### 19 V.S.A. § 305. Measurement and inspection

#### § 305. Measurement and inspection

(a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.

(d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.

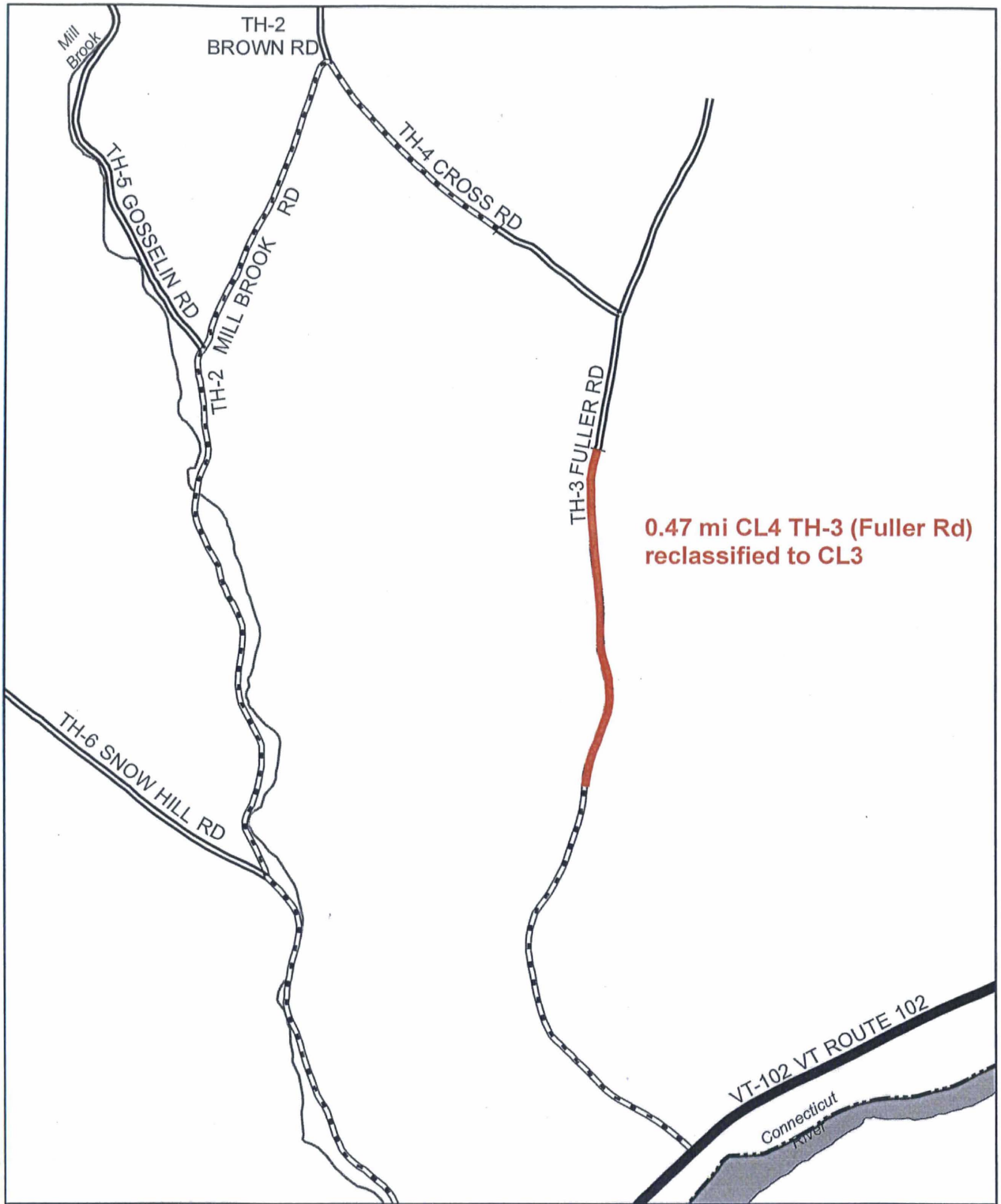
(e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.

(f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.

(g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate.

Hi Wendy,

I've received the Bloomfield Mileage Certificate, but I haven't had a chance to review the documents yet. Regardless, I wanted to initiate clarifying the new length sooner rather than later.

I've attached two maps highlighting (in pink) what I've interpreted to be the portion of Fuller Rd that has been reclassified. Could you verify with someone that it ends precisely where I've shown? If so, then the mileage up

to that point is 0.47 miles beyond the previously mapped end of the class 3 portion, resulting in a new class 3 total of 1.08 miles. However, if end of the class 3 portion is in a slightly different location, the measure should be adjusted accordingly.

Also, could you verify whether the remaining class 4 portion of Fuller Rd is an improved dirt road? Then I can change it to the "Soil" surface type on the Town Highway Map.

