To Selectboard,

As discussed in a phone conversation with Selectboard member Priscilla Gilman, I am returning your Certificate of Highway Mileage with my corrections noted on it. A reclassification from Class 3 to Class 2 is an action delegated by statute to the state. Towns have the right to reclassify from 3 to 4 and vice versa, but must request reclassification to Class 2. Class 2 roads receive a higher amount per mile of the annual state aid funding. I advised Selectperson Gilman to contact VTTrans District 5 in Essex Junction in order to discuss Class 2 requests. The actual request would be sent to our Engineering Services / Highway Research section in Montpelier for Agency approval or disapproval. Please be advised that Salisbury already exceeds one guideline we have which is for Class 2 mileage to usually not exceed 25% of total Class 2 and 3 mileage in a town.

Should a Class 2 reclassification be approved, it would not go into effect until next year.

Consider this your finalized copy of this year's certificate, unless you make other changes before annual reporting deadline of February 10.
