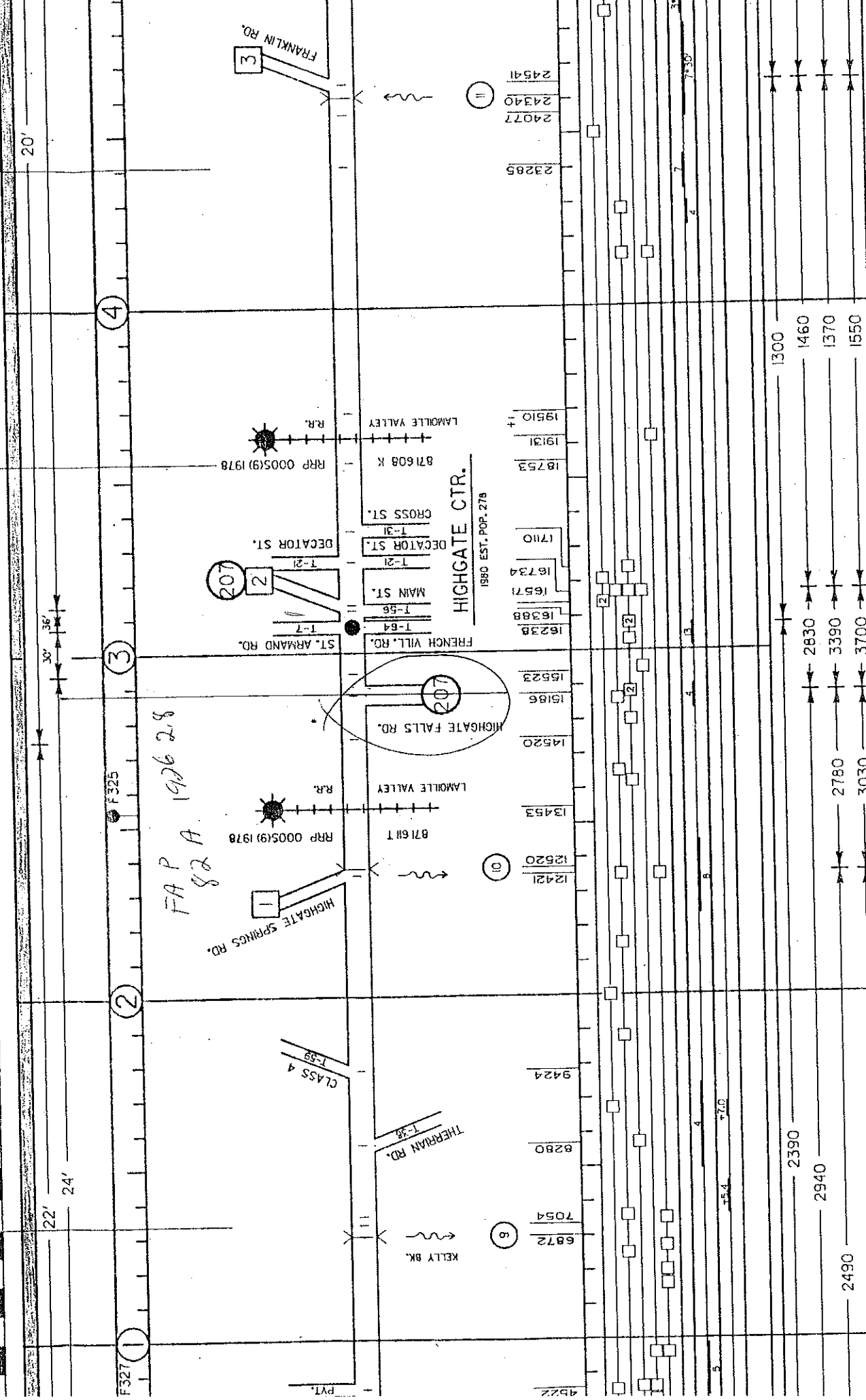
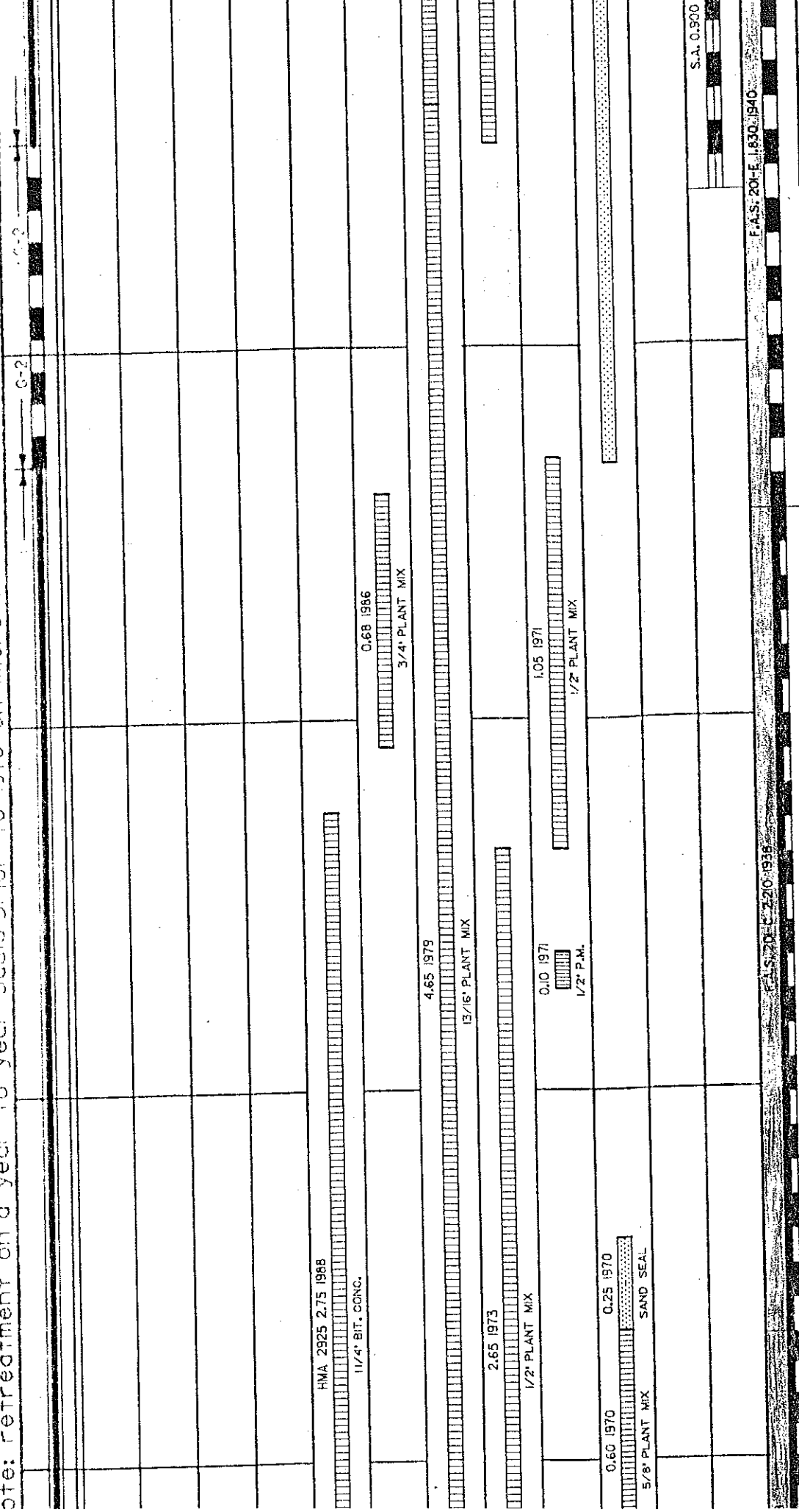

