SUBJECT: Information on Town Road T-50

Per your request the following is the information on T-50 as found in our records:

- 1. 1896 Beer's Atlas shows road 0.81 mile.
- 2. 1890 Town Map shows road as T-146.
- 3. 1931 Map shows road as 0.83 mile.
- 4. 1947 Map shows road as 0.78 mile.
- 5. 1963 Reinventory. During the 1963 reinventory Mr McCoy of the Highway Dept. was told that 0.69 mile of this road had been discontinued. The statement was later changed to 0.69 mile untraveled road per Mr. Pelsue and Mr. Van Santvoord. When the maps were updated an untraveled symbol should have been shown on the map but was not. In 1973 due to Act 63 this 0.69 mile should have been entered as Class 4 road.

Due to the error in 1963 the map should show 0.09 mile Class 3 and 0.69 mile Class 4 on T-50.

Also due to error in 1963, T-37 should show 0.18 mile of Class 4, T-41 0.10 mile of Class 4, and T-42 0.70 mile of Class 4.

We will include these changes on the 1984 Mileage Certificate.

Gentlemen:

I am herewith forwarding the Certificates of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1980. The enclosed form letter explains the necessity for completing and returning the Certificate, as well as the procedures to be followed in making changes in your Class 3 and Class 4 Town Highway Systems. Please read this form letter carefully before completing the Certificate.

The following mileage changes were brought to our attention during the past year:

Due to Construction Project RFF 019-1(8), your State Highway Mileage has increased 0.752 mile on a new section of 4-lane divided highway; 0.677 mile on new 2-lane highway; 0.734 mile of ramps; and 0.454 mile on a temporary crossover. A section of old US 7 (decrease of 1.035 miles) has been transferred to VT 7A (increase of 1.035 miles) due to the same project.

In addition, there is an increase of 0.050 mile on Beech Lane and 0.150 mile on Shields Drive in Class 3 mileage, due to the opening of two roads for public travel. We already have the Certificates of Completion and Opening of a Highway for Public Travel on file in this office.

For your convenience, we have entered on the enclosed Certificate of Highway Mileage all changes which were brought to our attention during the past year. We will appreciate your indicating any changes in your Class 3 during the past year. The enclosed form letter explains the procedures to be followed in making changes in Class 3 or Class 4 mileage.

One white and two yellow copies of the completed Certificate should be returned to this office no later than February 15, 1980. The designated representative of the State Agency of Transportation will approve the town's copy which will then be returned to the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk should retain the third yellow copy for the town's records until the approved copy has been returned.

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1978 by Mr. Cross, Road Commissioner and Mr. Chabot of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage and any changes in classification are indicated on the enclosed map and explained on the attached breakdown sheet.

I am also forwarding, herewith, the Certificate of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1979. The enclosed form explains the necessity for completing and returning the Certificate as well as the procedures to be followed in making changes to your Class 3 and Class 4 Town Highway System. Please read this form letter carefully before completing the Certificate.

You will note that the Mileage Certificate Form has been changed this year from previous Certificates. The 1978 General Assembly passed a "Scenic Highway Law" which has necessitated a change in the form. Please refer to the second enclosed form letter for specific instructions relative to Scenic Highway Mileage. This section is not mandatory, but left to your discretion. By this time, you should have received additional information on this legislation from the Transportation Board. Utilizing this and the attached instructions, you should be able to complete the Scenic Highway portion of the form. If there is any confusion on this item, please contact us.

The remaining portion of the form is to be completed just as before and do not delete any mileage from this portion that you may have picked up as scenic. Your Class 1, 2, 3 and 4 mileages will remain the same whether categorized as scenic or not.

In addition, the following mileage changes were brought to our attention during the past year:

Mr. Cross stated that T 456, 0.05 mile, is not town maintained. We need a statement from the Town Selectman that this road is not town maintained and will be required before the mileage can be deducted.

Due to project F 019-1(8), T 13 was reduced by 0.22 mile. T 88, a former portion of T 13, to be increased 0.10 mile.

Due to construction on US 7, several state highway mileage changes occurred during 1974 and are open to travel:

+1.349 miles of 4-lane US 7 +3.327 miles of US 7 ramps +0.551 mile of 2-lane US 7 +0.134 mile of jughandle +0.001 mile of VT 67A +0.934 mile of VT 67A connector

In addition, 2.356 miles of Old US 7 have been redesignated as BR US 7 although no mileage change results.

During the past year you submitted the required papers to add Finley Drive (0.20 mile) and Foster Drive (0.05 mile) to your class 3 system.

We will appreciate your indicating any other changes in your class 3 or class 4 town highway systems processed in accordance with the Statutes during the past year. The enclosed form letter explains the procedures to be followed in making changes in class 3 or class 4 mileage.
