
PURPOSE - TO ACT ON DAVID CHAVES REQUEST FOR THE TOWN OF ANDOVER
TO GIVE UP THE LAMSON RD.



DISCONTINUANCE OF LAMSON ROAD (TH#24)

DATE: OCTOBER 24, 1998

On October 24, 1998, a duly warned public hearing and site visit was held with the Andover Select Board acting in response to the request of David Chaves for the Town to give up the Lamson Road (TH#24).

Since the only persons present were Andover Select Board members and David & Patrice Chaves, and since no-one came forward with objections, the Select Board decided to discontinue Lamson Road (TH#24) which runs easterly .03 mile from the intersection of TH#1 and contains a 50' town R.O.W. across the Reino Bergquist and David Chaves property. This discontinuance is assuming that Reino Bergquist grants David Chaves a R.O.W. over his property which crosses Lamson Road at the start and is contingent upon David Chaves receiving an Act 250 permit from the State of Vermont for operation of a sand, soil and gravel extraction & sales business.



RESOLUTION FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF TOWN HIGHWAY #24

On July 26, 1999 the following resolution was adopted by the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Andover, Vermont.

Upon request by David Chaves in connection with his application for an Act 250 Permit from the State of Vermont a duly warned Public Hearing and Site Visit were held on October 24, 1998. As there were no objections to this resolution and the contingency that David Chaves obtain a Right-of-Way from Reino and Dorothy Bergquist has been met and recorded in the Andover Land Records, Book 37, Page 9-10, the Andover Board of Selectmen Resolve to Discontinue Town Highway #24, otherwise known as Lamson Road, and the land shall revert back to Reino and Dorothy Bergquist and David Chaves, they being the sole owners of all land adjoining said Town Highway #24. Town Highway #24 may be described as follows:

Highway #24 (Lamson Road) enters the Bergquist property from the Weston-Andover Road (TH #1) approximately 1692' from the Chester/Andover Town line and goes in an east/northeasterly direction approximately 1280'.
