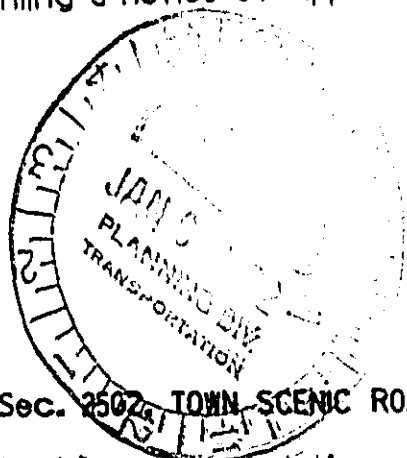
SEC. 305. MEASUREMENT OF HIGHWAYS

(a) A representative of the agency in the presence of the selectmen or their designee shall measure and inspect the class 1, 2 and 3 town highways in each town at least once every ten years. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectmen shall, after review by a representative of the agency, file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2 and 3 town highways, then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2 or 3 town highways are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency.

(d) The selectmen of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description or classification of a town highway may appeal to the board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the board.



Title 19, V. S. A. Section 2502
Added 1985

Sec. 2502. TOWN SCENIC ROADS; DESIGNATION AND DISCONTINUANCE

(a) On recommendation of the planning commission of a municipality, or on the initiative of the legislative body of a municipality, a legislative body may, after one public hearing warned for the purpose, designate or discontinue any town highway or portion of a town highway as a town scenic highway. Such action by the legislative body may be petitioned by the registered voters of the municipality pursuant to the provisions of section 1973 of Title 24.

(b) A town scenic road may be reconstructed or improved in a manner consistent with the standards established by the transportation board, pursuant to section 425 of Title 10. A class 1, 2 or 3 scenic highway shall still be eligible to receive aid pursuant to the provisions of this title.

(c) The legislative body of a municipality may appeal for a variance from standards promulgated by the transportation board. In these appeals the board's decision shall be final.

SELECTMEN'S MEETING
July 18, 1990

Members present: Roderick Ross, Grant Lewis, Vaughn Button

Others present: Edith Baughman, Mike Flock, Jenny Hermenze, Lance Teal, Larry Mitchell, Olga Hallock, Knox Cummin, Chuck Schwer, David Brautigam

The public hearing on THROWING UP TOWN ROAD #24 was called to order at 6:43 p.m. Lance Teal was representing John Teal, who is the only property owner abutting the road. Olga said she wondered what effect closing of the road would have on Teal's insurance coverage; Teal is considering the possibility of putting in a fire hydrant. Teal plans to principally use another private road which goes off Camel's Hump Road through the "Mitchell Farm". Grant reaffirmed the Selectmen's stand that the Town would not be doing any maintenance, plowing, etc on the "Teal Road" if it's thrown up. If, at a later date, there is a request for the Town to take the road over again, it would have to be brought up to State standards before the Town would consider the move. Lance said they feel that the other private road will be easier for their family to maintain. They will still use the "Teal Road", but will have a gate at the foot of it. Their main concern has been security with all of the traffic & people who come up into their dooryard. Time & equipment permitting, the Town could grade or plow Teal's private road at the same fee that such work is done on other private roads in Town. Hearing no objections from any party, the hearing was closed at 6:51 p.m. A motion was made by Vaughn & seconded by Grant to throw up Town Road #24. The motion passed unanimously. In the future, tax maps will not show the road, & acreage will be added to Teal's. Edith will let John Wood know the road has been thrown up. Length of the road is .18 mile.

The minutes of 6/20/90 & 6/25/90 were approved as presented. Two amendments were made to the minutes of 7/9/90-Page 2, paragraph 2 "Brautigam" should read "Chatelain"; Page 2, paragraph 7 "Pinkerton" should read "Pinkham". Minutes were approved as amended.

Rod asked what engendered the Planning Commission's request to be copied any material of concern to them.

No decision has been made on crack sealing. Tatro has not given a price yet for rental of his truck.

There was no discussion of the dust control material.

There was a short discussion of the status of Sherman Hollow Inc.'s Act 250 permit application. Whatever the delay, it was not the fault of the Town or Town's attorney.

The Rathburn property is apparently not sold as yet; Vaughn told Rod the other 2 Selectmen had felt the Town would not have an undue interest in the property.

Warrant for current bills was signed. Olga reported tax monies are coming in slowly.

John Teal driveway permit was signed.

Selectmen reviewed the 2 latest proposal which came in from Pendriss & Griffiths to PAINT THE TOWN HALL. They are both higher than

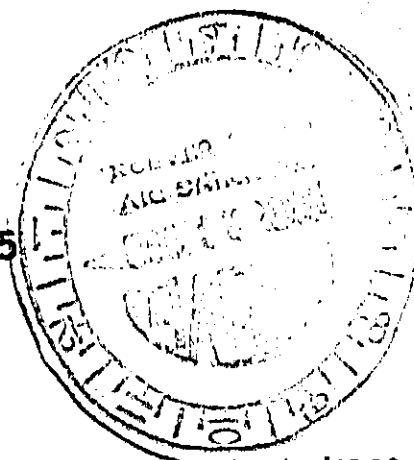

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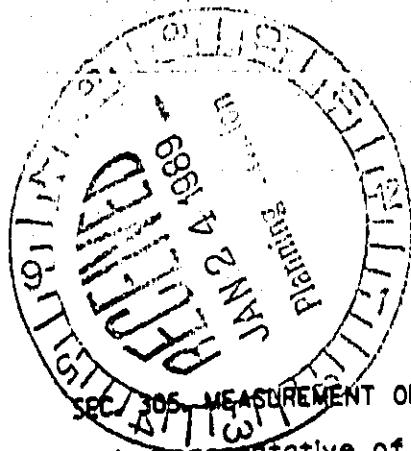
