Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1981 by Mr. Denis, Selectman, and Mr. Chabot, Road Inventory Chief of this office.

The resulting change in your highway mileage is indicated on the enclosed map and explained as follows:

Your Class 3 mileage has decreased by 0.050 mile due to a remeasurement on Town Road 7.


