Pursuant to Section 16, No. 250 of the Acts of 1957, this is to certify that the following described section of highway in the Town of Bridgewater is completed and open for public travel.

Being a piece or parcel of land to be used for highway purposes, said land being a strip 2 rods in width and leading from the road which goes by the grantor's property to property formerly of Reno Atwood, to the Top-of-the-hill, so called, to the boundary line of Roger and Alice Thompson as deeded to them by Albert S. and Sarah Thompson, dated August 19, 1963, and recorded in Book 34, Page 250 of the Bridgewater Land Records.

This strip hereby conveyed is part of the old highway which was discontinued by the town of Bridgewater on June 20, 1945, all as appears of record in the Bridgewater Land Records.

It is specifically understood and agreed that this deed is given for the sole purpose of maintaining a public highway over said land,

Said highway right-of-way shall be contained within the stone walls as now exist or shall be 2 rods in width as above stated.

Any standing timber contained within such right-of-way may be cut but shall belong to the grantors and said right-of-way is subject to any building therein situated. Said road may be gated if agreed to by the grantors and Roger and Alice Thompson or their respective successors in title.

The easement herein granted shall terminate one rod southerly of the boundary line between Shurtleff and Thompson.
