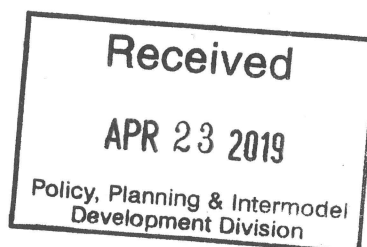

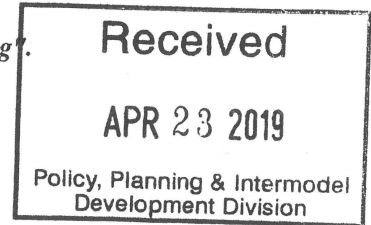

I have included the certificate as signed by the Selectboard but there are two changes that need to be made.

Highway 32 – Webster Road


This road was discontinued some time ago and was improperly marked as a Class 4 on the map. The complete hearing process was done at the time and finalized in a settlement from the Superior Court. I have attached the paperwork from that time. There is additional paperwork in the files so if you need additional items, please let me know and I will see what I can find.

Highway 20 – Devlin Road

In 2013 adjustments were made on the highway certificate based on the information that we had at the time. Since that time, we were able to get more information from the surveyor and determine that the starting point for this survey is a pipe 67 feet below the old bend in the road near the entrance to the cemetery. The old road which is a driveway servicing one house (Spencer) was reclassified as a trail in 2013. The highway foreman found the pin and measured the 2,149 feet described in the survey and marked the end of the road. The first 1,749 feet of Devlin Road is class 3 to the Kilkenny driveway referenced in the 2013 submission. The road continues as a class 4 road for an additional 891 feet to the end point of the survey. I have included a handwritten sketch that might help.

NOTICE OF DECISION TO DISCONTINUE ROAD

WEBSTER ROAD- Following a site visit on March 12, 2001 and hearings held on March 12, 2001, at which the testimony of interested parties was heard, a majority of the Town of Duxbury Select Board, pursuant to the authority granted to it under 19 V.S.A. §710, finds and judges that the public good, necessity and convenience of the inhabitants of Duxbury requires the discontinuance of the entire length of Webster Rd. from the existing class 4 status. A description of the highway is attached hereto and incorporated herewith. This notice shall be served upon adjoining or abutting landowners by certified mail. This decision may be appealed to the Superior Court within 20 days from the effective date of the notice.

Pursuant to 19 V.S.A. § 33, the Selectboard of the Town of Duxbury hereby provides notice that it caused a survey to be completed of the existing highway known as Devlin Rd. This survey was performed and notice hereby provided at this time order to establish record Town ownership of the road, since at the time the road was actually taken over, the legal process for taking the road over was not completed. The purpose of the survey is to establish for the record that Devlin Rd. as described below is a Duxbury Town Road with all the rights and responsibilities appurtenant thereto.

Based on the Town Tax Map, the following abutting landowners were notified according to statute of the survey: Brusa, Spencer, Devlin, Kimball, Kilkenney, Sherman, and Voss.

Devlin Rd. is hereby described as follows:

As a Right Of Way being 24.75' either side of the center line of Devlin Rd. being shown on a Map of Survey recorded of even date herewith in the Town of Duxbury Land Records and more particularly described as follows:

Right of Way being 24.75 feet either side of the center line of Devlin Road, more particularly described as follows:

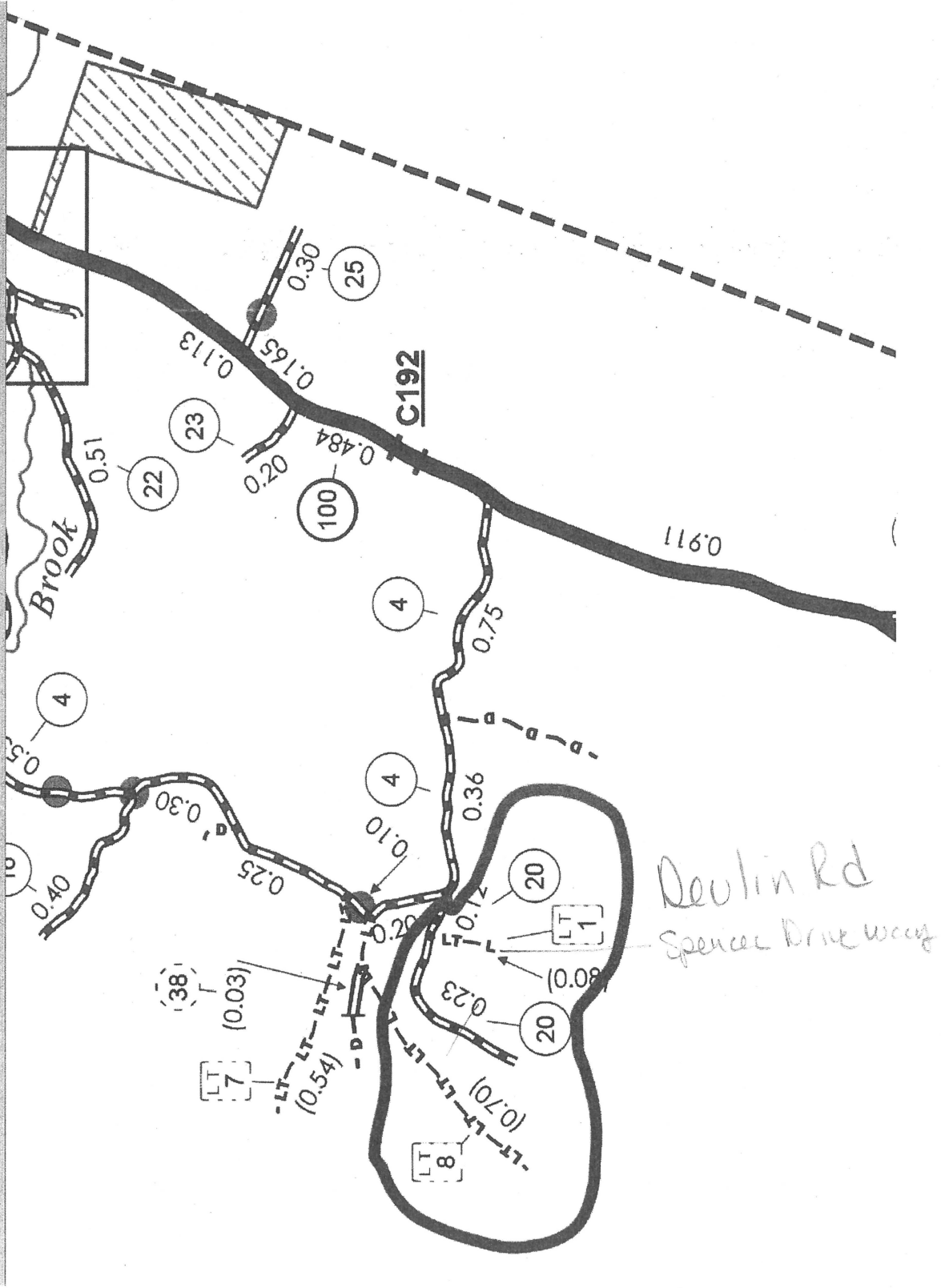
