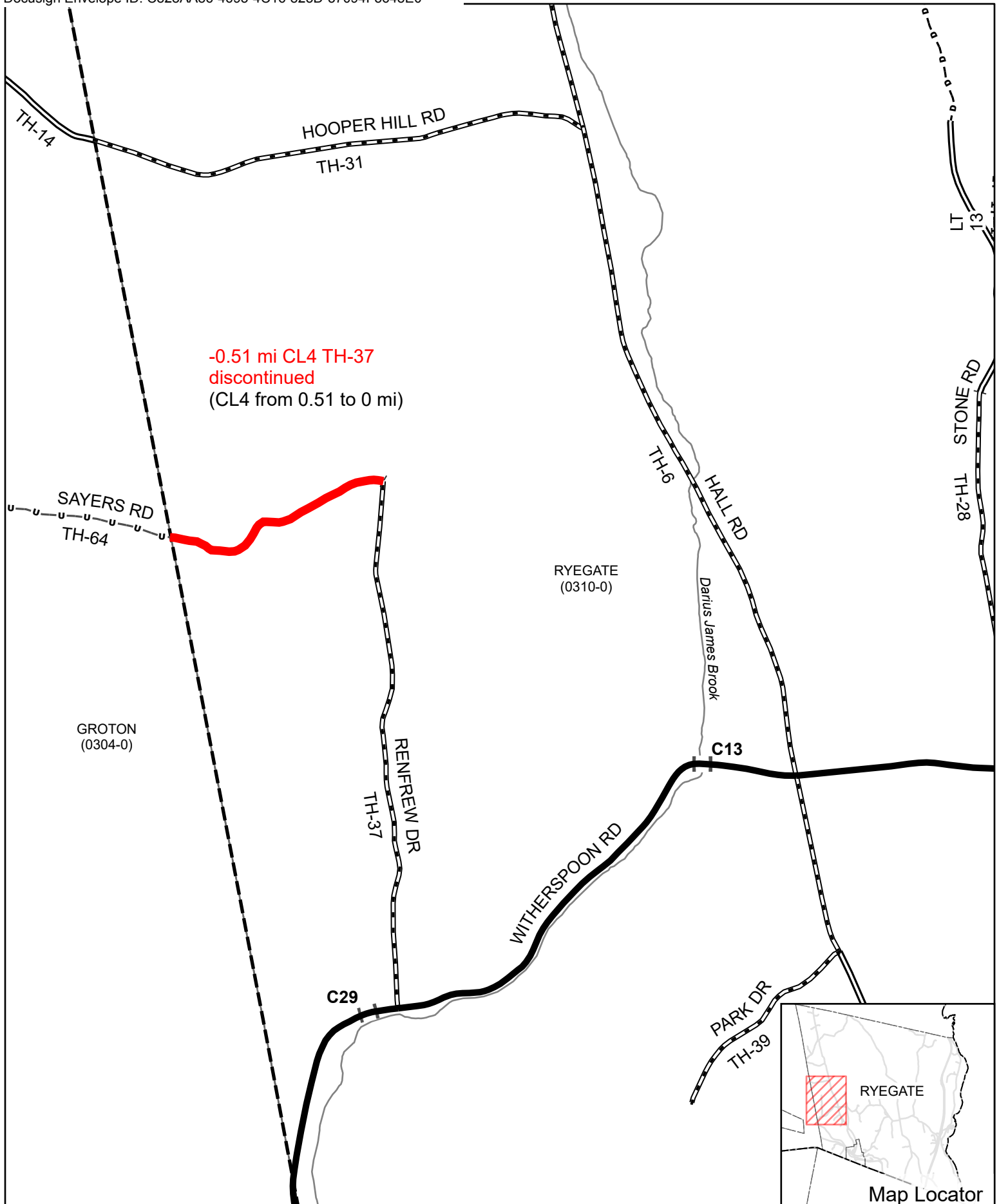

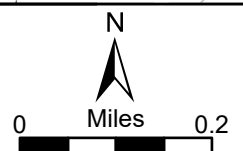

SELECTBOARD MINUTES

December 22, 2025

Town Office & Zoom

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 by Chair Regina Hazel. Other members present: Andrew Smith and Darryl Perkins. Also present: Lauren Nelson and Nelson Elder.

Zoom: None

Possible Additions to Agenda:

Recent Fire on Whitelaw Rd

Fire Dept. Donations and Tax ID number

Andy moved to add the above two additions to Agenda. Darryl seconded the motion and it carried.

The minutes of December 8, 2025 and Public Hearing December 11, 2025 were reviewed. Darryl moved to approve the minutes of both meetings as written. Andy seconded the motion and it carried.

Treasurer's Report: The Board reviewed bills and signed orders.

The Treasurer asked the Board if the Fire Department had their own Tax Id number. The Board stated, being a municipal fire dept., they should use the Town's tax ID number.

Treasurer Salary Adjustment:

The Board acknowledged that the Treasurer does not work 17 ½ hours per week that is required to qualify for health insurance. That being, the Board cannot continue health insurance going forward. As of January 1st, the Board was adding \$100 per week to the salary to help compensate for the loss of health insurance. Lauren requested that health insurance for treasurer position continue until her term ends in March.

After much discussion, Andy moved to increase the Treasurers' salaries to \$100.00 a week to compensate for the loss of health insurance. Darryl seconded the motion and it carried.

Lauren verbally submitted her two week notice to terminate her position as Town Treasurer.

Road Report:

Nelson has been pricing tires for the Loader to budget for the 2026 Budget. The tires on the loader now are the original 2011 tires. It is an expense but will keep the loader going. He stated that a line item will need to be created in the 2026 budget for the Town's portion (20%) of the Better Back Roads Grant to maintain Brown Drive and the Wells River bank. The car has been moved on Elizabeth Farm Rd. Winter maintenance continues due to an active December weather. The grader is ready for winter maintenance. Nelson has signed the Grants in Aid paperwork for state funding of small road projects.

FOR ACTION:

The Board discussed the discontinuance of the untraveled portion of TH# 37 (Renfrew Dr). The Board has 60 days after the Public Hearing to decide. Being no opposition from the public, Darryl moved to approve the discontinuance of the untraveled portion of TH#37 (Renfrew Dr) 0.51 miles west towards Groton. Andy seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Budget Committee Appointments:

The Budget Meeting will be on January 19, 2026. After discussion, Andy moved to appoint Rick Colby, Greg Gandin, John Munson, Fremont and Marsha Nelson, Nancy Perkins, Allana Page, and Tyler Pokines to the Budget Committee. Darryl seconded the motion and it carried.

The Board discussed Town Report preparations.

FOR INFORMATION:

NEKCV Maps and Pricing were discussed. The map of availability of fiber optic broadband in Ryegate is available at the Town Office.

The Board reviewed the Thank You received from 302 CARES for the one-time donation and a Thank you from LRHC for the annual appropriation.

Darryl discussed the details of the fatal fire on Whitelaw Rd. December 18, 2025.

There being no other business. Andy moved to adjourn at 8:20 PM. Darryl seconded the motion and it carried.
