



VERMONT SPEED LIMITS
 Unless otherwise posted, the speed limit is 50 miles per hour for passenger cars and 45 miles per hour for all other motor vehicles.
IN CASE OF ACCIDENT involving property damage over \$50 or personal injury — Report within 36 hours to Commissioner of Motor Vehicles. Motorist's car must be removed from state of local police.
