Gentlemen:

Due to the transfer of VT 111 to the State Highway System the following mileage changes occurred during the past year:

State Highway mileage increased 3,763 miles
State Aid Highway mileage decreased 3,800 miles.

Alpen Road	0.17 mile



The Selectmen of the Town of Derby, having proposed to lay out and establish a highway from the Main Street in the Village of Derby Center, in a general easterly direction to the town line of the Town of Holland, and being one and one-half ($1\frac{1}{2}$) rods in each direction from the center of the present traveled portion of Route 111, hereby report that as a result of said proposal, notices were left with or at the residence of all persons owning or interested in lands through which the highway is proposed to be laid out, except that as to such of those persons as do not reside in the State of Vermont, such notices were left at the residence of his known agent or attorney, if he had one in the State, and, if not, with or at the residence of the occupant of the land in connection with which the interest of the person required to be notified arises and, for lack thereof, such notices were left with the Town Clerk in the town where such land lies. Such notices were all delivered twelve or more days prior to the date of the hearing.





Gentlemen:

With regard to the completion of the enclosed Highway Mileage Certificates, we wish to call your attention to changes in State and Town Highway mileage in your Town.

Due to 1963 construction, the mileage for Interstate Route 91 and ramps, has changed from 3,265 to 5,370 miles, an increase of 2,105 miles. However, because the construction plans for the 1963 project in Derby did not show Village Lines, all of the mileage for Interstate 91 and ramps was inadvertently shown in the mileage for Derby Town on last year's mileage certificates. Now that this has been discovered, we find it necessary to transfer 1,294 miles of Interstate 91 and ramps to the mileage for Derby Line Village, leaving the net increase in Interstate mileage for Derby Town at 0,811 miles. As we have done in the past, we have noted on the mileage certificates that the town is not assessed for Interstate mileage.

Also due to 1962 Interstate construction there are the following changes in Town Highway mileage in the Town of Derby:

T-59	Decreased by 0.04 mile - the amount taken in Interstate Right-of-Way.
T-16	Decreased by 0.04 mile - the amount taken in Interstate Right-of-Way.
Frontage Road (T-62)	This increases Town Highway mileage by 0.16 mile for the Town's portion of a new frontage road coming out of Derby Line Village into the town.

We have entered the net change in State Highway mileage on the enclosed certificates for your convenience and would appreciate your entering the amounts of 0.16 mile (for T-62) as "Town Highways Added" and 0.08 mile (for T-16 and T-59) as "Town Highways Subtracted", as well as noting any change that may have taken place during the past year.







Gentlemen:

With regard to the completion of the enclosed Highway Mileage Certificates, we wish to call your attention to changes in State and Village Highway mileage in your Village.

Because the construction plans for the 1962 Interstate project in the Town of Derby did not show Village lines, all of the mileage for Interstate 91 and ramps was inadvertently shown in the mileage for Derby Town on last year's Highway Mileage Certificates. Now that this has been discovered, we find it necessary to transfer 1.294 miles of Interstate 91 and ramps from Derby Town to Derby Line Village, with an additional 0.079 mile of ramps not previously shown in either place, for a total of the 1.373 miles which is now shown on the mileage certificates with a notation at the bottom of the certificate that the village is not assessed for Interstate mileage.

Also due to 1962 Interstate construction there are the following changes in Village Highway mileage:

Felow Hill: Decreased by 0.03 mile - amount taken for Interstate Right-of-Way.

Frontage Road: Increases Village Highway mileage by 0.29 mile (Y-5) balance of frontage road is in the town. Road goes from Felow Hill in Village to State Aid No. 1 in the town.

We have entered the change in State Highway mileage on the enclosed certificates for your convenience and would appreciate your entering the amounts of 0.29 mile (for Y-5) as "Village Highways Added" and 0.03 mile (for Felow Hill) as "Village Highways Subtracted", as well as noting any change that may have taken place on Village Streets during the past year.

If you have any questions regarding the completion of the enclosed mileage certificates, your District Highway Engineer has a copy of this letter and will be glad to assist you.
