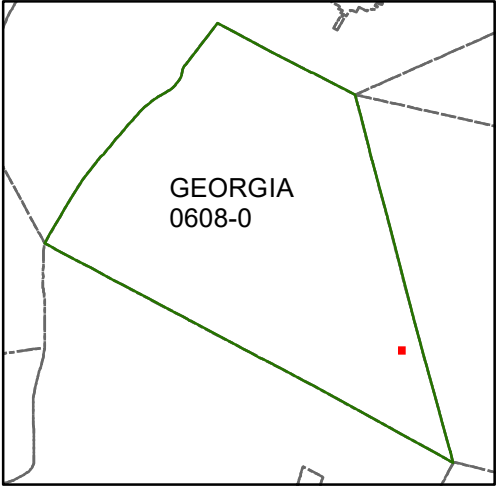

configuration

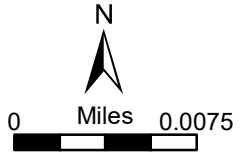


Index Map

The portion in yellow for TH-58 is not a maintained town road and it has been that way for 19 plus years. This would be roughly a 50ft mileage decrease. Silver Lake is a T and it used to be a Y. This was changed in 2012, this has no mileage change.

Good afternoon Cheryl,

Recently we sent you the 2024 Mileage Certificate with a preloaded note under **Part II, Reclassified/Remeasured** section stating "**CL3 TH-58 (Rhodeside Acres) remapped intersection from T to Y at TH-43 - no mileage change**".

Upon looking at street view in Bing and Google Maps (see images below), I noticed that the intersection may not be a true Y as it appears in satellite imagery. It maybe is a T and that the approach to the left from TH-58 to TH-43 may not be used as travel but perhaps a parking area for mailboxes? Or is it used as a turning lane only from TH-43 to turn right onto TH-58?

Can you look into this for us and let us know whether what is highlighted in yellow in the images below is used for travel on this road and if the Town maintains it? From the images below, it does not look like it is maintained to the same level as TH-58. If it is Class 3, like TH-58, then is it plowed in winter? If not that small piece would not be up to Class 3 standards (or NUTs) and we would still map it but it would essentially be counted as Class 4 mileage until brought up to Class 3 standards.

If it is just for parking or pulling over, we would not map it as a road of course and you can cross that preload off of the mileage certificate before signing.

Good afternoon Cheryl,

I just wanted to let the Georgia know that we have 2 upcoming changes for the 2024 Town Highway Map and have noted them on the 2024 Mileage Certificate.

1. Intersection of TH-25 (Silver Lake Rd) and TH-31(Skunk Hill Rd) was reconfigured from a Y to a T (see image below), but there is no effective mileage change.



2. Intersection of TH-58 (Rhodeside Acres) and TH-43 (Stone Bridge Rd) should be mapped as a Y and not a T (see image below). There is no mileage change resultant in this update as well.
