**OTHERS PRESENT WERE:** Tom Telling, Tom Barker, Burton Wedge, Ann Dittami, Tad Powers, and Deb Hurlburt.

Jackie Devoid called the meeting to order at 7:00 and led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

**GENERAL BUSINESS:**

**MINUTES**

Jonathan Blake moved to accept the minutes of January 11, 2011 as amended. Motion carried.

Jack Beasley moved to accept the minutes of January 18, 2011 as amended. Motion carried.

**OFFICERS AND COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**Town Clerk Report**

Ann Dittami reported:

- frozen pipes in the building, David Crane will fix the problem so it doesn't happen again,
- she would like to hire Sid Hutchins to knock the icicles off the building, the Board agreed,
- she wanted to know what the Board would like to do about the homeless count for towns. The Board agreed there were no homeless in Salisbury.

**Lister's Report**

- Ann Dittami reported that Bill Krajewski (appraiser) was in and will start doing site visits in early February.

**Road Foreman's Report**

Tom Barker reported:

- two trucks went down during the last storm and it was a busy weekend,
- he and Burton set up Health Savings Accounts, he had to take about \$300 out of his own pocket to pay for one prescription (this will be discussed later),
- he asked the Congregational Church to cut up a limb in the drive because he does not want to plow with the new truck and do damage to it, he does the Church drive as a favor to the members,
- he said there is no place to put the snow in Veterans Park, someone from the Historical Society will remove some railings next fall.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:**

**Tom Telling** explained to the Board the Town Compilation and the Landfill Audit. He agreed to come in and work on adjusting entries with Martha and Jackie. The Board felt it was very helpful to have him come.

**Deb Hurlburt** wanted to know who owns the West Side Cemetery? Martha Sullivan said the Town does. She explained that last year the cemetery was only mowed twice. She called Sue and Tom Record and volunteered to mow it because the situation was so appalling, and they never returned her call.

She likes having the minutes on the web site and read that the Board was considering a stipend for the Development Review Board members. She considered it her civic duty and did not want a stipend. The Board said they did not budget anything.

**Executive Session**

Jim Eagan moved to go into Executive Session with Tad Powers to discuss the Ann Story situation. Motion carried. Ann, Tom and Joyce went into the Lister's office.

The Board came out of Executive Session at 8:35 PM.

**Pidgeon Road East**

Jack Beasley moved that the following statement be incorporated into the minutes of this meeting. Motion carried.

**January 25, 2011**

**The Select Board certifies the following information regarding Town Road #22: The road, commonly known as Pidgeon Road, was re-established as a town highway in 1888. In 1986 the Board agreed to upgrade the eastern end of the road to meet the standards of a Class 3 road. The upgrade was accomplished shortly thereafter, and the town has continued to maintain the road since that time. The upgrade covers a distance of .25 mile (approximately 1320 feet) westerly from Town Road #8 (Middle Road).**

**The official highway map indicates that the upgraded portion of Town Road #22 is discontinued. The Board has been unable to locate any documentation to substantiate the "discontinued" designation.**

**Documents to verify all of the above, as well as a corrected map, are being submitted to the State.**
