Gentlemen:

The Stamford Vermont Selectmen warns the residents of the town that there will be a public hearing on April 12th 1979 at 8 P.M. in the Stamford school to discuss proposed discontinuances and reclassifications of certain roads or portions of roads within the town.

A copy of the four(4) proposed changes, describing and locating them in detail is available for inspection in the town clerks office.

30 March 1979

Reclassification and Discontinuance of Roads
Location and Description

Item # 1. Discontinuance of Road Section. Town Road # 7.

In accordance with Section 343, Title 19 VSA and after examining the premises, the Board of Selectmen judge that that section of the "old Road" extending south of the access road to the Shippee-Mills residence to Route 100, to be surplus to the needs of the town and no longer serving the public good, and recommends that it be discontinued. Further, it is recommended that it revert to the abutting property owners i.e. Shippee -Mills, as authorized by Article 8, section 531, Title 19 VSA

Item # 2. Reclassification of Road Section(upgrade) Town Road # 8.

In accordance with Ch 1, Section 15, Title 19 VSA recommend reclassification of approximately 0.17 miles of Sumner Hill Road north of Patten's from class #4 to class #3. This action would result in the extension of the Class 3 portion of this road from 0.43 miles to approximately 0.60 miles.

Item # 3. Reclassification of Road Section.(Three Options) Town Road #15.

A. Downgrade the entire section from its junction with Klondike Road(TR 14) to its junction with with that section classified as Trail. The entire Road would then be designated "Trail" from its junction with Klondike Road to its junction with Lesure Road(TR 16).

B. Down grade the section from Bona's camp to the untraveled portion beyond to a class four(4)road.

C. Down grade the section from its junction with Klondike Road(TR 14) to the class four(4) section beyond as Class four(4)

Item 4. Reclassification of Road Section.

To reclassify that portion of a road from its junction with TR 13 to a waterbar approximately .11 miles distant. This road formerly serving a residence now destroyed, (Farron's) now serve no one. Only purpose of continued maintenance is to maintain a waterbar and prevent water damage to roadways below it. Recommend downgrading to Trail status.

A Public Hearing was conducted on April 12 1979 at 8:00 PM in the Town Clerk's Office to discuss proposed discontinuances and reclassifications of certain roads or portions of roads within the town.

The Meeting was properly warned by an official notice in the North Adams Transcript, with written notices posted in four public places in the town and a written discription of all proposed changes posted in the Town Clerk's office. Furthur all abutters were notified by letter from the Clerk of Board, Board of Selectmen. A copy of the legal notice and the written discription of the proposed changes is attached as exhibit #1.

Present at the meeting were all members of the Board of Selectmen. In addition, the following abutters and/or interested persons were in attendance. Mr R. Costine, Mr J. Newkom, Mr A. Bona, Mr J. Ahearn, and Mr D. Costine.

Item # 1. Discontinuance of Road Section. Town Road # 7. (Revision C)

That section of the "old road" extending south of the access road to the Shippee-Mills residence to Route 100, is declared to be surplus to the needs of the town and no longer serving the public good and is therefore declared discontinued. Furthur, it is recommended that it revert to the abutting property owners, i.e. Shippee-Mills as authorized by Article 8, section 531, Title 19 V.S.A.

Item # 2. Reclassification of Road Section(upgrade) Town Road # 8. (Revision A)

In accordance with Ch. 1, Section 15, Title 19 V.S.A. approximately 0.17 miles of Sumner Hill Road north of Patten's having been resurfaced and improved to meet state standards, now satisfies the requirements for a Class #3 road. It has been inspected by the District Engineer and the Town Road Commissioner & on their recommendations we declare it qualified as additional class 3 roadway.

Item #3 Reclasification of Road Section. Town Road 15.(Revision B)

Downgrade that section of Town Road 15 from its junction with Town Road 14 from Class 3 to Class 4. In addition,downgrade that portion of Town Road 15 classified as Untravelled Road to Legal Trail.

Item #4 Reclassification of Road Section(Addition E)(T32 Provisional)

Inspection of records in the District Engineers Office as well as records of the Town reveal that though there was an action initiated to make this private road a Town Road in 1968, that action was never completed and later abandoned. No furthur action is therefore desired nor anticipated regarding this addition.

Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1978 by Mr. Bushika, Road Commissioner and Mr. Chabot of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage and any changes in classification are indicated on the enclosed map and explained on the attached breakdown sheet.

I am also forwarding, herewith, the Certificate of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1979.