REPORT OF SELECTMEN ON RESURVEY ROUTE 78

Whereas, at a meeting of the Selectmen of the Town of Highgate, held on October 28, 1965, the Selectmen did unanimously vote that proceedings should be instituted for resurveying that portion of the public highway in the Town of Highgate known as Vermont Route 78, so called, which passes through the town of Highgate from the Swanton-Highgate town line easterly to the Highgate-Sheldon Town line, the purpose of such resurvey being to enable the Selectmen of the Town of Highgate to give a certified description of such highway to the State Highway Board so that the State Highway Board might take over such public highway as a State Highway.

The Selectmen did order and appoint that on January 21, 1966, at the hour of 9:30 o'clock, in the forenoon, they would examine the premises, and thereafter at 1:00 o'clock of the forenoon of the same day would meet at the town clerk's office in said Highgate for the purpose of hearing all persons interested in such resurvey, and for the further purpose, if the Selectmen decided that said highway should be resurveyed, to hear claims for damages, and did give notice thereof to:

The Selectmen exhibited to the meeting and to all those interested, the resurvey plans as prepared by the State Highway Board, a copy of which resurvey plans had been on file in the Highgate Town Clerk's Office since October 2nd, 1965. The Selectmen also stated that the resurvey plans were made in connection with the taking over by the State Highway Board of the highway as resurveyed, that the highway as resurveyed is the same as the highway as it now exists, and that there is no present intention of undertaking highway construction within the bounds as resurveyed, that if such construction is undertaken in the future such rights as abutting property owners may have acquired to maintain fences and railings or enclosed lands within the highway that have as it existed and as now resurveyed will not be taken or interfered with without following the procedures and paying such compensation as may be required by law.

The survey plan as prepared by the State Highway Board was discussed with all interested persons and no objections were made to the same. After consideration of said survey plans by the Selectmen and considering all matters presented, the Selectmen voted unanimously that the public good and necessity and convenience of individuals requires a resurvey of the highway as hereafter described, that such a resurvey is necessary since it is difficult or impossible to ascertain the boundaries of the highway from the records of the original survey made when the various parts of such highway were established. The Selectmen did therefore approve and adopt the survey and survey plans of said roadway as prepared by the Vermont Highway Department and by which resurvey said highway is described as follows:

RESURVEY OF ROUTE #78 - Highgate, Vermont

Commencing at a point in the center line of Vermont Route 78 in the boundary line between the Town of Swanton and the Town of Highgate, which point is designated as Station 72443 on the plans of the survey now on file in the Town Clerk's Office in the Town of Highgate, thence continuing

in a general easterly direction along said center line a distance of 7.6794 miles through the villages, so-called, of Highgate Center and East Highgate to a point in the center line of said highway which intersects the boundary line between the Town of Highgate and the Town of Sheldon, at Station 481+75 on the plans of said survey. The width of said highway on each side of said center line is the same as the width of the present highway, as shown on the plans of said survey and also as shown by the records of the deeds of abutting land owners, recorded in the Town Clerk's Office of said Town of Highgate, dated in the years from 1937 through 1951, conveying lands adjoining said highway to the said Town of Highgate, consistent with the plans of said survey.

For a more particular description of the survey, the location of the reference points above referred to, and the location of slope rights, channel rights, culvert rights and other rights appurtenant to said highway, reference should be made to the Survey Plans entitled
