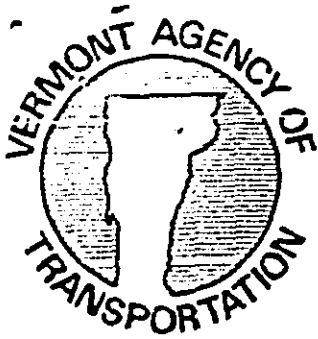

Gentlemen:

Enclosed is the Certificate of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1983. We have made several changes in the Certificate this year. You will note that this new form does not require notarization. Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1981 by Mr. Wimett, Road Commissioner, and Mr. Chabot, Road Inventory Chief of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage and any changes in classification are indicated on the enclosed map and are explained as follows:

Your Class 3 mileage has decreased by 0.210 mile which is broken down with 0.050 mile on Town Road 5 and 0.160 mile on Town Road 17. This portion of T-5 is gated and the portion of T-17 is cabled.

We are also forwarding the Mileage Certificate for your town for the year ending February 10, 1982. 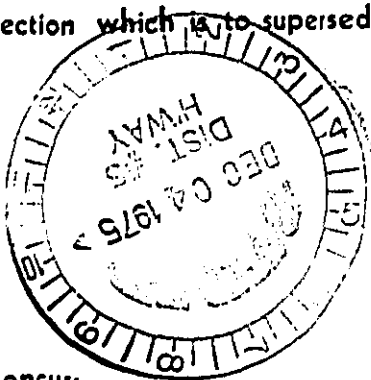

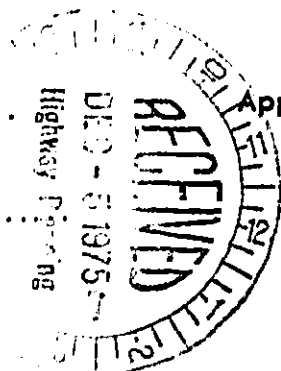
