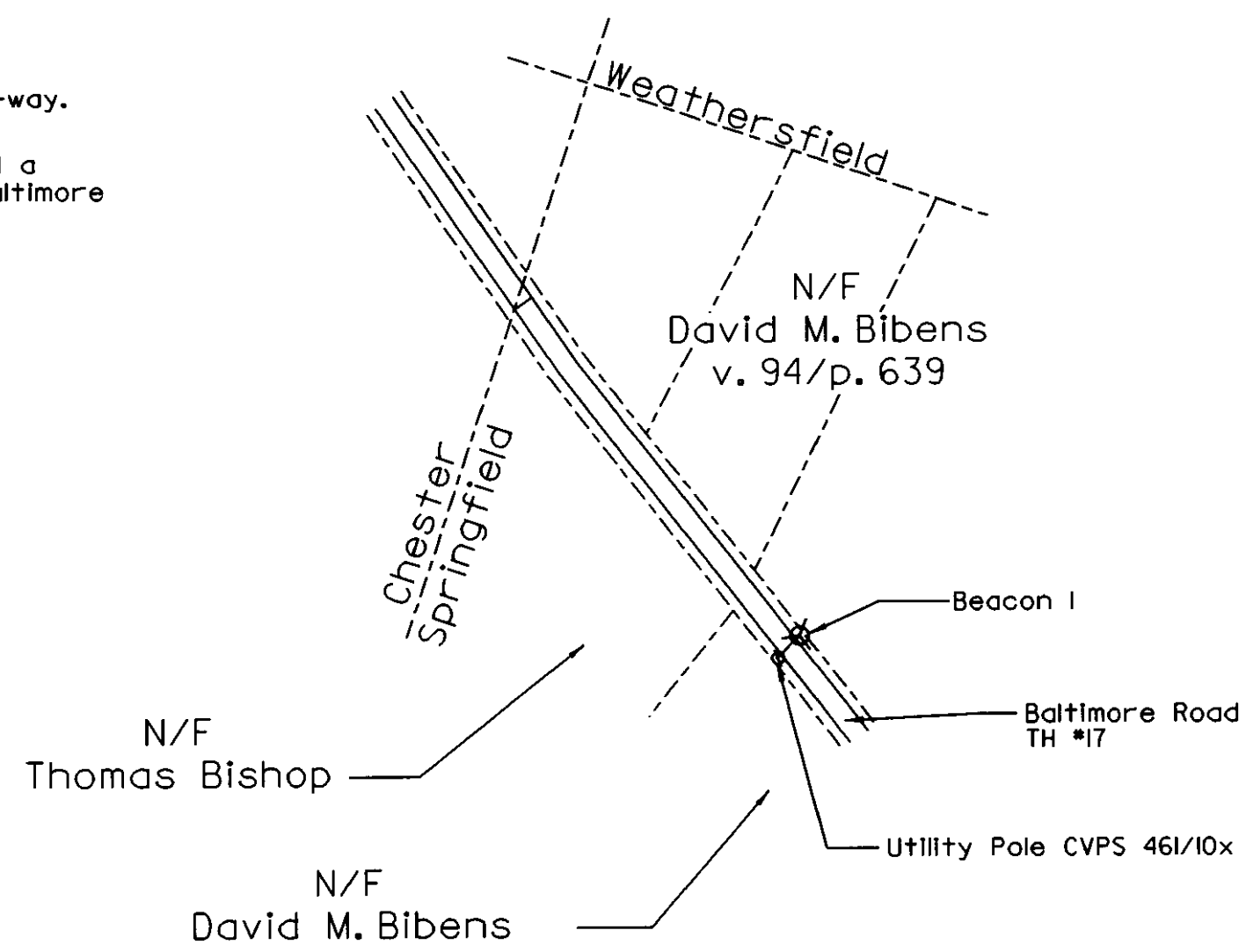


BEACON NO. 1 NOTES

