TO TOWN CLERK AND SELECTMEN OF ROCKINGHAM:

Enclosed is your 1991 Certificate of Highway Mileage. THIS CERTIFICATE MUST BE COMPLETED in order to determine and distribute state aid for Town Highways. Please remember that mileage changes, with documentation, can be sent to the Planning Division any time during the year.

In 1990, when your Town Highways were inspected and remeasured by Jay Kilton, then Road Inventory Chief, the following highways were found to NOT meet Class 3 standards:

<u>NUMBER</u>	<u>MILEAGE</u>	<u>REASON NOT CLASS 3</u>
✓T-110	0.07	Does Not Meet Class 3 Standards.
✓T-84	0.90	Does Not Meet Class 3 Standards.
✓T-344	0.22	Does Not Meet Class 3 Standards.
SR ✓T-94	0.06	Does Not Meet Class 3 Standards.

These highways were subsequently reinventoried in 1991 by Donald Harvey, Mapping Engineer, and found to still not meet Class 3 standards. These sections of highways will be deducted from your Class 3 mileage and transferred to the Class 4 section where they will be noted by an asterisk. These sections are still Class 3 by law, but are Class 4 functionally, therefore are not eligible for Town Highway State Aid until brought up to Class 3 standards.
