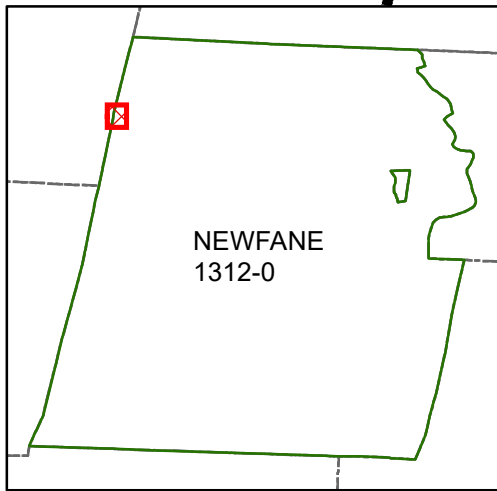

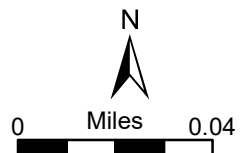
Index Map

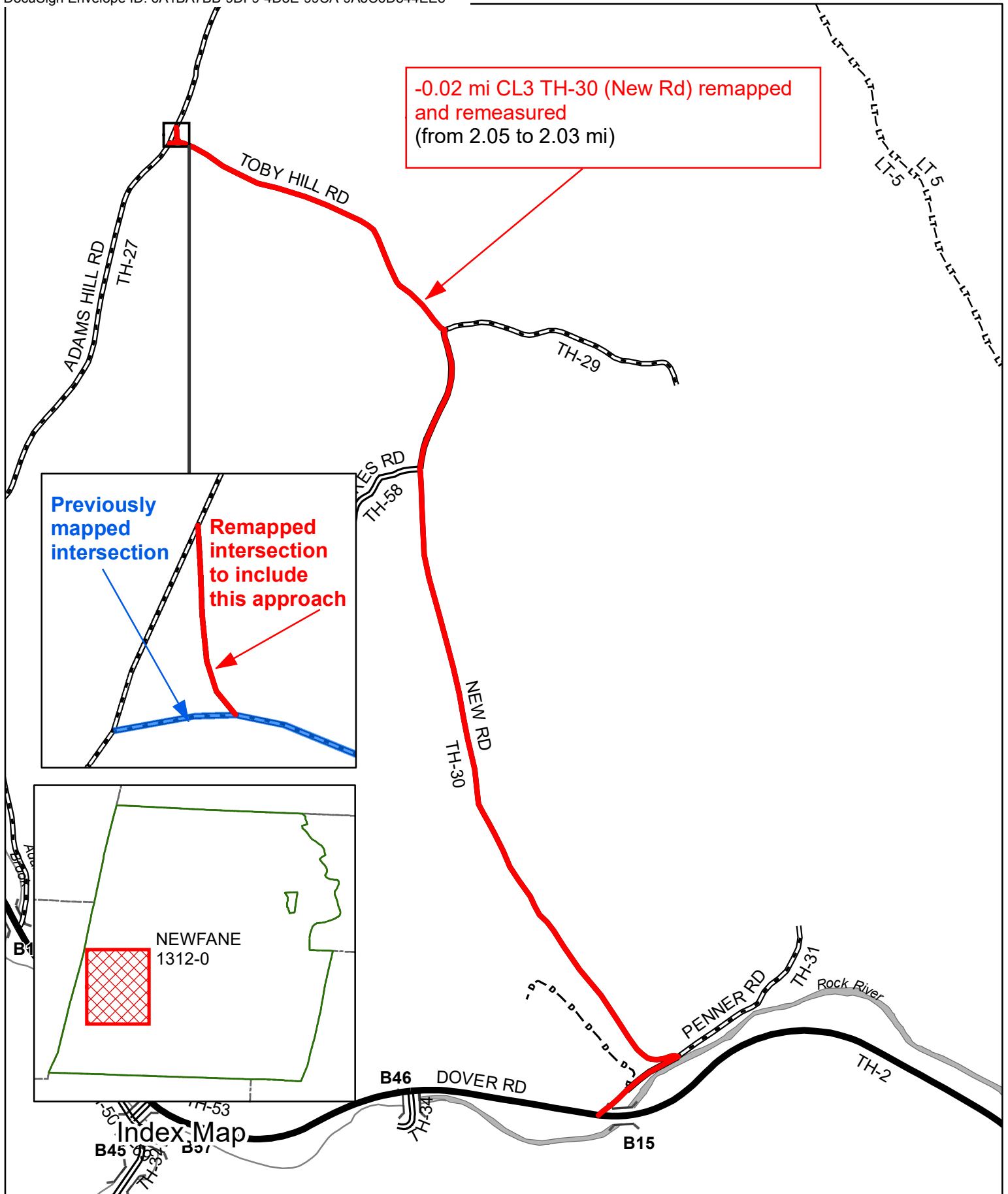

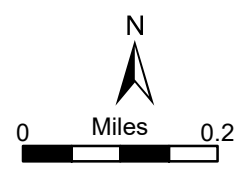

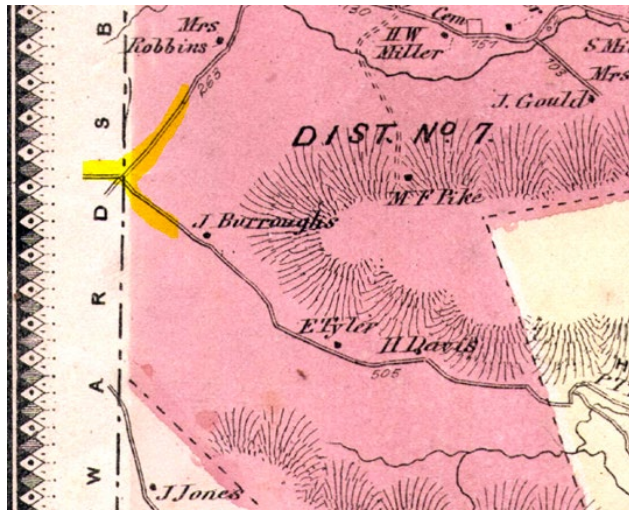

Good morning folks,

Thank you for the map. And yes it shows where LT-3 (Silver Mine Trail) is located. It however does not contain the survey information on it, which is really what we need for the change at the intersection with TH-19. If there is anything in the Town records of the original laying out survey information for LT-3/TH-57, that would be great. The Beers Atlas (1869) and the Walling Map (1856) shows this road to the Wardsboro border (see images below) so it would be a very old survey prior to 1856.

