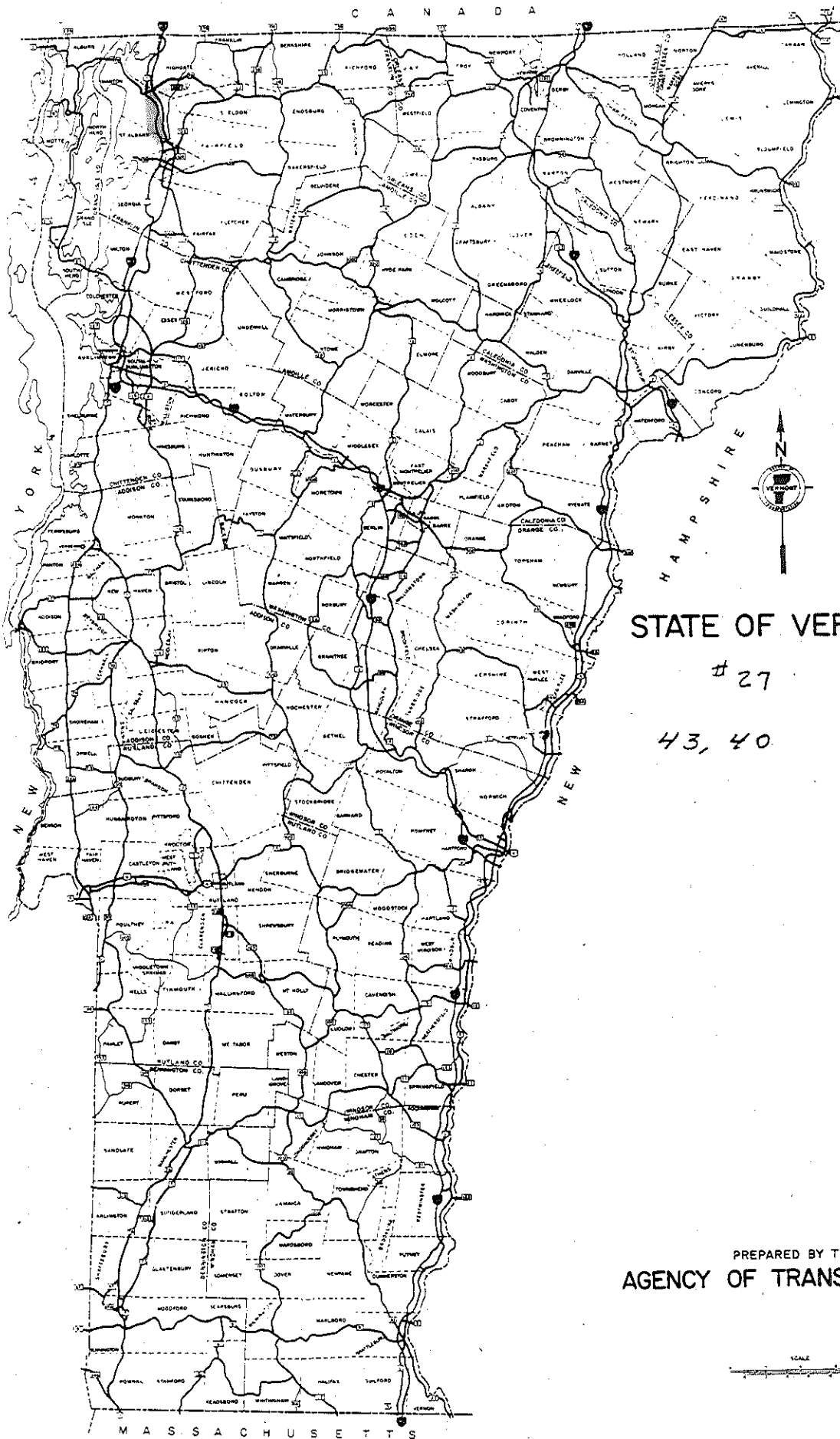

CHAP. XLV.

An Act, authorising the laying out and surveying anew, the stage road, through the town of Swanton.

Sec. 1. It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont, That Frederick Bliss, Peter Sax and Seth Wetmore, be, and they are hereby authorised and appointed a Committee to re-survey, and erect suitable monuments on, the old stage road, leading from the north line of St. Albans, through the town of Swanton, to the south line of Highgate, making such alterations therein, as they shall deem proper; and

Survey bill to be recorded in Town Clerk's office. cause a survey-bill thereof, noting the boundaries of said road, to be recorded in the town clerk's office in the said town of Swanton, on, or before, the first day of February next; and that, from and after the recording of the survey-bill as aforesaid, the road to said road laid out as aforesaid, shall be, and is hereby made, the stage road through the town of Swanton.

Expenses hereon paid. *Sec. 2. It is hereby further enacted, That* the expenses for laying out and surveying said road, as aforesaid, be paid out of the Treasury of the town of Swanton.

CHAP. XLVI.

An Act laying a tax of one cent per acre on the township of Montgomery and two cents per acre on Avery's gore.

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Vermont, That there be, and

hereby is laid a tax of one cent per acre on all the lands in the township of Mont. Montgomery, and also two cents per acre on all the lands in Avery's Gore, in Gore, the county of Franklin (lands sequestered for public, pious and charitable uses excepted) for the purpose of making roads and building bridges in said town and Gore; to be expended under the direction of Robert Martin, Samuel Lusk, and Eli Bush, all of said Montgomery, who are hereby appointed a Committee

Committee to superintend the expenditure of said tax; and any Justice of the Peace, within and for the County of Franklin, is hereby authorised and directed to issue his warrant to Rufus Smith, of Montgomery aforesaid, collector, who is hereby appointed a collector to collect said tax; and said committee and said collector are directed, in the collecting, expending and accounting for the monies raised by said tax, to govern themselves in all things conformable to the general statutes of this state, in that case made and provided.

An Act, for the benefit of the overseers of the poor of the town of Dinty.
