TOWN OF WOODBURY BOARD OF SELECTMEN
REPORT OF DOINGS AND ORDER OF DISCONTINUANCE

Pursuant to a Notice of Hearing dated October 12, 1983, a hearing was held by and before the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Woodbury at 7:00 p.m. on November 9, 1983 for the purpose of taking testimony from all interested parties as relates to the Discontinuance of Town Highway #58 in the Town of Woodbury.

All of the abutting property owners were served with said Notice of Hearing by certified mail, return receipt requested, on October 17, 1983. A copy of said Notice was also served upon the Chairman of the Woodbury Planning Commission, all of said Notices being served or delivered more than twelve (12) days before November 9, 1983.

In addition, said Notice was published in the Times Argus, a newspaper with a general circulation in the Town of Woodbury area, not less than ten (10) days before the time set for said hearing. Said Notice was further posted in the Woodbury Town Clerk's office and in two public places within the Town of Woodbury.

On or before November 9, 1983, the members of the Board of Selectmen examined the premises known as Town Highway #58 in order to aid in determining the public good, necessity and convenience as respects discontinuance of said Town Highway #58.

At 7:00 p.m. on November 9, 1983, the Selectmen assembled at the Woodbury Town Clerk's office to hear testimony from

any interested parties relative to said discontinuance of Town Highway #58.

There were no attendees at said hearing, and the Board unanimously decided to discontinue said Town Highway #58.

Based upon an examination of the premises and after affording a hearing to all interested parties, the Board of Selectmen made the following findings:

1. That the public good, necessity and convenience requires discontinuance of Town Highway #58, which said highway is more particularly described as being all that portion of town highway situated in the Town of Woodbury and being a .23 mile stretch of unpaved section of road extending in a westerly direction from its intersection with Vermont Route 14.

2. That upon discontinuance of said Town Highway #58, the land comprising said highway shall be set to the lots to which it originally belonged, if they can be ascertained; if not, said land shall be equally divided between the owners of the land on each side of said highway.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, the Selectmen of the Town of Woodbury do hereby order and decree that Town Highway #58, more particularly described as being all that portion of town highway situated in the Town of Woodbury and being a .23 mile stretch of unpaved section of road extending in a westerly direction from its intersection with Vermont Route 14, is discontinued and that the land comprising said highway shall be set to the lots to which said land originally belonged, if they

can be ascertained; if not, then said land shall be equally divided between the owners of said land on each side of said highway.

It is further ordered that this Report and Order of Discontinuance shall be recorded by the Woodbury Town Clerk in the Town Clerk's office.
