Gentlemen:

Enclosed is the Certificate of Highway Mileage for your town for the year ending February 10, 1983. We have made several changes in the Certificate this year. You will note that this new form does not require notarization. SELECTMEN'S REPORT, FINDINGS OF FACT AND ORDER CHANGING THE CLASSIFICATION OF
TOWN HIGHWAY.
ALSO, DISCONTINUANCE AND ACCEPTANCE OF TOWN HIGHWAY.

On May 20, 1982 the Selectmen gave notice that on June 19, 1982, they would conduct an examination and hold a hearing relative to changing the order of the following Town Highways from Class Three to Class Four:

Done
1981

Town Highway #9. A section of Class 111 highway within the Town of Bridgewater 50 feet beyond the barn presently owned by John & Rodney Lewis, et al, for a distance of approximately .8 (8/10) of a mile.

Town Highway #24. A section of Class 111 highway within the Town of Bridgewater 1.2 miles long beginning at the entrance leading to the home presently owned by Verna Gay, to the end of Town Road #24.

Town Highway #42. A section of Class 111 highway within the Town of Bridgewater beginning at the entrance leading to the residence of Harry Cole and running to the end of Town Road #42.

Discontinuance:

A portion of the old highway leading from residence of former Slocum to the Red School House in Bridgewater Hollow. (Old Buell Place). Refer to map in Plat Book.

Acceptance:

That portion of highway #16 of which the Town presently does not have a right-of-way. Refer to map in Plat Book. Class 1V.

At least 30 days notice, registered mail, was given to persons abutting, owning or interested in lands through which the highway passes, and to the Bridgewater Planning Commission. A copy of the notice was posted in two public places within the Town, one of which was the Town Clerk's Office, at least 30 days before the hearing date, and the notice was published in the Vermont Standard, a newspaper generally circulating in the area, at least 10 days before the hearing date.

The Selectmen examined the highway and held a hearing on June 19, 1982.

RESOLUTION

REGARDING TOWN HIGHWAY RECLASSIFICATION

WHEREAS the Board of Selectmen has the authority to reclassify certain Town Highways from Class Three to Class Four, and

WHEREAS the extent of maintenance required for Class Four Highways differs from that required for Class Three Highways, and

WHEREAS the Board of Selectmen may determine the maintenance of Class Four Highways by the necessity of the Town, the public good, and the convenience of the inhabitants of the Town, and

WHEREAS the Board of Selectmen, in reclassifying certain Town Highways from Class Three to Class Four, does not intend to eliminate all maintenance of these reclassified Town Highways.

THEREFORE: the Board of Selectmen of the Town of Bridgewater hereby resolve that in reclassifying certain roads from Class Three to Class Four, this reclassification will not diminish or eliminate the maintenance that is presently being done; that being, to once or twice during the summer months grade and provide minor repairs. This resolution does not, however, presume to provide any winter maintenance or any summer maintenance over that which is presently being done.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Summer maintenance presently being done, and summer maintenance in the past is more consistent with a Class Four highway than with a Class Three Highway.

2. The usage of these Town Highways by the inhabitants of the Town and other members of the public is minimal and is not sufficient to justify these highways' maintenance as Class Three Highways.

3. The convenience of the inhabitants of the Town and the public good and necessity require the reclassification of these Town Highways to Class Four.

4. The discontinuance and acceptance of highway is hereby noted as done.

ORDER

THEREFORE, it is hereby ordered that the Town Highways described above be and hereby are reclassified, and are hereby designated as Class Four highways of the Town of Bridgewater.
