Vermont Statutes Annotated

19 V.S.A. § 305. Measurement and inspection

§ 305. Measurement and inspection

(a) After reasonable notice to the selectboard, a representative of the agency may measure and inspect the class 1, 2, and 3 town highways in each town to verify the accuracy of the records on file with the agency. Upon request, the selectboard or their designee shall be permitted to accompany the representative of the agency during the measurement and inspection. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectboard shall file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2, 3, or 4 town highways, trails, or unidentified corridors are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) All class 1, 2, 3, and 4 town highways and trails shall appear on the town highway maps by July 1, 2015.

(d) At least 45 days prior to first including a town highway or trail that is not clearly observable by physical evidence of its use as a highway or trail and that is legally established prior to February 10, 2006 in the sworn statement required under subsection (b) of this section, the legislative body of the municipality shall provide written notice and an opportunity to be heard at a duly warned meeting of the legislative body to persons owning lands through which a highway or trail passes or abuts.

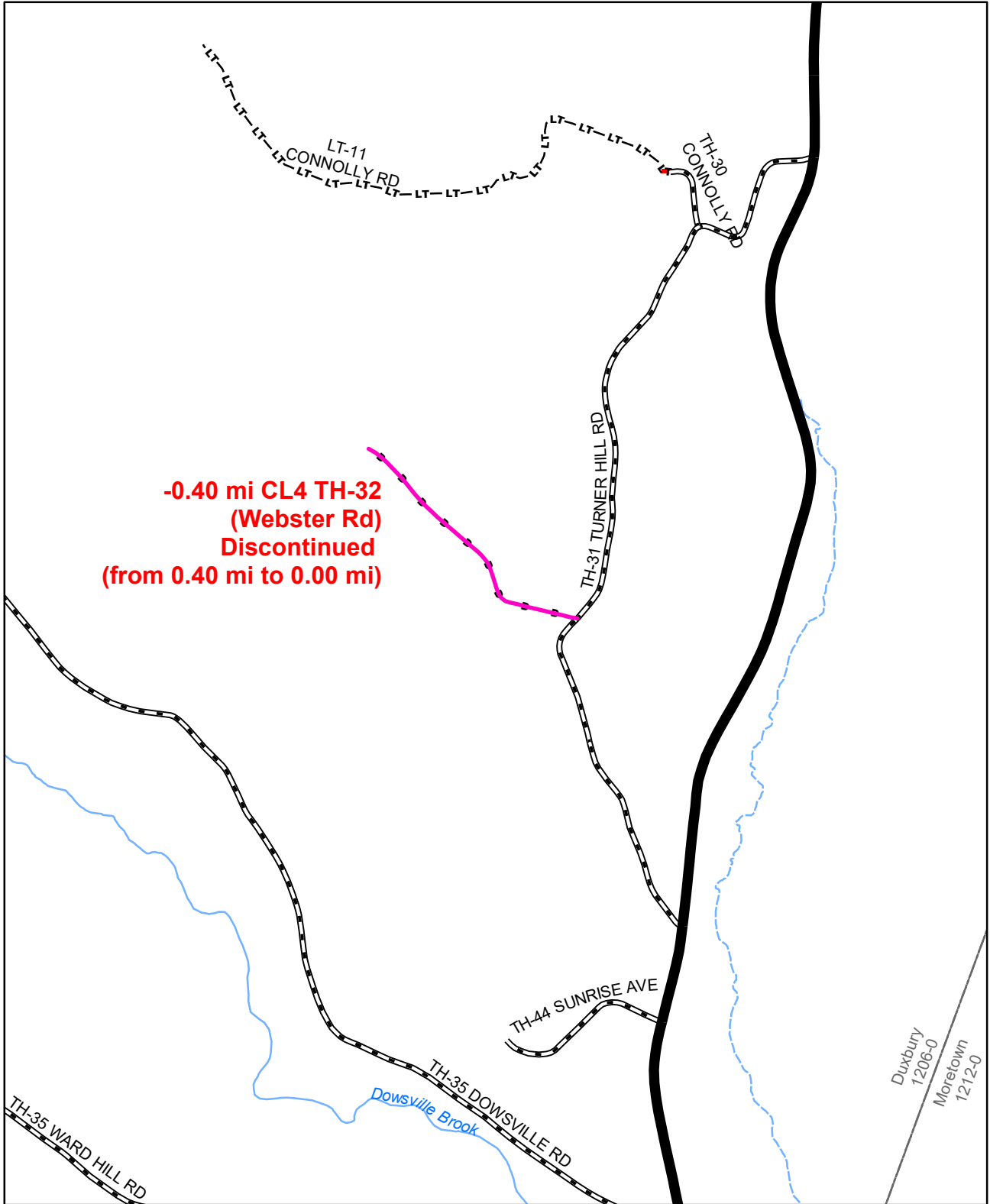
(e) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency. A request by a municipality to the agency for a change in mileage shall include a description of the affected highway or trail, a copy of any surveys of the affected highway or trail, minutes of meetings at which the legislative body took action with respect to the changes, and a current town highway map with the requested deletions and additions sketched on it. A survey shall not be required for class 4 town highways that are legally established prior to February 10, 2006. All records filed with the agency are subject to verification in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.

