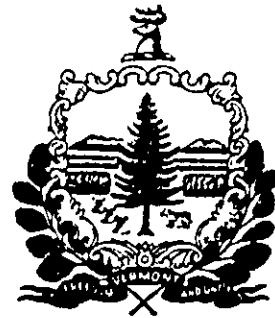





At a meeting of the Transportation Board in Montpelier - January 11, 1983

On MOTION of Mr. Rock, seconded by Mr. Shortle, and approved by a majority of the Transportation Board, the Board directed the following actions be taken with respect to Town Highways in the Town of Glastenbury, pursuant to Section 24, Title 19, V.S.A.:

- 1) Pursuant to Section 17(a) (4), Title 19, V.S.A., Town Highway 1 to be reclassified as Class 4 over its entire length.
- 2) Pursuant to Section 17(a) (4), Title 19, V.S.A., Town Highway 2 be reclassified as Class 4 from its intersection with Town Highway 1 to a point 0.06 miles Northerly of said intersection along the centerline of Town Highway 2.
- 3) Town Highway 2 be designated as a trail from a point 0.06 mile Northerly of the intersection of Town Highway 1 and Town Highway 2, along the centerline of said highway, a distance of 1.50 miles to the end of Town Highway Number 2. The full width of the existing highway right-of-way shall be continued in public ownership.
- 4) Maintenance of the Class 4 segments of the Glastenbury town highways shall be continued at previous levels limited to grading, graveling, ditching and installation of culverts, such maintenance activities to be conducted in consultation with the supervisor.

SUBJECT: Glastenbury

Board Member Merton Snow has concluded Hearing proceedings resulting from the proposal to reclassify town highways in Glastenbury. It was initially represented in submissions to the Board that the intention of the proposers was to reclassify a section of Town Highway 1 from its present Class 3 status to Class 4 and to designate a segment of Town Highway 2 as a trail.

The Hearing process revealed that alternatively, the intention of the Glastenbury interests was to designate all of Town Highway 1 as Class 4, to reclassify a short segment of Town Highway 2 as Class 4, and the balance of Town Highway 2 to be designated as a trail.

It is the intention of Mr. Snow to submit Findings to the Board proposing Board approval of these changes.

This process has revealed that the Transportation Board is responsible for all Title 19 highway actions in gores and unorganized towns which are otherwise assigned to selectmen.

This includes among other things the reclassification process and the Section 15 requirement for measurement of town highways and the February 10 statement of description and condition of town highways.

The action to be taken by the Board in connection with the Glastenbury process will be effected formally by the Board's execution of the Certificate of Highway Mileage which must be filed by February 10.

I am not aware of the Agency's scheduling process for these forms. It would be helpful if the appropriate certificates for Glastenbury and the other unorganized towns and gores could be supplied for Board action at its next scheduled meeting on January 11.

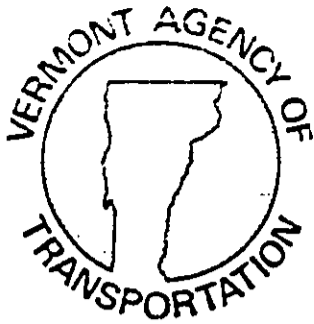