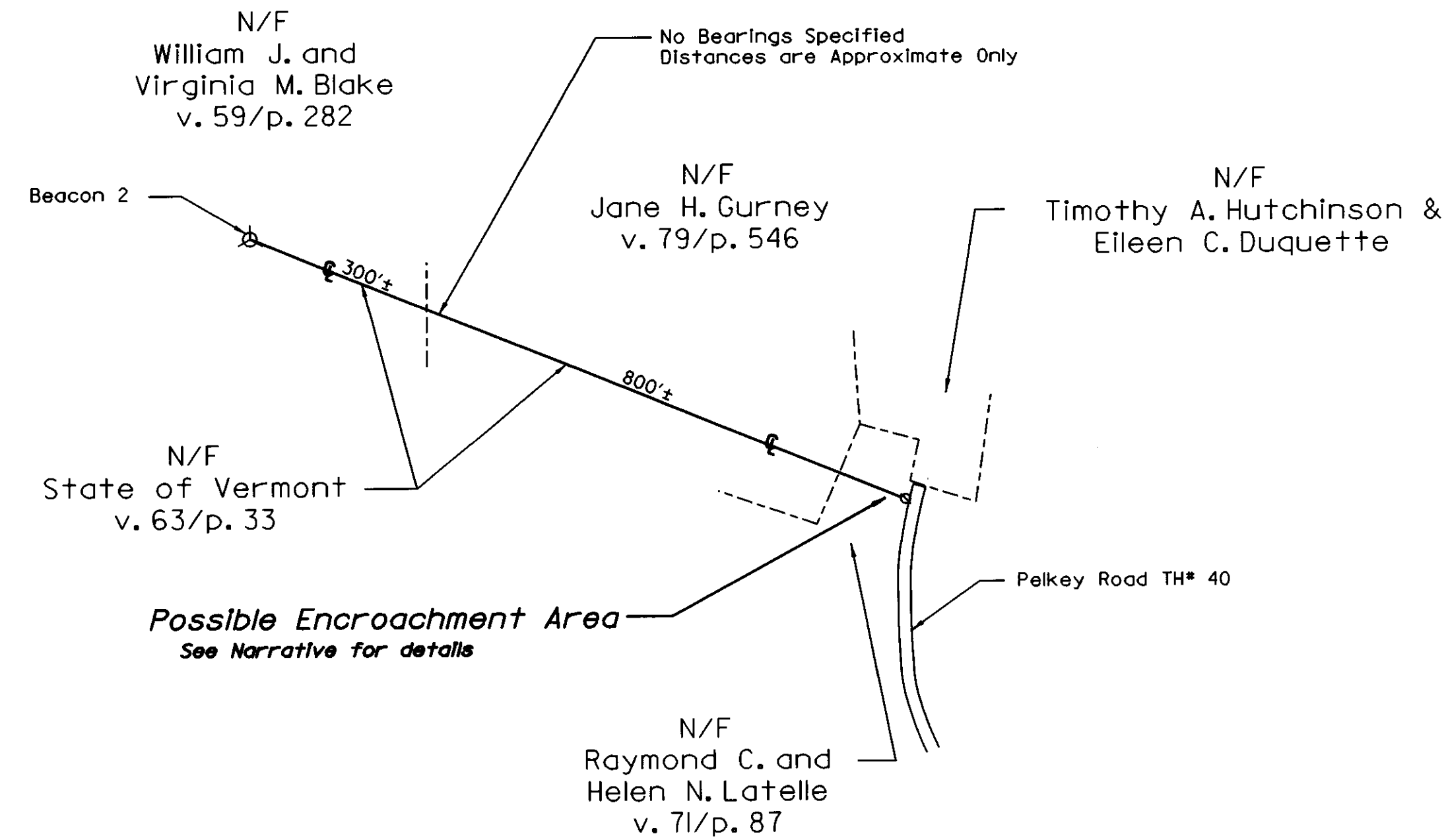

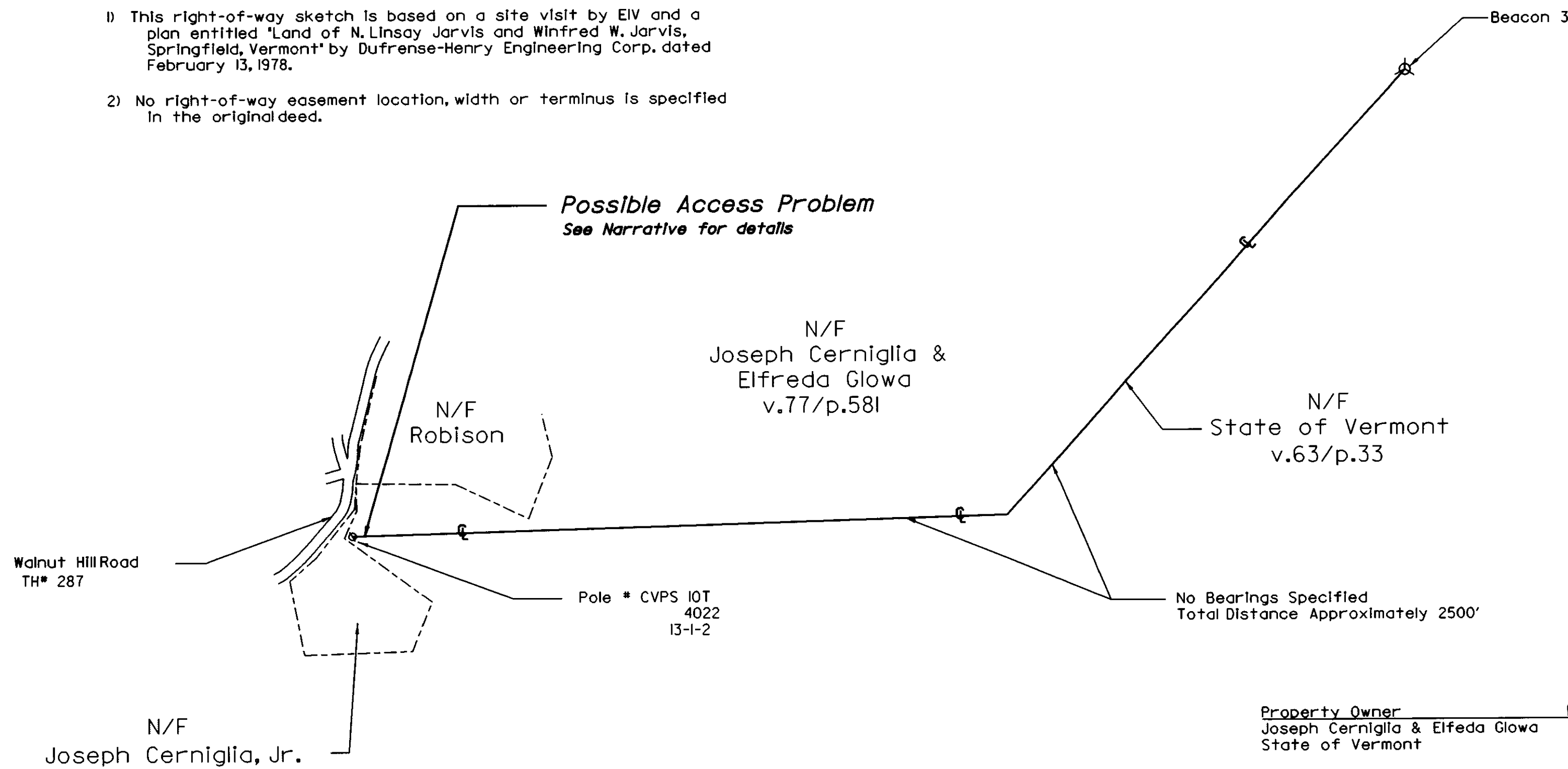

