ending points, since there are a couple of places on Court Street, Court Square and elsewhere downtown where we have multiple highway lanes. Please provide details, as we may want to correct this next year.

Also, in my letter to you of February 9, 1994 last year, I requested that you send three sets of the corrected Town and Village maps so that the Town Manager, Director of Public Works and I would each have a set. I am still waiting for this.

TO: TOWN/CITY/VILLAGE CLERK AND
SELECTMEN/ALDERMEN/TRUSTEES OF:

The Vermont General Assembly is currently considering the adoption of a proposal to supplement the existing program of financial support for Class 1 Town Highways. Under this proposal, towns would receive an additional amount based on the lane mileage of its class 1 highways meeting the criteria. These criteria are:

- * A lane must have a width of at least 10 feet, with the length calculated not to include tapers, but to begin at the point where the width reaches 10 feet. There is no support provided on a proportionate basis for less than standard widths of 10 feet.
- * A lane will be considered only when it is identified by appropriate lane striping.
- * Parking spaces shall not be included in the calculation of the width of the lane.
- * Turning or holding lanes shall not be included unless the length of such lanes exceeds 200 feet.

The calculation of assistance to a town under this formula shall be based on the lane mileage meeting the above criteria multiplied by the current year's mileage assistance formula (to be decided by the Vermont General Assembly).

Attached is a CERTIFICATE listing the Agency's estimate of lane mileage meeting the above criteria in your town. This certificate **MUST BE COMPLETED AND RETURNED** to the VAOT Planning Division in order to begin the distribution of these funds. Please sign the Certificate and return it to this office by May 16, 1994.

As noted above, this program is currently under consideration by the Vermont General Assembly. Final implementation will begin only upon final action by that body.
