Thank you for the prompt submission of your Highway Mileage Certificates.

However, it would seem as though there was a deduction from Town Highways that may have escaped your notice.

On November 5, 1960 a 0.10 mile portion of Town Highway No. 49, between State Aid No. 5 and Town Highway No. 57 was discontinued according to the Selectmen's report of the results of the hearing.

As no mention was made of this discontinuance procedure being recorded and the mileage has not been deducted on the Mileage Certificates recently submitted, we are not quite sure what has happened.

If you could send us a copy of the recording of the discontinuance and indicate that you have subtracted the 0.10 mile from Town Highways we shall make the corresponding deduction on the copies already submitted.

With regard to the completion of the enclosed Road Mileage Certificates, we wish to call your attention to a change in Town Highway mileage in your town.