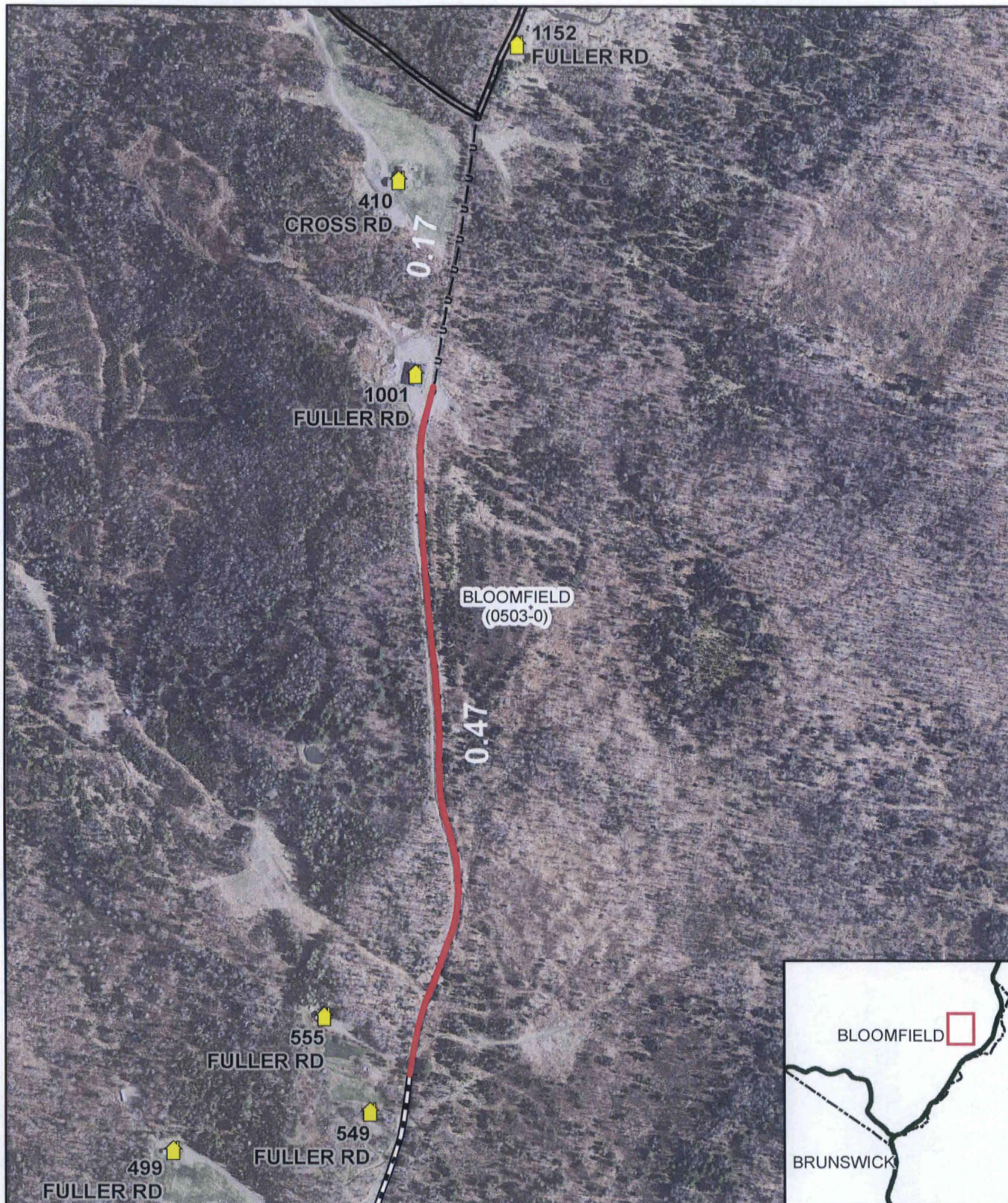

Those in attendance were Selectmen Lance Walling and Samuel Boudle, Town Treasurer Sharon Belknap, Water Commissioner Chester Smart, Town Clerk Wendy Covill, Steve Earley Earley Rubbish Removal, Shawn Covill Lister, and Eric Routhier.

Approved minutes of November meeting. Tabled September and October minutes as Eric Brault was not in attendance to approve.

Orders were viewed and signed for payment.

Steve Earley brought a list of what items they will be picking up now. Many items are currently accepted bulky day. Appliances and electronics are a few items that will now be picked up curbside. Earley did explain that the new recycling guidelines regarding food waste is going to be difficult to do up here being so remote. This is being looked into. Earley asked for a \$25.00 per week raise in his new contract which was signed by the board and will be in effect on January 1, 2016.

Chester Smart reports that the floats are still not fixed. Capitol Well checked out the situation at the reservoir and the pipes that freeze. They recommended rerouting the pipes and installing internal heat tape. Rerouting the pipes so they are mostly underground to prevent freezing. Eric Routhier explained to the board that an internal heat tape could be snaked into the existing pipes with no need to reroute or trench the pipes. He is willing to help with that if needed. Board agreed it would be more cost effective to do it ourselves.

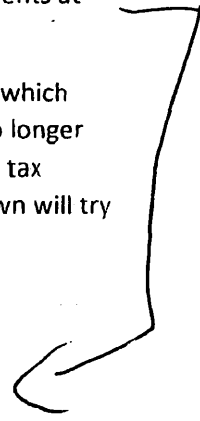

There is also a question regarding a property listed as contiguous which is no longer contiguous. This property is that of Ken Davis. Town needs to address Methodist Church as it is tax exempt and must be insured. Lance said to contact Emmogene Hart regarding the church. Shawn will try to give a Lister's report each month at board meetings.

Sam made motion to adjourn at 6:46 p.m. Lance seconded. Meeting adjourned at 6:47 p.m.
