NOTES:

1. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INCLUDE A TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 641 OF THE VERMONT AGENCY OF TRANSPORTATION STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION DATED 2001 AND THE LATEST VAOT STANDARDS AND SECTION 6 OF THE MANUAL ON TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES (MUTCD). PAYMENT FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN SHALL BE INCLUDED UNDER ITEM 641.0 TRAFFIC CONTROL OR AS DIRECTED BY THE RESIDENT ENGINEER.
2. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AT LEAST ONE UNOBSTRUCTED 10 FOOT WIDE TRAVEL LANE ALONG U.S. ROUTE 5 DURING WORKING HOURS TO ALLOW FOR THE SAFE PASSAGE OF EMERGENCY VEHICLES. NO LANE CLOSURES SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE DURING NON-WORKING HOURS.
3. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE TWO UNOBSTRUCTED 11 FOOT WIDE TRAVEL LANES ON U.S. ROUTE 5 DURING NON-WORKING HOURS. THE LANES SHALL BE MAINTAINED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE EXISTING ROW. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE DELINEATION BETWEEN PEDESTRIAN ROUTES, THE TRAVEL LANES AND TO PROTECT TRAFFIC FROM WORK ACTIVITIES.
4. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE AND MAINTAIN SAFE INGRESS AND EGRESS TO AND FROM INTERSECTING ROADWAYS, RESIDENCES AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS AT ALL TIMES AS DIRECTED BY THE RESIDENT ENGINEER.
5. SEE VAOT STD. E-100 FOR ADDITIONAL SIGN PLACEMENT DETAILS.
6. CONSTRUCTION ZONE SIGN LAYOUT SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 6 OF THE LATEST EDITION OF THE MUTCD.
7. CONSTRUCTION SIGNS SHALL BE IN NEW OR LIKE NEW CONDITION PER VAOT STANDARDS.
8. DIAMOND SHAPED SIGNS SHALL BE 4'x4' WITH BLACK LEGEND ON FLUORESCENT ORANGE BACKGROUND.
9. REFLECTIVE SHEETING SHALL BE TYPE VII OR BETTER.
10. CONSTRUCTION ZONE SIGNS SHALL BE INSTALLED ON TWO POSTS EACH OR AS AN NCHRP 350 COMPLIANT SIGN/STAND SYSTEM.