(f) The selectboard of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description, or classification of a town highway may appeal to the transportation board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the transportation board.

(g) The agency shall provide each town with a map of all of the highways in that town together with the mileage of each class 1, 2, 3, and 4 highway, as well as each trail, and such other information as the agency deems appropriate.

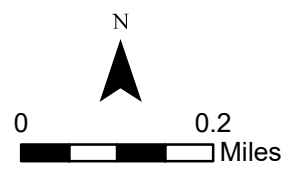


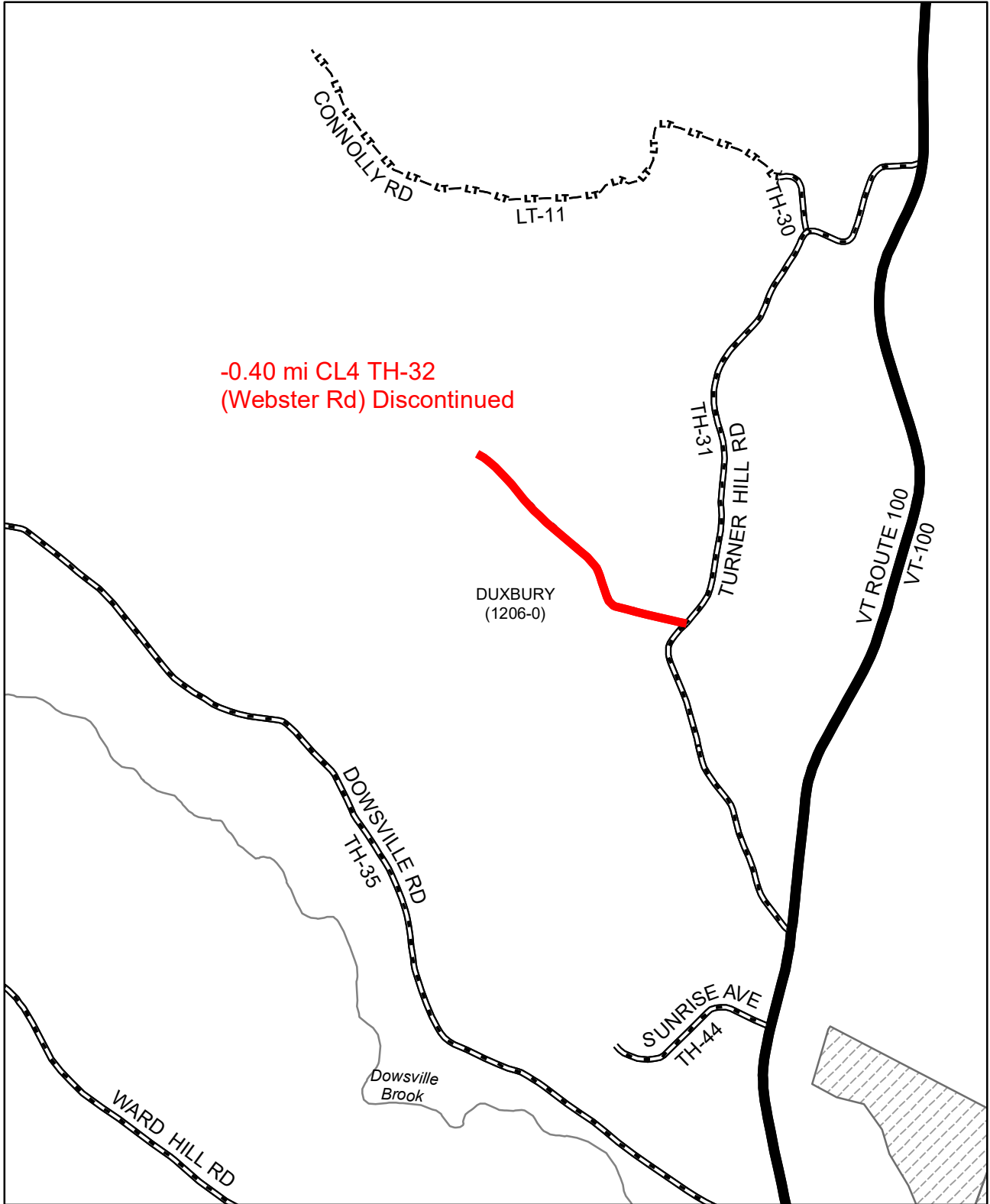

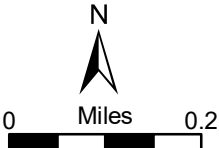

The discontinuance of Webster Rd has been fully processed.

