

Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1981 by Mr. Conant, Road Commissioner, and Mr. Chabot, Road Inventory Chief of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage and any changes in classification are indicated on the enclosed map and explained as follows:

Your Class 3 mileage has increased by 0.050 mile on T-21 due to the reclassification of a portion of this road. We require a Certificate signed by the entire Board of Selectmen regarding this reclassification. Also, during our reinventory, it was found that 0.150 mile on Town Road 22 is not discontinued, as shown on the attached map. We require a statement from the Board of Selectmen that this portion of road is being maintained at Class 3 standards.



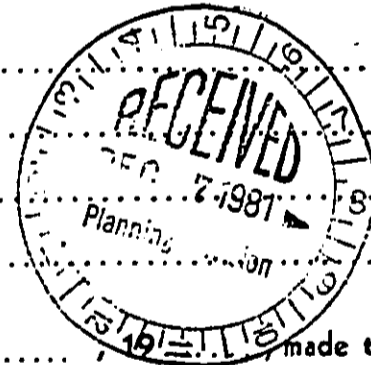

I am herewith forwarding the Certificates of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1975. 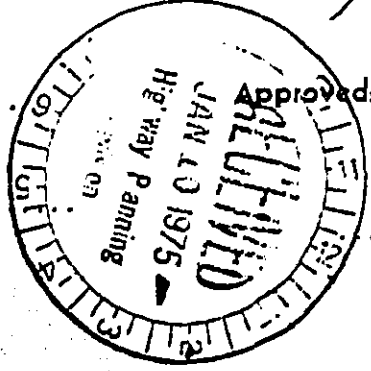

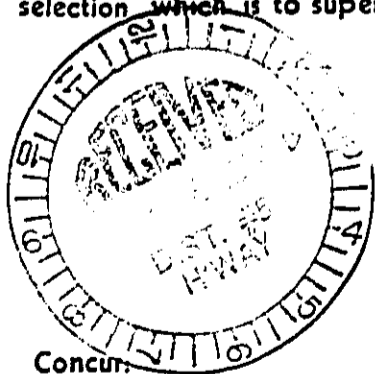

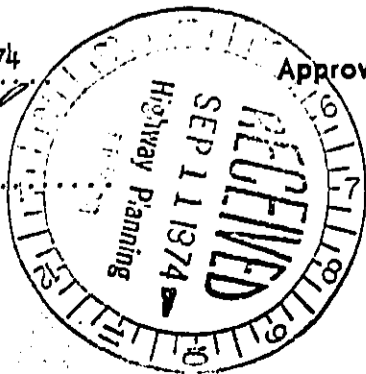
