Legislative Act 61 of 1931 authorized the State of Vermont to take over certain highways for a State and/or Federal Aid Highway System.

U. S. Route #7 in Highgate was taken into the State Highway System on April 1, 1931 by order of the State Highway Board.

Vermont Route #73 in Highgate was taken into the State Highway System on December 11, 1967 by order of the State Highway Board, and said order is recorded in the Land Records of Highgate in Volume 55, Page 83, dated January 2, 1968.

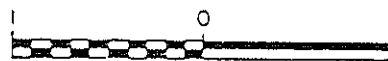