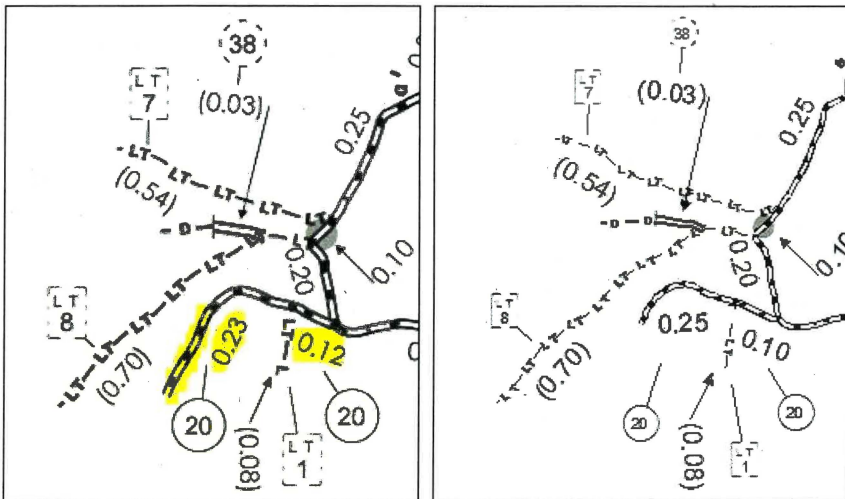
Although we are not changing the total class 3 mileage of Devlin Rd, I did update how the map looks, because we were showing class 3 road extending beyond the Kilkenny driveway. The mileage we had on record (0.35 mi) matches the updated map. However, both the survey and our map data indicate that 0.10 mi is before the intersection with LT-1, and 0.25 mi is after LT-1. (See the before and after map excerpts below). So the survey definitely helped map the class 3 section more accurately.

If the Town wants to add a class 4 segment onto the end of Devlin Rd (TH-20), we would need documentation indicating that it is owned by the town and has been accepted by the Selectboard as a Town Highway (dedication and acceptance), or established legally by following the process of laying out a highway described in State statutes. We can discuss this further if the Selectboard wants to add this highway to the map.

Thanks again for your help making the Duxbury Highway Map as accurate as possible!

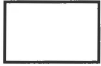
I hope you are well, and that things are proceeding as smoothly as possible in Duxbury as everyone adjusts to some pretty dramatic changes!

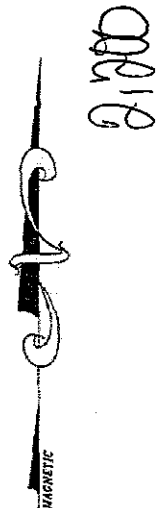
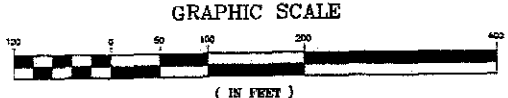


