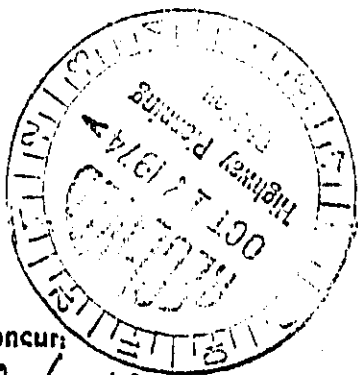

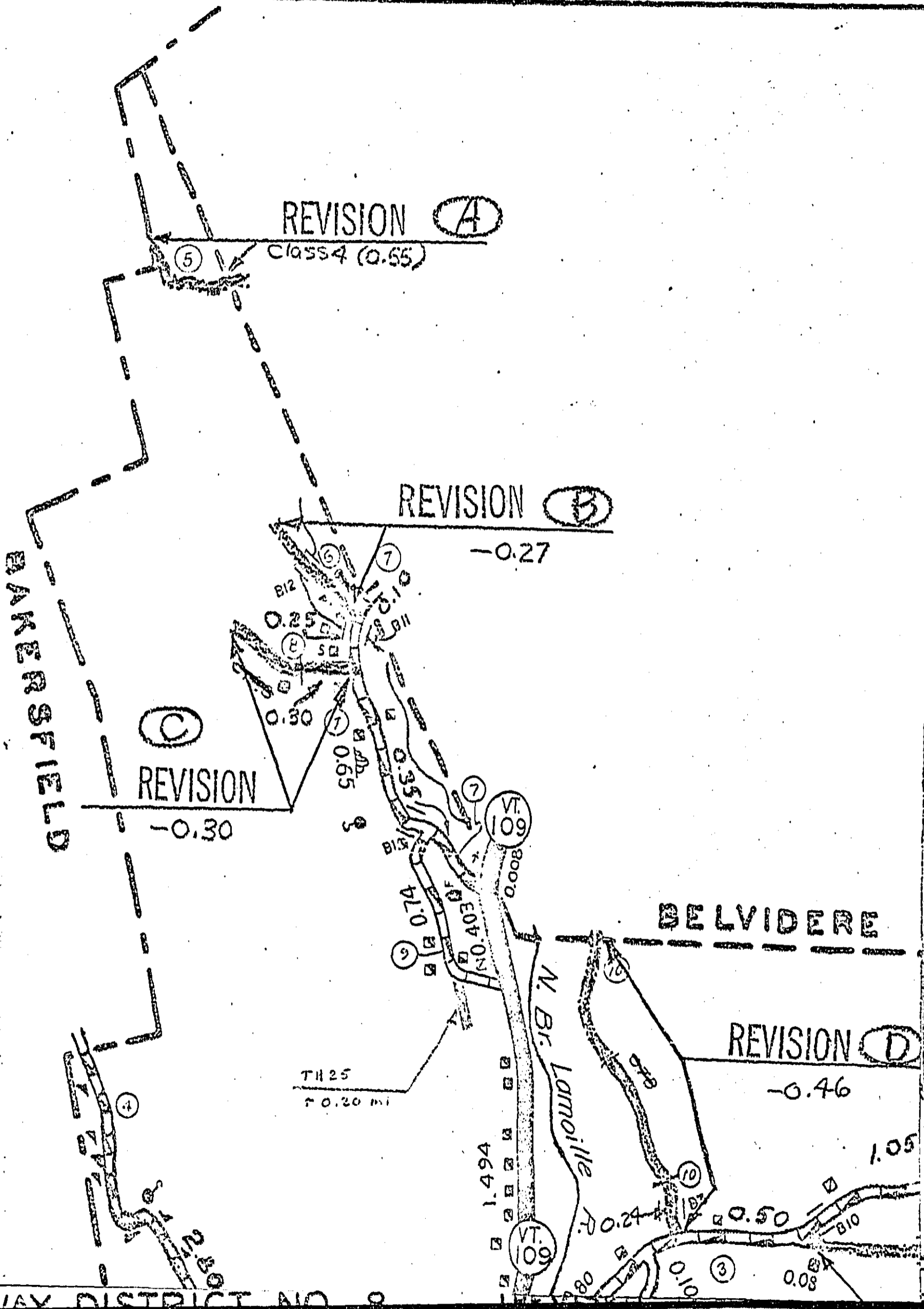

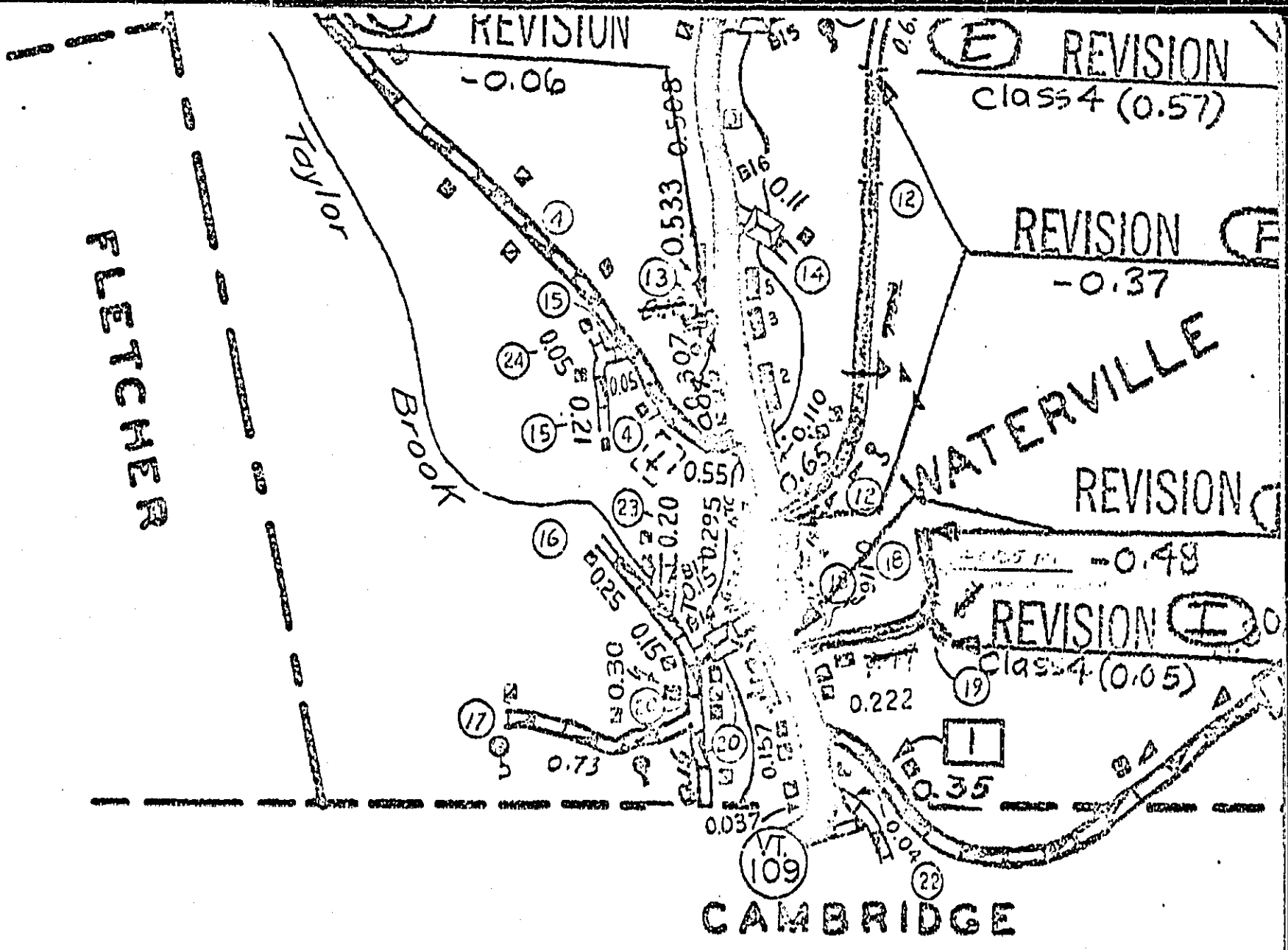

The entries on the enclosed Certificates reflect these as well as the reclassification changes. We will also appreciate your indicating any other changes in your class 3 or class 4 town highway system processed in accordance with the Statutes during the past year. The enclosed form letter explains the procedures to be followed in making changes in class 3 or class 4 mileage.

ALL copies of the completed Certificate should be returned to this office no later than February 15, 1974 in order for any changes to be effective at this time. The town's copy will be approved by the designated representative of the State Highway Board and returned to the Town Clerk.

