**FEES.** Service and Maintenance fees at Agency and Darling State Forest, \$10 cents—all other state forests and forest parks—25 cents per day per car of five persons or less.  
**Camp Sites**—tent floors, trailers—\$1.00; lean-tos—\$1.50 per day per car of five persons or less.

**BATH HOUSE LOCKERS**—10 cents per person.

**PARK HOURS**—All of the state forest and forest park areas are open to the public between the hours of 10 AM and 8 PM during the summer season.

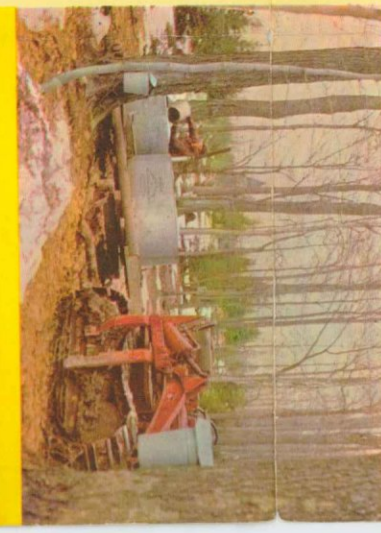
