
Dear Mr. Landry:

I am writing to inform you that the Waterbury Board of Selectmen have reclassified T.H.56, upgrading it from a class 4 highway to a class 3 highway. The entire length of the highway, including Bridge #25 has been upgraded.

I have enclosed the Town Clerk's certified copy of the Selectmen's Order Reclassification of a highway for your records. Could you forward this information to the proper office so the town highway map gets revised as necessary?

SELECTMEN'S ORDER

RECLASSIFICATION OF A HIGHWAY

BE IT REMEMBERED that after examining the premises and hearing interested parties the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Waterbury judge that the public good, necessity and convenience of the inhabitants of the Town of Waterbury requires that Town Highway #56 ("Old Bolton Road", so-called) be reclassified from Class four (4) to Class three (3).

The portion hereby reclassified is from the intersection of Little River Road and T.H. #56 in a generally easterly direction along T.H. #56 as it is now laid out, to the most easterly end of the bridge over Little River, which is the end of the Town Highway, a distance of approx. 0.18 miles, as shown on Vermont General Highway Map-Town of Waterbury, prepared by Vermont Agency of Transportation, Planning Division, dated 1986.

All persons owning or interested in lands thru which the highway passes or abuts were notified in writing by certified U.S. mail, postage pre-paid sent to the official residence or place of business of such person, a notice was sent by certified U.S. mail to the Waterbury Planning Commission, a notice was published in the Barre-Montpelier Times-Argus, a newspaper of general circulation in the area on 24 September 1991 and a notice was posted at the Town Clerk's office more than thirty days prior to the public hearing.