VICINITY MAP

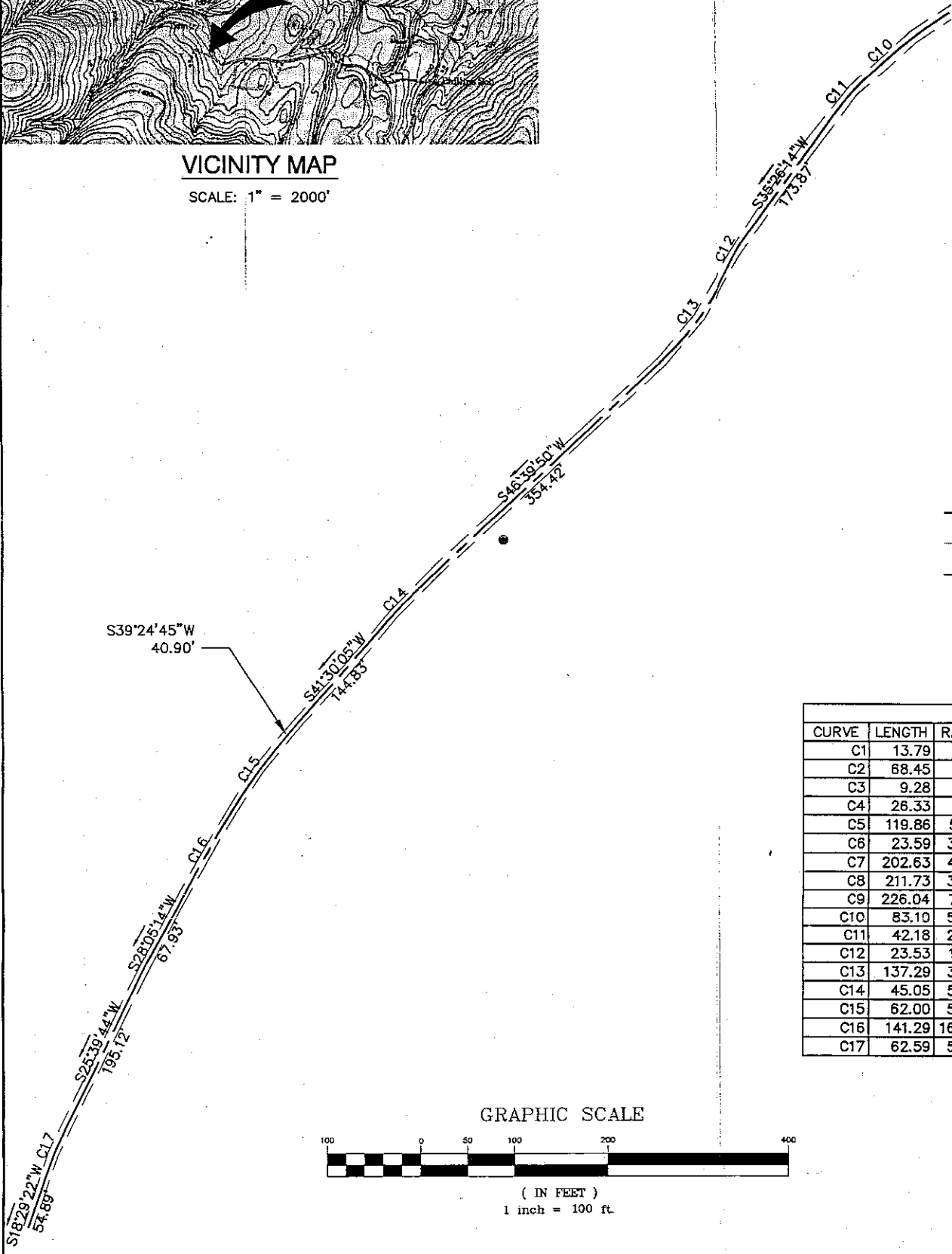

Just as a note for next year, the Mileage Certificates need to be submitted to VTrans by February 20th to be processed in a timely manner and to insure that Town Highway Map reflects the current mileage.

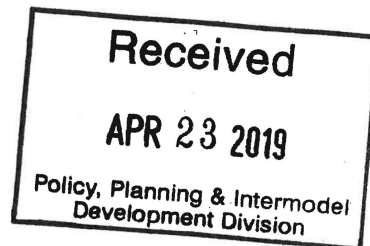

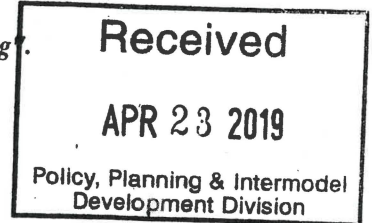

I have included the certificate as signed by the Selectboard but there are two changes that need to be made.

Highway 32 – Webster Road

This road was discontinued some time ago and was improperly marked as a Class 4 on the map. The complete hearing process was done at the time and finalized in a settlement from the Superior Court. I have attached the paperwork from that time. There is additional paperwork in the files so if you need additional items, please let me know and I will see what I can find.

Highway 20 – Devlin Road

In 2013 adjustments were made on the highway certificate based on the information that we had at the time. Since that time, we were able to get more information from the surveyor and determine that the starting point for this survey is a pipe 67 feet below the old bend in the road near the entrance to the cemetery. The old road which is a driveway servicing one house (Spencer) was reclassified as a trail in 2013. The highway foreman found the pin and measured the 2,149 feet described in the survey and marked the end of the road. The first 1,749 feet of Devlin Road is class 3 to the Kilkenny driveway referenced in the 2013 submission. The road continues as a class 4 road for an additional 891 feet to the end point of the survey. I have included a handwritten sketch that might help.
