Gentlemen:

In accordance with Title 19, V.S.A., Section 15, as amended, all the traveled highways in your town were measured in 1971 by Mr. Sawyer, Town Employee and Mr. Oldenburg, Selectman, with Mr. Chabot of this office.

The resulting changes in highway mileage are indicated on the enclosed map and are explained on the attached breakdown sheet.

The second breakdown sheet indicates those roads for which we will require copies of the rights-of-way and Certificates of Completion and Opening before they can be added to your town highway mileage.

According to Mr. Sawyer and Mr. Oldenburg, the following roads are considered to be old town highways:

Before we can include these roads in your town highway system, it will be necessary for you to submit a certificate, signed by the Selectmen, certifying that these roads have been considered and maintained as public highways for "X" number of years. Without this certificate these highways cannot be considered to be part of your town highway system.

Mr. Chabot also noted that there is a locked gate across T 5 at 0.49 mile. Unless you confirm to this agency that this gate has been removed, it will be necessary that we deduct 0.51 mile from the length of T 5.

Due to construction project S 0147(2) the length of VT 100 through your town was increased 0.042 mile during the past year.