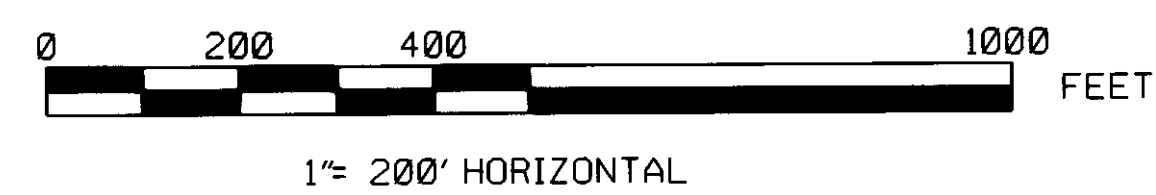
Location Map

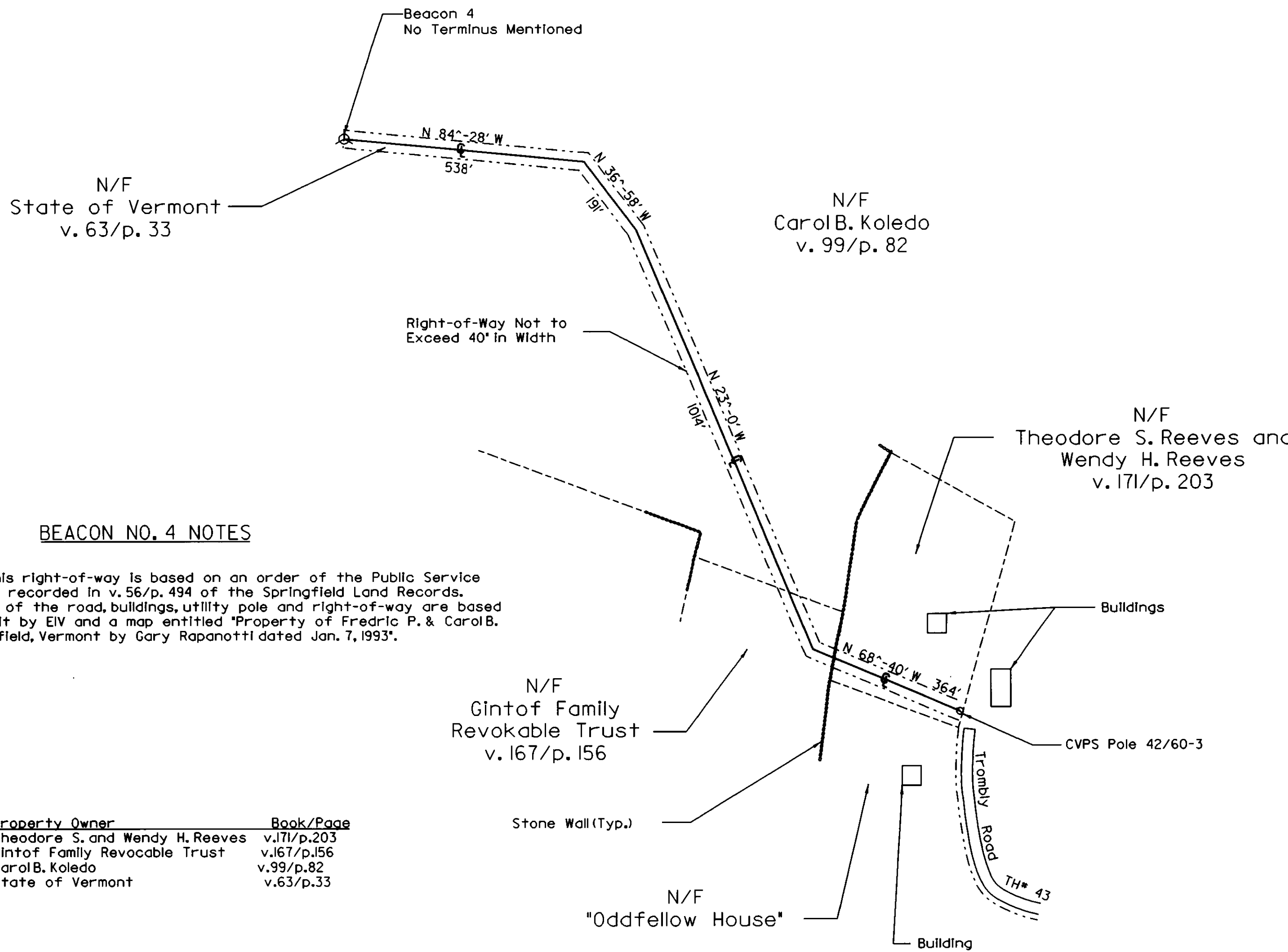
