Title 19, V. S. A. Section 305
Added 1985

SEC. 305. MEASUREMENT OF HIGHWAYS

(a) A representative of the agency in the presence of the selectmen or their designee shall measure and inspect the class 1, 2 and 3 town highways in each town at least once every ten years. The agency shall notify the town when any highway, or portion of a highway, does not meet the standards for its assigned class. If the town fails, within one year, to restore the highway or portion of the highway to the accepted standard, or to reclassify, or to discontinue, or develop an acceptable schedule for restoring to the accepted standards, the agency for purposes of apportionment under section 306 of this title shall deduct the affected mileage from that assigned to the town for the particular class of the road in question.

(b) Annually, on or before February 10, the selectmen shall, after review by a representative of the agency, file with the town clerk a sworn statement of the description and measurements of all class 1, 2 and 3 town highways, then in existence, including any special designation such as a throughway or scenic highway. When class 1, 2 or 3 town highways are accepted, discontinued, or reclassified, a copy of the proceedings shall be filed in the town clerk's office and a copy shall be forwarded to the agency.

(c) The agency shall not accept any change in mileage until the records required to be filed in the town clerk's office by this section are received by the agency.

(d) The selectmen of any town who are aggrieved by a finding of the agency concerning the measurement, description or classification of a town highway may appeal to the board by filing a notice of appeal with the executive secretary of the board.

Title 19, V. S. A. Section 2502
Added 1985

Sec. 2502. TOWN SCENIC ROADS; DESIGNATION AND DISCONTINUANCE

(a) On recommendation of the planning commission of a municipality, or on the initiative of the legislative body of a municipality, a legislative body may, after one public hearing warned for the purpose, designate or discontinue any town highway or portion of a town highway as a town scenic highway. Such action by the legislative body may be petitioned by the registered voters of the municipality pursuant to the provisions of section 1973 of Title 24.

(b) A town scenic road may be reconstructed or improved in a manner consistent with the standards established by the transportation board, pursuant to section 425 of Title 10. A class 1, 2 or 3 scenic highway shall still be eligible to receive aid pursuant to the provisions of this title.

(c) The legislative body of a municipality may appeal for a variance from standards promulgated by the transportation board. In these appeals the board's decision shall be final.

Gentlemen:

In the summer of 1980 Mr. Ed Chabot, Road Inventory Chief and Mr. Hawkins, Selectman remeasured all the roads in your town. The resulting changes in mileage were sent to you on December 1, 1980 with a letter of explanation.

There is a section of Town Highway #9, which is not up to Class 3 standards (0.310 mile) and we need a statement from your town that this portion of the road has been brought up to standards. For a road to be classified as Class 3; according to the law, it should be travelable all seasons of the year in a standard manufactured pleasure car.

Your town is currently receiving aid from the State on this road and we request that you notify this office of your intent in regards to the maintenance of this portion of Town Highway #9 as soon as possible. Your Mileage Certificate will be held in this office until we are notified as to what action you will be taking in regards to this road.

Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1980 by Mr. Hawkins, Selectman, and Mr. Chabot, Road Inventory Chief, of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage and any changes in classification are indicated on the enclosed map and explained on the attached sheets.

We are also forwarding the Mileage Certificate for your town for the year ending February 10, 1981. For your convenience, we have entered previous mileage and changes that were brought to our attention during the past year. Any other changes in Class 3 or Class 4 mileage must be entered by you and must be substantiated according to the requirements listed on the enclosed Certificate and as explained in the enclosure (ENCLOSURE 1).

Please refer to the second form (ENCLOSURE 2) for specific instructions relative to Scenic Highway Mileage. Utilizing the attached instructions, you should be able to complete the Scenic Highway portion of the Certificate. The remaining portion of the Certificate is to be completed just as before and DO NOT delete any mileage from this portion that you may have designated as Scenic.

The Certificate should be completed and sworn to before a Notary Public. One white and two yellow copies of the completed Certificate should be returned to this office no later than February 10, 1981. The designated representative of the Agency of Transportation will approve the town's copy, which will then be returned to the Town Clerk. The Town Clerk should retain the third yellow copy for the town's records until the "APPROVED" copy has been returned.
