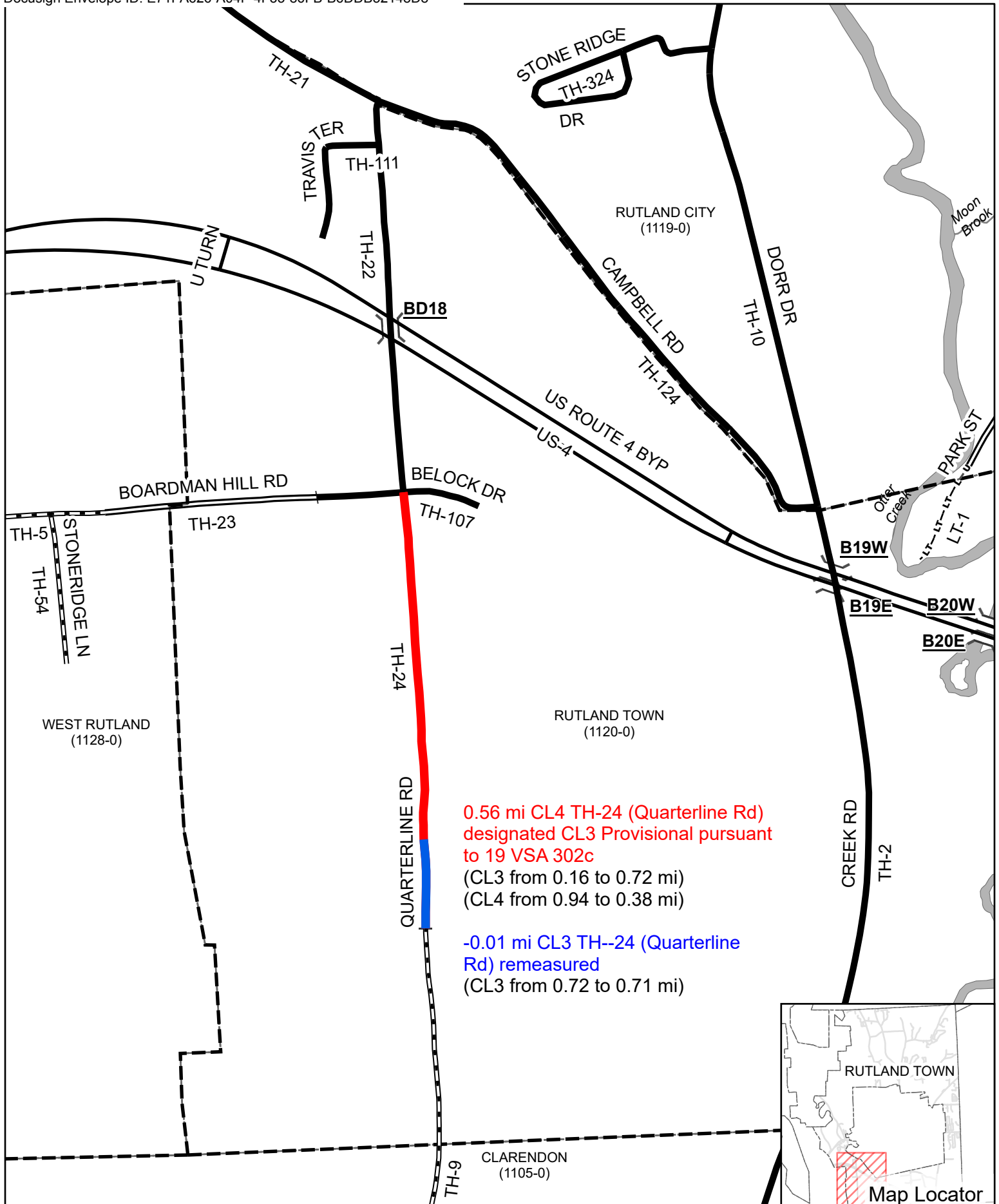

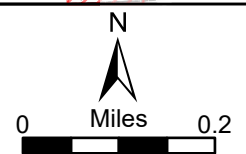

Good afternoon Bill,

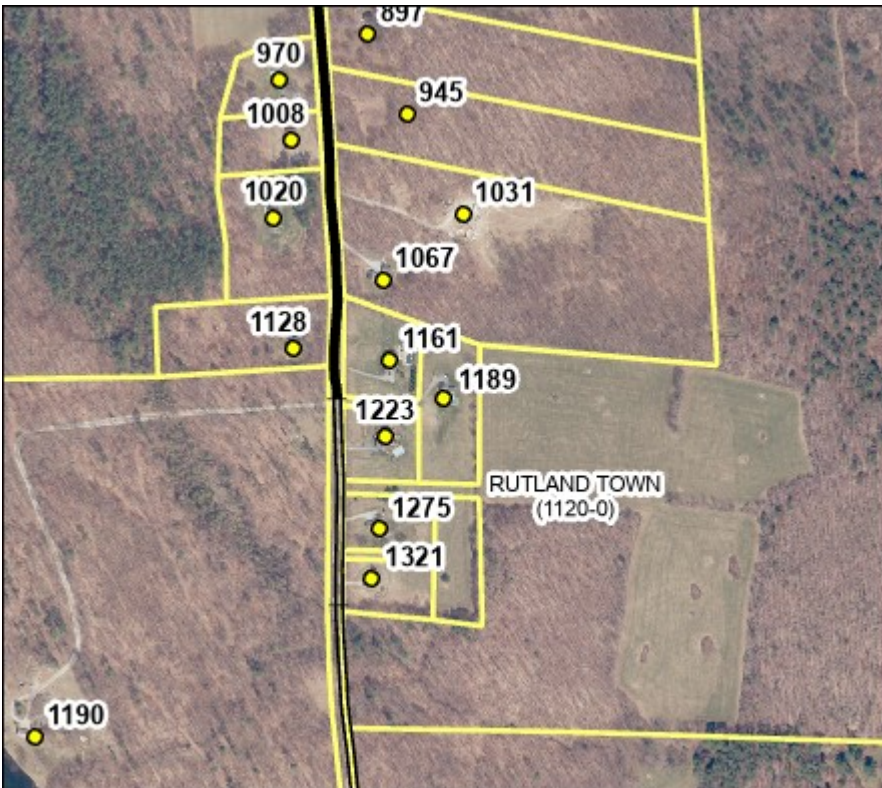
I just wanted to summarize in writing the path forward for Quarterline Rd (TH-24) that we discussed by phone last Friday.

If the selectboard decides to reclassify the class 4 portions of Quarterline Rd as class 3, they will need to re-submit Rutland Town's mileage certificate, and you can submit a change to class 3 provisional on the certificate (see details below). Once the reclassification has occurred, send us the documentation and we will remove the provisional status (or return it to class 4 if there hasn't been a legal reclassification within 5 years).

Assuming all of TH-24 will be CL3 to the town line, the change this year can be written as:

*0.94 mi CL4 TH-24 (Quarterline Rd) designated CL3 Provisional pursuant to 19 VSA 302c*

Or...If only the portion connecting to the CL3 segment will be reclassified, I would need to reconfirm where the CL3 section ends (at a driveway or at the southern end of the southernmost subdivision or further?) to verify the exact mileage change needed.

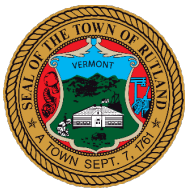

Hello Bill,

I decided to dig a little deeper into the history of Quarterline Road, and the 1975 Mileage Certificate (attached) might have some relevant information.

According to the 1975 Certificate, Quarterline Rd (TH-24) was one of two highways in Rutland Town that underwent "Field reclassifications" to class 4 when Act 63 (defining class 3 and class 4 highways) went into effect. One possibility is that the Town forgot about this field reclassification and assumed that TH-24 was still entirely class 3, but this seems unlikely