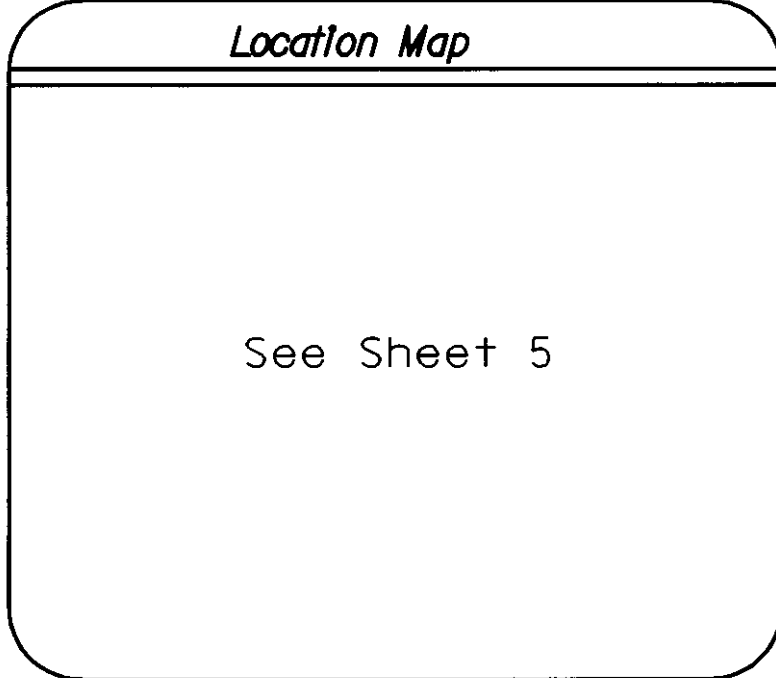

