





Comments: We have a question prompted by trying to map the change noted in your 2006 Mileage Certificate.

The minutes state: "Nelson made a motion to discontinue Walker Hill Road from the intersection of Chateaugay Road to a point North West 1.3 miles including the bridge."

According to our E911 information, Walker Hill Road applies to the trail that used to be identified as Town Highway 12 which is 0.40 miles. The rest of the description seems to apply to the trail which used to be identified as T-13.

Could you clarify which trail was discontinued during the September 27, 2005 discontinuance meeting?

Road hearing was called to order at 4:10 PM by Nelson B. Lee, Jr., Chairman

Present: Steve Tarleton, Mary Oldenburg, Randy Kennedy, Vicky Young and Nancy Robinson

Visitors: James Beauregard, Ira Stevens and Donald Atwood

Selectboard initiated this hearing after receiving letters requesting that the road classification be clarified and returned to the private road status as believed by several of the landowners. Letters were received last February and signed by 5 of the 7 property owners. Letters attached. Current highway map shows road as a legal trail being 1.3 miles in length.

Jim Beauregard has done research of the properties and road and has found where a portion of the road from the farm of Artemus Walker to the farm of John Walker was discontinued in 1859 in Vol. 17 page 131 (Exhibit #1).

Road status was questioned in 1988 when research was conducted by James Oldenburg, Jr., Road Foreman and Paul Hermann, Town Administrator. No record found of town laying out this road or ever doing any work. Bridge was replaced with FEMA money after the flood of 1973. Road has always been maintained by the landowners.

Town warned and held a hearing in 1989 changing the status of the road from a class 4 road to legal trail. Not sure why town did this, since town took stance in 1988 that road was not a town road. Maybe town intended to discontinue but neglected to complete the legal process.

Don Atwood feels that any decision made today a future board will be sorry for.

Ira Stevens feels that if part of the road has already been legally discontinued then the record should stand and the rest of the road should be discontinued.

Being no further comments, Nelson explained that the board will review this information and make a written decision within 60 days.

Hearing portion of meeting adjourned at 4:40 PM, board will enter into deliberative session to review some of the testimony.




