

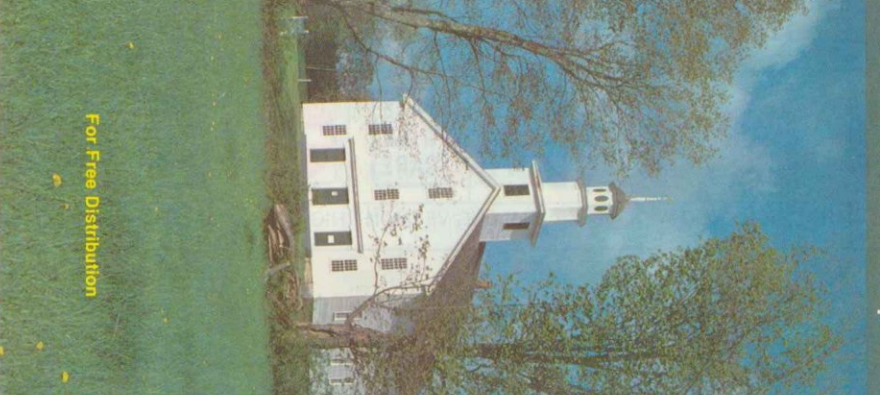

ATTENTION TRAVELERS! Vermont has preserved the natural beauty of the countryside by eliminating all billboards. You will find the following alternative sources of information helpful.



To locate specific facilities in rural areas, look for Official Business Directional Signs. Signs are placed at major road junctions from sign to facility and direction.

Travel Information placards (in French, German, Italian, Spanish) provide state information and a state map. Chambers of Commerce in many communities provide travel literature about specific facilities and general state information. Many individual Vermonters and local organizations are happy to assist travelers. Generally, Ca. 19 is monitored for travel delays. Ca. 9 for emergency.