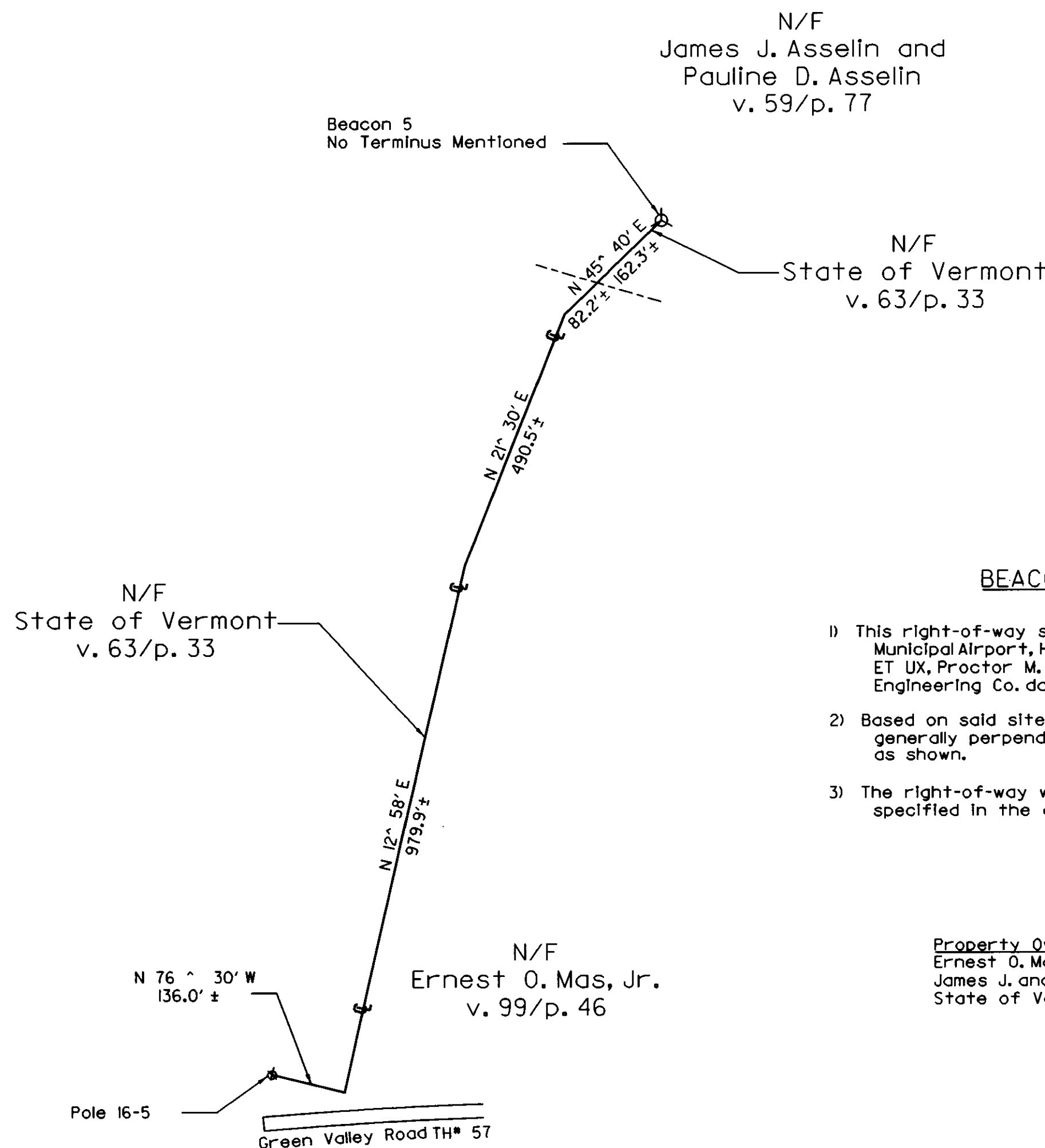


BEACON NO. 4 NOTES

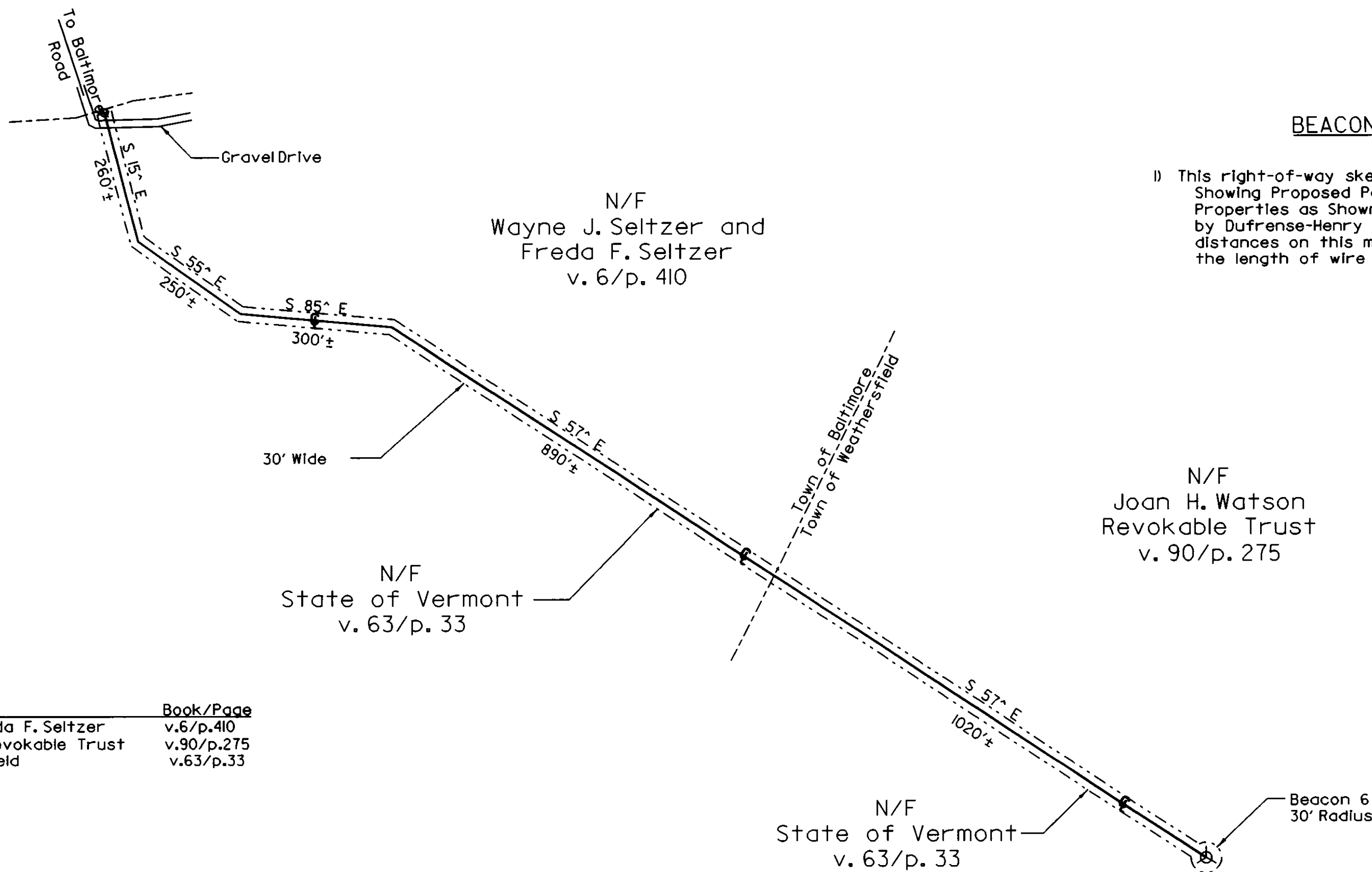


