

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 13, as amended, all the 0.50 miles traveled highways in your town were measured in 1968 by F. Tucker, Town Manager, with Mr. Otis of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage are indicated on the enclosed map and are explained on the attached breakdown sheet.

The second breakdown sheet indicates those roads for which we will require copies of the rights-of-way and Certificates of Completion and Opening before they can be added to your Town Highway mileage.

Also, due to remeasurement, SA 1 was reduced 0.000 miles in length, SA 2 was increased 0.030 miles and SA 3 was decreased 0.080 miles.

Mile 19, V. 3d, Section 15, states, in part, "The Selectmen of each town, with the assistance of a representative of the State Highway Board shall measure the travelled highways defined in Section 1 of this title, at least once every ten years, not including pent roads and trails. Annually, on or before March 15, the Selectmen shall file with the Town Clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurement of all highways including all new highways built and all highways abandoned, during the year previous thereto, not including pent roads and trails."

This measurement was done the 26th, 27th and 28th of July 1959, by Mr. Guy Beaver, with Mr. Beaver of this office, as the attached photostory will verify.

Perhaps you do not desire to make any other additions to your Town mileage other than those supported by Affidavits or Certificates, and we respect your wishes in this matter. However, in any event, the 3.26 miles of roads listed as not travelled, on the accompanying "breakdown sheet of re-measurement changes," should be deducted from your Town Highway mileage.
