The resulting changes in highway mileage and any changes in classification are indicated on the enclosed map and explained on the attached sheets.



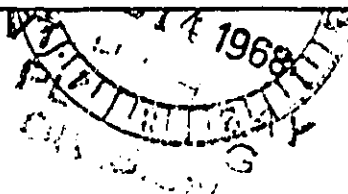
The Selectmen did not inspect all the properties. There are no instructions anywhere that says this is necessary.

In reference to your letter of January 26, 1970, requesting that serious consideration be given to the addition of that portion of T.H. 7 extending westerly from Vt. Rte. 22A to the junction with T.H. 10, T.H. 10 westerly to its junction with T.H. 8, T.H. 8 westerly to its junction with T.H. 5, to your State Aid mileage.
