



Gentlemen:

Thank you for the prompt submission of your Highway Mileage Certificate.

However, we find that there is 0.16 mi^s that should be but is not included
in your mileage figures.

Because of the relocations during the Greenboro - Craftsbury construction project No. 3 0955(1) on former State Aid Highways 3 and 5, in Craftsbury, there would be two sections of former State Aid Highway existing from the start of the realignment on both of these highways to the old junction of State Aid Highways 3 and 5, which should revert to the Town System.

As these sections are necessary to complete the connection between former State Aid No. 3 and present State Aid No. 2, it is felt that the omission from your mileage was just an oversight.

If you could add 0.16 miles to your copy of the Highway Mileage Certificate, we shall do the same on the copies submitted.