BEACON NO. 5 NOTES

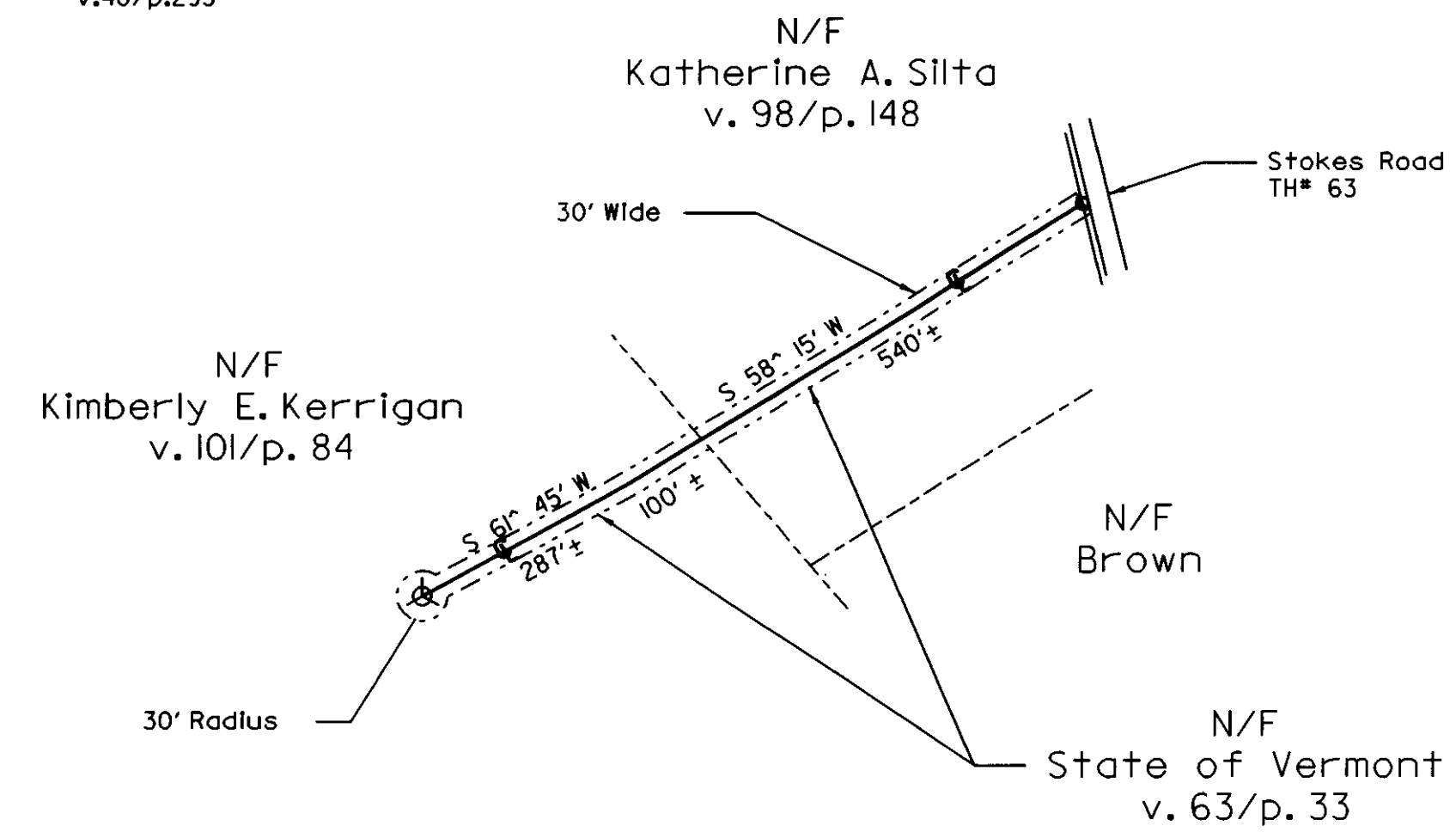