to me given that a section was known to be class 3 when the 2009 reclassification occurred. Another possibility is that a portion was reclassified as class 3 after 1975, and local knowledge might help determine when that would most likely have occurred to facilitate finding records of the reclassification. It is also possible that the Town began using part of TH-24 as a class 3 highway at some point without actually going through a legal reclassification.

If there is no record of the section of Quarterline Rd in question being reclassified as class 3 between 1975 and 2009, then we would recommend legally reclassifying it as class 3 following the procedures

outlined in State Statutes and the Orange Book for Town Officials:

Hopefully it won't come to that, because I'm sure it would be a drag to have to clean up "old issues".

Good afternoon Bill,

Dave Sears recommended that I reach out to you to obtain more information about the history of TH-24 (Quarterline Rd).

In 2009, the Mapping Section processed a reclassification of 800 ft from class 4 (CL4) to class 3 (CL3), and based on the information accompanying the 2009 Certificate of Highway Mileage (see attached), that section extends approximately from the drive to 1189 Quarterline Rd (where pavement ends) for 800 ft. The image on the last page of the 2009 certificate seems to correspond well with how we are mapping that section (see image below). However, we were never aware that the portion of Quarterline Rd between this reclassified section and Boardman Hill Rd (approximately 0.55 mi) was ever made CL3, and therefore its mileage has not been included in the CL3 mileage totals that is used for allocating State funding for CL3 Town Highways.

