Gentlemen:

Due to the late receipt of the necessary information, Town Highways 10B and 23C could not be added to your Town Highway mileage in 1967.

We have reviewed the right-of-way which you submitted and find everything in order. We do, however, have a question. On your 1967 Highway Mileage Certificate you indicated the length of T 10B as 0.25 mile. According to the copy of the Warranty Deed which you submitted, this highway is 5,250 feet or 0.99 mile in length. Would you please clarify for us the large discrepancy in mileage?

Please note that we have included only the mileage for T 23C on the enclosed 1968 Highway Mileage Certificate. We will not include the mileage for T 10B until we hear from you.

We will also appreciate your entering any other changes in Town Highway mileage processed in accordance with the Statutes during the past year.

We will appreciate your giving this matter your immediate attention since the deadline for submitting Mileage Certificates was March 15.

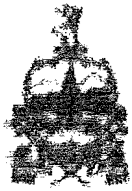

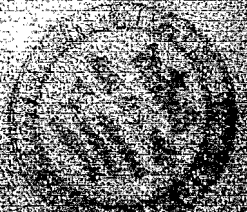