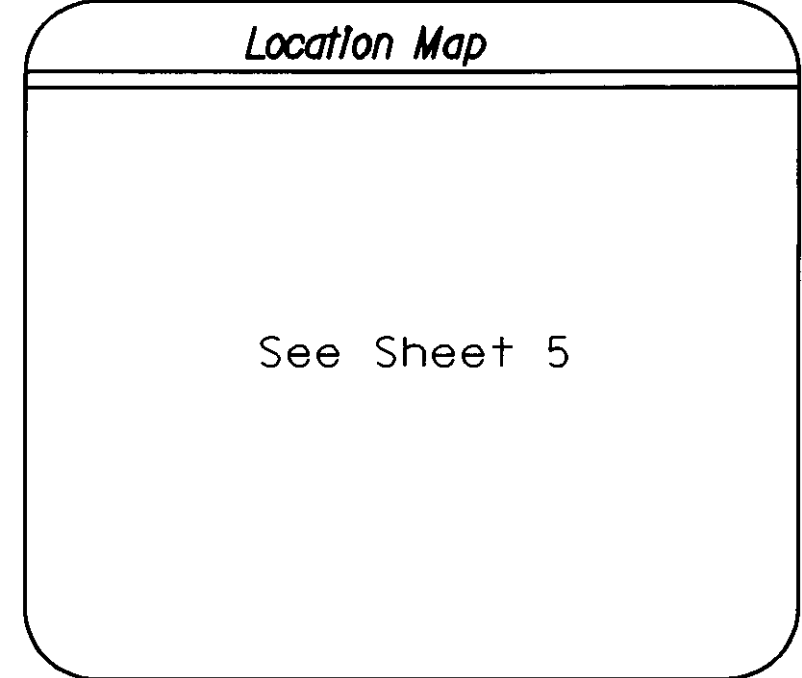

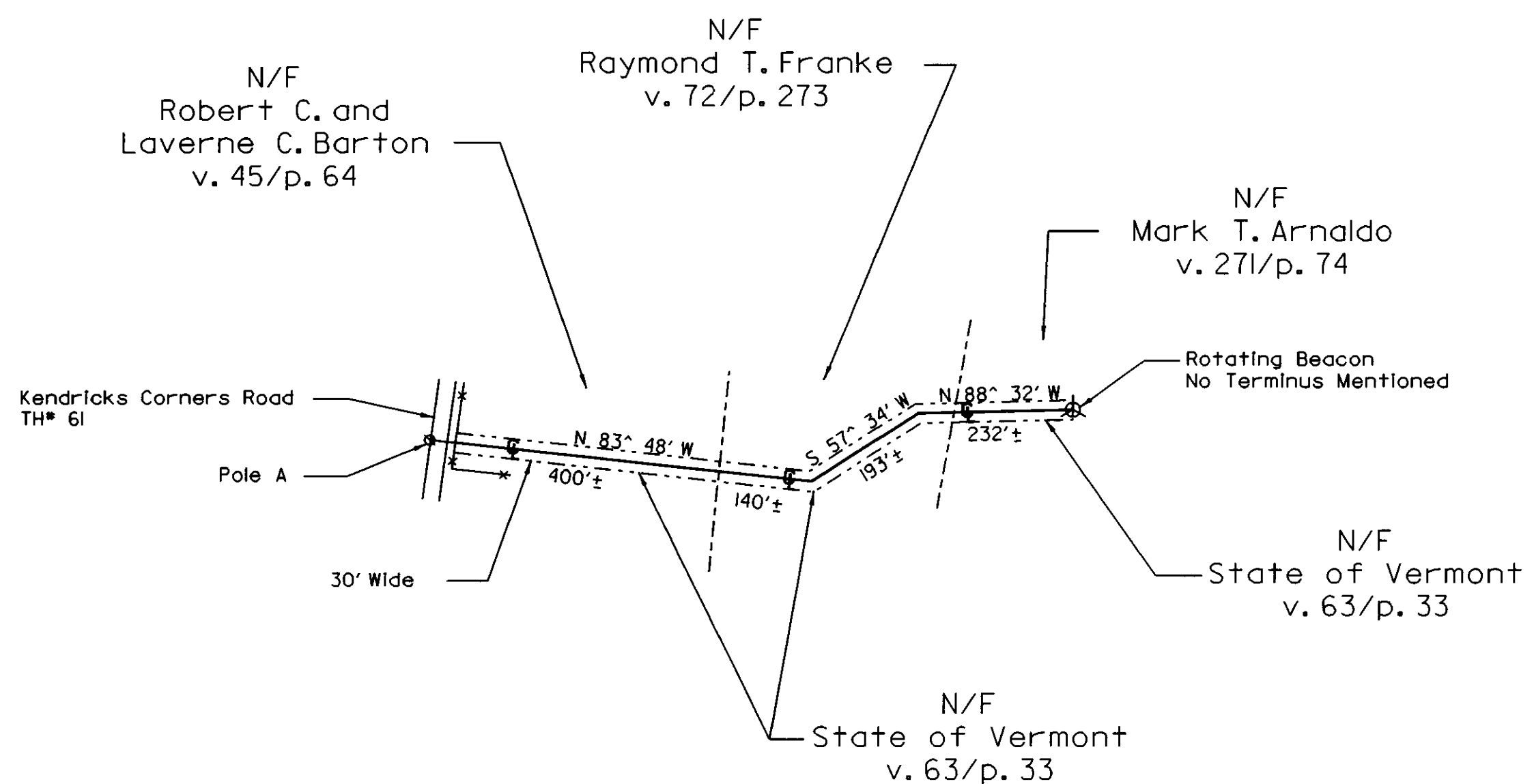


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Location Map
