Gentlemen:

With regard to the completion of the enclosed Highway Mileage Certificates, we wish to call your attention to a possible change in Town Highway mileage in your town, as shown on the enclosed map.

According to an inventory on May 17, 1962, by Mr. Baker of this office, the highway extending from Route Vt. 30 to Town Highway No. 22 is 0.11 mile and is not included in your present Town Highway mileage.