In looking at the western end of this trail, I also noticed that we may have that mapped incorrectly (see yellow highlight on old maps and current Town Highway map below) as Jeff pointed out it does not follow the elevation data well and suggested we update it to the blue line in the 4th image below. That leads to also having LT-2 mapped incorrectly as well. Historically, LT-2 and LT-3 make a right angle and if I remap LT-3 as suggested below, then that would change the intersection of LT-2 and LT-3 as noted in red. I can make this correction on the western end without a survey, but would be great to have it for the eastern end of LT-3. I don't anticipate that this change will affect the mileage of LT-2 and LT-3, but will let you know if it does.

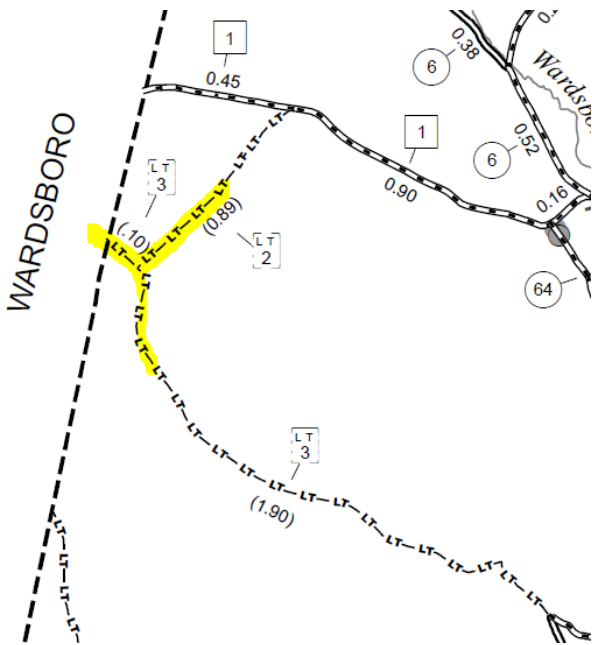
Beers Atlas 1869:



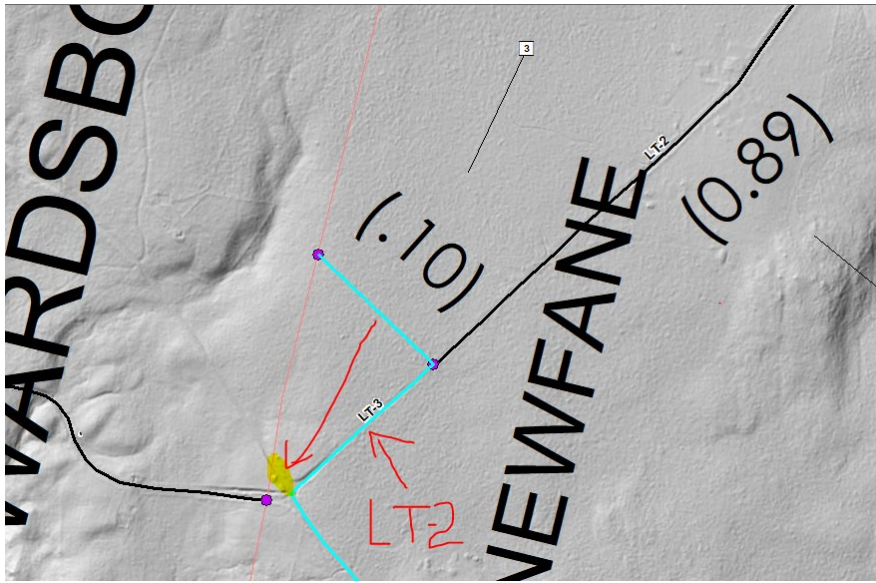
Walling Map: 1856

Good morning again Wannetta,

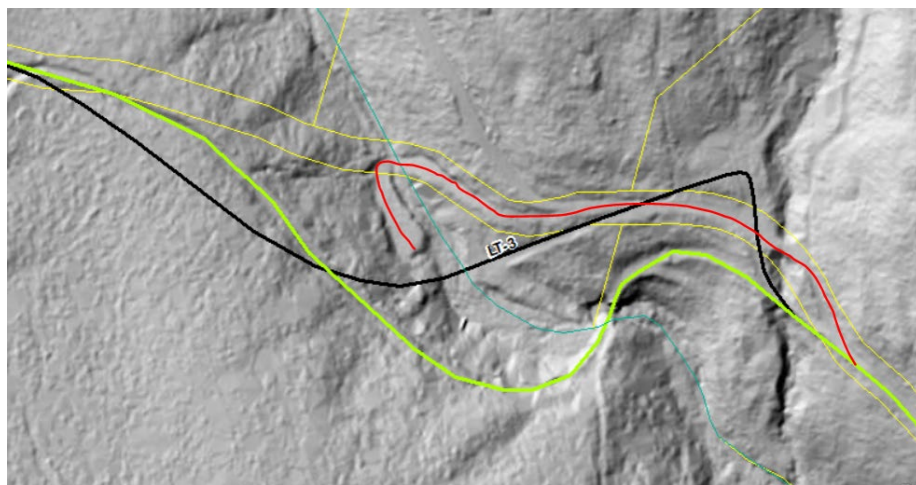
We have another question regarding Newfane Roads and wondering if you may have any information on the original laying out of LT-3 (formerly TH-57). Jeff Nugent of WRC has noticed that what we currently have mapped does not match elevation data very well and perhaps it is aligned like the green line in the image below and not how we have it mapped in black. Neither of these alignments follow the parcel data for the right of way (in yellow). We are not sure that the parcel ROW is accurate in terms of the original alignment since when you compare that with the elevation data (see red line in the second image), the higher elevation does not continue with the ROW. We think that what Jeff has mapped in green is probably most accurate but will need to confirm that somehow with historic records to make this change.

Looking though historic records the most eastern part of the road was originally Class 3 of 0.35 miles (remapped as 0.27 miles in 1970) and became Legal Trail in 1981. The rest of it was Class 4 until 1987 when the Class 4 became Legal Trail.

Here is a blurb from the 1971 Mileage Certificate, which is all we have for description on this road's location. If you have the original laying out that will help us identify the true alignment of the road. Let us know and thank you!

5. The so called Silver Mine Road commencing at the junction of the so called Hobby Hill Road and the so called Baker Brook Road and extending westerly to the Wardsboro town line, a distance of approximately two miles.