The only additional information I have is from the field inventory notes of Quarterline Rd in 1994 (see attached) when VTrans measured the road with Road Commissioner Marshall Fish present, and indicating that TH-24 was CL4, suggesting that a reclassification may have occurred after 1994 and before 2009.

If you provide us with the documentation associated with that reclassification, we can update Rutland Town's map and the mileage totals.

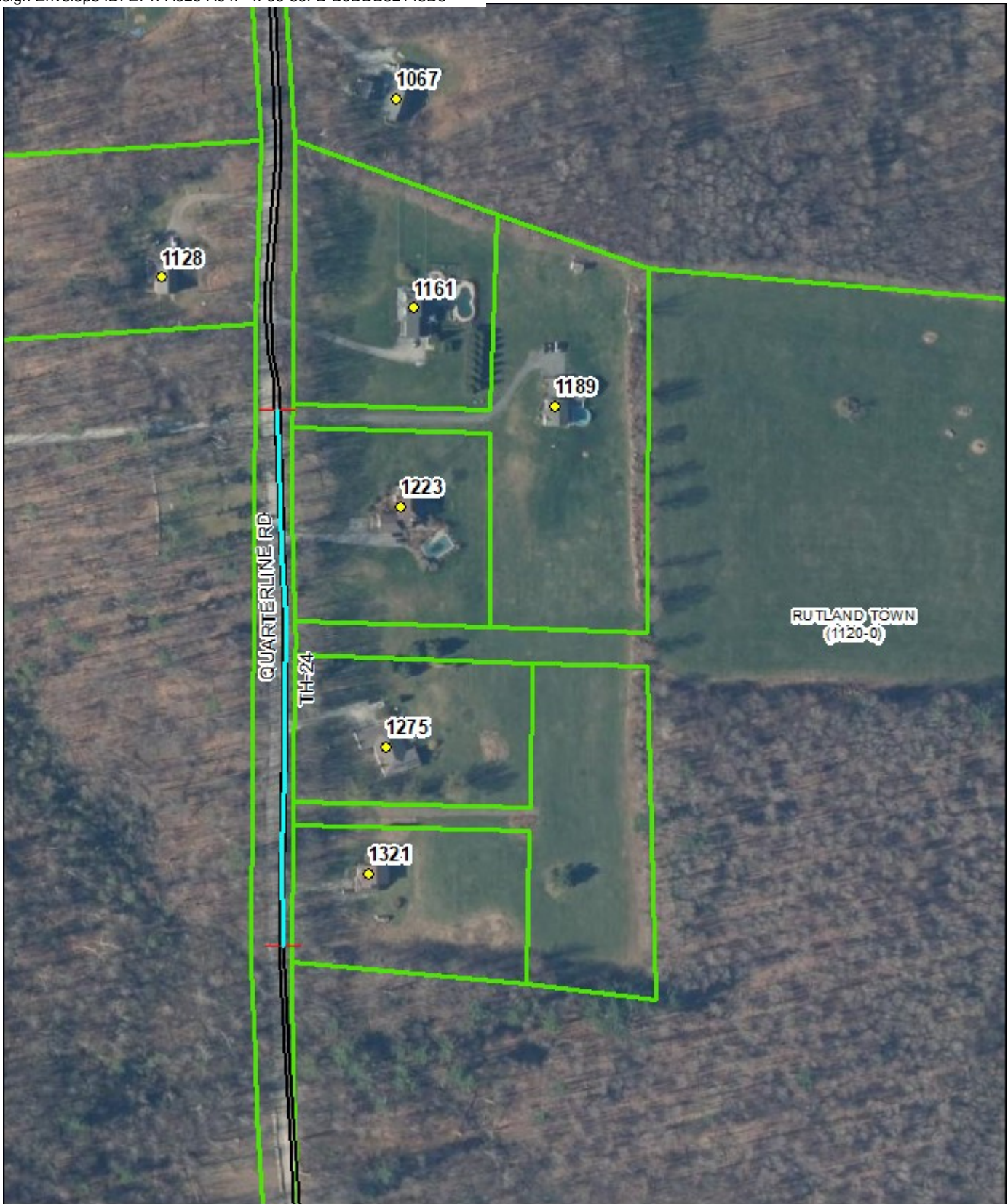
Also, did I understand Dave correctly when I spoke with him earlier today... I thought he said that the CL3 portion of Quarterline Rd ends where the pavement ends? Does winter plowing include the 800 ft of gravel road south of 1189 Quarterline Rd as well as the paved portion?

With some luck, we might be able to get this resolved in time to add it to the 2026 Mileage Certificate!
