THREE COMPONENT SYSTEM

1. **ALPHABETIC TOWN LETTERS** (A-L) - Run north-south

2. **ARABIC TOWN NUMBERS** (1-18) - Run east-west

3. **STATE LETTERS** (VT, NH, NY, MA, CT) - Run north-south

4. **STATE NUMBERS** (1-18) - Run east-west

DUI in Vermont

Conviction for driving under the influence of alcohol in Vermont is a criminal offense. A conviction can result in court-imposed fines and penalties, including possible jail sentences. Repeat offenders carry stiffer penalties. Vermont's DUI test can also result in driver suspension.

Child Safety Restraints Required

Vermont law requires that children under one year of age be secured in a federally approved child safety seat. Children one year of age or older must be secured in a child safety seat that meets federal motor vehicle safety standards. Child safety seats must be used in the front seat of a car or a seat belt if riding in the rear seat. Law enforcement officers can provide additional information.

It is advisable to make advance reservations for accommodations, especially during the busy summer and early spring seasons. The approximately 13,840 miles of public highways in Vermont include:

- 329 miles of Interstate open to travel.
- 2,389 miles of State Highways (excluding Interstate) and 11,180 miles of Town Highways.
