Regarding your letter of July 22 about the Orleans Village State Aid roads, we submit the following explanation of the mileage:

Much of the confusion is due to re-description of the state aid roads to what we intended to be a more logical order following Route 50 becoming State Highway.

Please refer to the attached map, which shows the former State Aid numbers as well as the new ones which are marked in red.

New State Aid No. 1, which begins at Chandler Avenue and extends easterly along Franklin Street and Willoughby Avenue, was formerly a combination of S.A. No. 4, S.A. No. 1 and S.A. No. 2.

New State Aid No. 2, which is Barton Road, was formerly a section of S.A. No. 1.

New State Aid No. 3, which is East Street beyond Willoughby Avenue, is the sum as before.

New State Aid No. 4, which is Maple Street to the village line, was formerly a section of S.A. No. 1.

The overall difference in mileage is actually 0.324 miles, and is due to the fact that Franklin Street (from Chandler Ave. to Franklin Town Line) and Willoughby Ave. (School Street to the Barton Town Line), have become part of the State Highway System.

We trust that the above information will help to explain the apparent differences in mileage.

Dear Sir:

The new Selection of State Aid highways in the Village of Orleans has not been signed as yet due to the fact that we cannot reconcile the differences.

On State Aid #1 the former mileage was 0.965 and the new figure is 0.763. As this is on Route 58 we can understand this change.

On State #2 you give a mileage of 0.510. The old mileage was 0.565. Number 3 is O.K. On #4 the old mileage was 0.343 and you have 0.274. You give a total mileage now of 1.925, where the old mileage was 2.249. Deducting 0.2 for Route 58 the correct mileage should be 2.049.

This figure of 2.249 has been used for many years and the Village authorities claim they have made no reduction on routes 2 and 4.