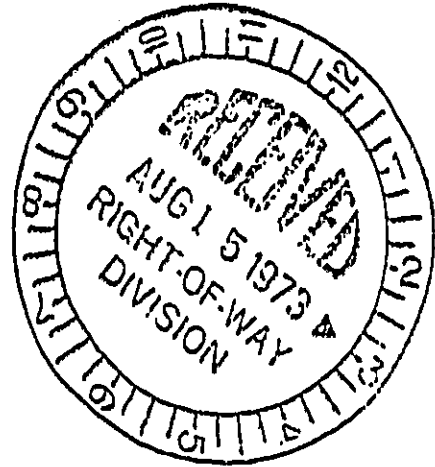

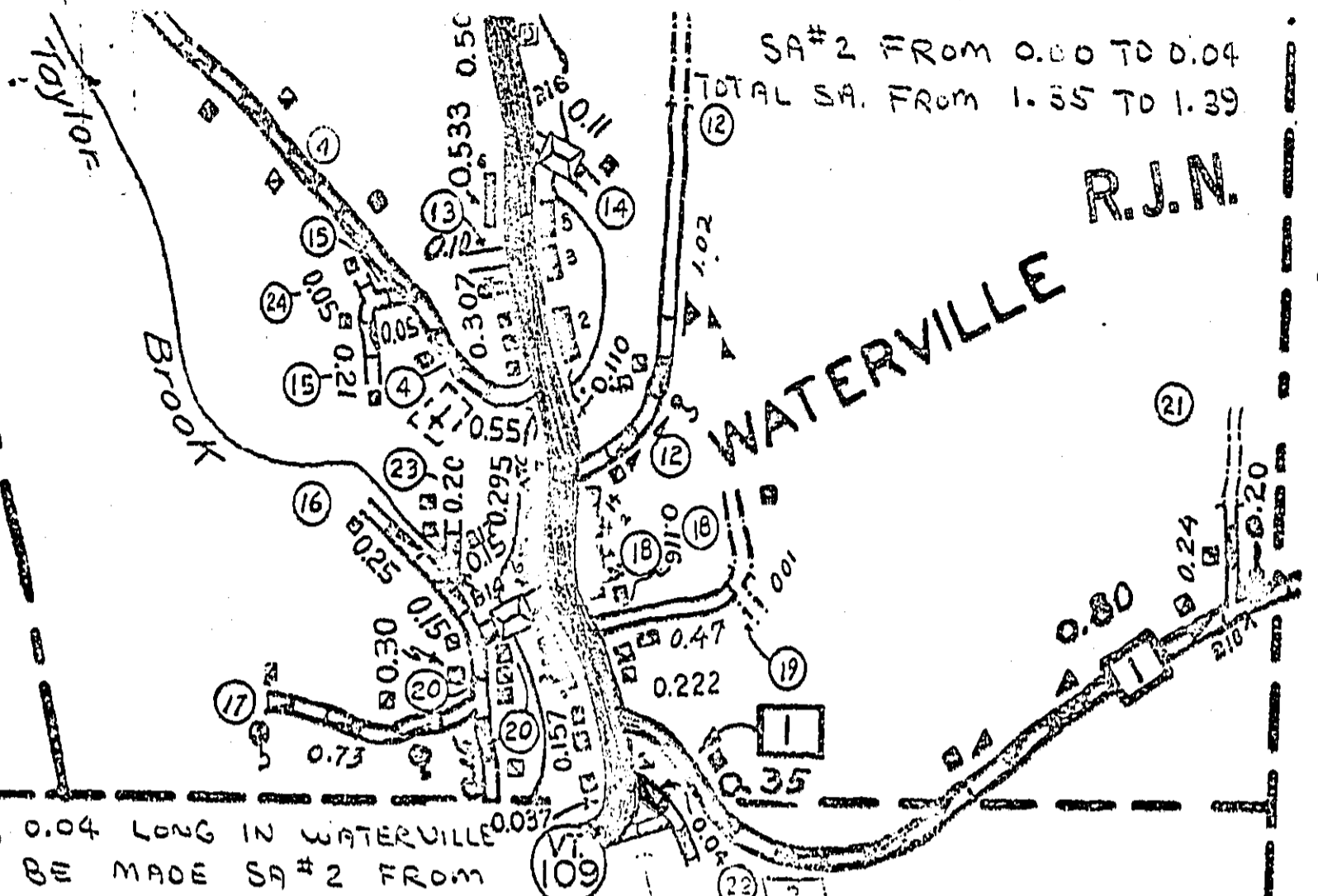
