Enclosed is your 1994 Certificate of Highway Mileage. This Certificate **MUST BE COMPLETED** in order to determine and distribute state aid for Town Highways. Any 1993 changes brought to our attention have been entered on the Certificate of Highway Mileage. Please remember that mileage changes, with documentation, can be sent to the PLANNING DIVISION any time during the year.

In 1992, when your Town Highways were inspected and remeasured by Jay H. Kilton, Road Inventory Supervisor, the following highways were found to NOT meet Class 3 Standards:

These highways were subsequently reinventoried in 1993 and found to still not meet Class 3 Standards. These sections of highways will be deducted from your Class 3 mileage and transferred to the Class 4 section where they will be noted by an asterisk. These sections are still Class 3 by law, but are Class 4 functionally, therefore not eligible for Town Highway State Aid until brought up to Class 3 Standards.
